1. INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides comprehensive instructions for the artfone G6 4G Senior Mobile Phone. Designed with ease of use in mind, the artfone G6 features large buttons, a clear interface, and essential functions for reliable communication. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper operation and maintenance of your device.

3. SETUP

3.1 Installing the SIM Card and Battery

The artfone G6 uses a Nano SIM card. Ensure the phone is powered off before installation.

1. Gently remove the back cover of the phone.
2. Locate the SIM card slot. Insert your Nano SIM card with the gold contacts facing down, ensuring it clicks into place.
3. Insert the battery into its compartment, aligning the gold contacts.
4. Replace the back cover until it securely snaps into place.

3.2 Charging the Phone

Before first use, fully charge the phone. The artfone G6 can be charged using the included charging station or directly via the USB-C port.

- **Using the Charging Station:** Connect the USB cable to the charging station and then to a power adapter (not included) or a USB port. Place the phone securely in the charging station. The charging indicator on the phone's screen will show charging status.
- **Direct Charging:** Connect the USB-C cable directly to the phone's USB-C port and then to a power adapter or USB port.

A full charge typically takes approximately 2-3 hours. The battery icon on the screen will indicate when charging is complete.

3.3 Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the **Call/Green** button until the screen lights up.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the **End Call/Red** button until the power off options appear, then confirm.

4. OPERATING YOUR ARTFONE G6

4.1 Basic Call Functions

- **Making a Call:** Enter the phone number using the keypad and press the **Call/Green** button.

- **Answering a Call:** When the phone rings, open the flip to automatically answer, or press the **Call/Green** button.
- **Ending a Call:** Press the **End Call/Red** button or close the flip.
- **Hands-free Function:** During a call, press the dedicated speaker button (if available) or navigate through the menu to activate hands-free mode.

4.2 Sending and Receiving SMS Messages

- Navigate to the "Messages" menu.
- Select "Write Message" to compose a new SMS.
- Enter the recipient's number or select from contacts.
- Type your message using the keypad.
- Press "Send" to transmit the message.
- Received messages will appear in the "Inbox" within the Messages menu.

4.3 Dual Display Functionality

The artfone G6 features two displays for enhanced convenience:

- **Main Display (2.4-inch):** Used for all primary operations, menu navigation, and viewing content when the phone is open.
- **Outer Display (1.8-inch):** Shows essential information like time, date, battery status, and incoming call notifications without needing to open the phone. It also features a multilingual time announcement function.

4.4 Keypad and Menu Navigation

The large, illuminated buttons and clear menu icons are designed for intuitive use.

- Use the navigation keys (up, down, left, right) to move through menu options.
- Press the "OK" or "Select" button (usually the center button) to confirm a selection.
- Press the "Back" or "Clear" button to return to the previous screen or delete characters.
- **Quick Dial Buttons:** Assign important contacts to M1, M2, and number keys (2-9) for quick dialing. Refer to the phone's settings for assigning these.

4.5 SOS Emergency Call Function

The SOS button provides a critical safety feature, allowing you to quickly contact pre-set emergency numbers.

1. Setting Up SOS Contacts:

- Go to "Settings" > "SOS Settings".
- Add up to 5 emergency contacts. These contacts will be called sequentially until one answers.
- You can also set an SOS message that will be sent to these contacts.

2. **Using the SOS Function:** In an emergency, press and hold the dedicated SOS button on the back of the phone. The phone will automatically dial the pre-set emergency contacts and send the SOS message.

4.6 Blacklist Function

To block unwanted calls, you can add numbers to the blacklist.

- Navigate to "Settings" > "Call Settings" > "Blacklist".
- Add numbers you wish to block. The phone can block up to 50 numbers.

4.7 Multimedia and Other Functions

- **FM Radio:** Access the FM Radio application from the main menu. You may need to connect headphones (not included) to act as an antenna.
- **Torch:** Activate the built-in torch from the quick access button or menu.
- **Camera:** The phone supports taking photos. Access the camera from the menu. You can save photos to a microSD card (up to 64GB, not included).
- **Language Settings:** Change the phone's language via the "Settings" menu.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the phone's surface. Avoid using liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid exposing the phone to extreme temperatures. Do not leave the phone fully discharged for extended periods.
- **Storage:** If storing the phone for a long time, charge the battery to about 50% and store it in a cool, dry place.
- **Protection:** While the phone is robust, avoid dropping it or exposing it to water.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your artfone G6, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
Phone does not turn on.	Ensure the battery is correctly installed and fully charged. Press and hold the power button for several seconds.
Cannot make or receive calls.	Check if the SIM card is properly inserted. Ensure you have network signal. Contact your network provider if the issue persists.
Battery not charging.	Verify the USB cable and charging station/adaptor are correctly connected. Check for any damage to the cable or ports.
No sound during calls.	Check the volume settings. Ensure the speaker is not blocked. Try restarting the phone.
Keypad unresponsive.	Restart the phone. Ensure no physical obstruction is present.
