1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Generic Portable Clothes Dryer, Model Pr-01. This compact, foldable, and energy-efficient laundry drying machine is designed for convenience in small spaces, apartments, travel, and dorm rooms. This manual provides essential information for safe operation, setup, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your dryer.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before using the appliance and retain for future reference.

- Always ensure the power supply matches the voltage specified on the appliance.
- Do not operate the dryer with a damaged cord or plug. Contact customer support for assistance.
- Keep the dryer away from water and moisture. Do not use in bathrooms or wet environments.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the dryer during operation to prevent overheating.
- Do not overload the dryer. Adhere to the recommended capacity for efficient drying.
- Avoid drying items that have been soiled with flammable substances (e.g., cooking oil, gasoline).
- Use sturdy hangers made of metal or durable plastic. **Avoid cheap plastic hangers as they may deform or melt under heat.**
- Do not block the air inlet or outlet during operation.
- Unplug the appliance when not in use or before cleaning.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your portable clothes dryer:

1. **Choose a Location:** Select a stable location with adequate space and ventilation. Ensure it is near a power outlet and away from water sources.
2. **Hang the Dryer Unit:** Extend the collapsible hook on top of the dryer unit. Hang the unit securely on a clothes rack, shower rod, or any sturdy bar capable of supporting the dryer's weight plus the weight of wet clothes.
3. **Attach the Drying Bag:** Place the opening of the drying bag around the base of the dryer unit, ensuring a snug fit to contain the heat effectively.
4. **Load Clothes:** Open the zipper on the drying bag. Hang your damp clothes on hangers inside the drying bag. Ensure clothes are not dripping wet and are spaced to allow for proper airflow. Close the zipper.

5. **Connect Power:** Plug the dryer into a suitable electrical outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The dryer can be operated using either the remote control or the LED panel on the unit.

5.1 Power On/Off

- Press the power button (O) on the remote or the unit's LED panel to turn the dryer on or off.

5.2 Selecting Drying Modes

The dryer features two main drying modes:

- **Delicate Mode (L01):** Operates at 100-120°F (38-49°C). Ideal for delicate fabrics such as silk, wool, and down.
- **Quick Mode (L02):** Operates at 120-149°F (49-65°C). Best for cotton, linen, nylon, and polyester.

Use the mode selection button (often represented by a fan or sun icon) on the remote or LED panel to cycle through the available modes.

5.3 Setting the Timer

The smart timer function allows you to set the drying duration from 1 to 8 hours.

- Press the timer button (often represented by a clock icon) on the remote or LED panel to adjust the drying time. Each press typically increases the time in increments.
- The LED display will show the remaining drying time.

5.4 Heat Sanitization and UV Purification

The dryer incorporates features for enhanced hygiene:

- **Heat Sanitization:** Drying at temperatures up to 150°F (65°C) helps ensure deep cleaning and sanitization of garments.
- **UV Purification:** An integrated UV light helps kill germs and bacteria during the drying cycle.

6. DRYING TIPS

- **Pre-Spin Clothes:** For best results, ensure clothes are thoroughly spun in a washing machine to remove excess water before placing them in the dryer.
- **Load Capacity:** The dryer has a capacity for approximately 20 pieces of clothing (e.g., t-shirts). Do not exceed this to ensure proper airflow and drying efficiency.
- **Hanger Selection:** Always use sturdy metal or high-quality plastic hangers that can withstand heat. Avoid thin or cheap plastic hangers, as they may bend or melt.
- **Even Drying:** For optimal drying, ensure clothes are hung individually and not bunched together.
- **Drying Times:** Drying times vary based on fabric type, thickness, and initial moisture content. Refer to the general guide below:

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1 Cleaning

- Always unplug the dryer before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior of the dryer unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- The drying bag can be hand-washed with mild detergent and air-dried if necessary.
- Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling or storing.

7.2 Storage

When not in use, the compact design allows for easy storage:

- Disconnect from power and allow the unit to cool completely.
- Fold the drying bag and store it with the dryer unit in a dry place.
- The compact size allows it to fit into drawers or suitcases for travel.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your dryer, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dryer does not turn on.	No power, loose connection, remote battery dead.	Check power outlet, ensure plug is secure, replace remote battery.
Clothes are not drying effectively.	Overloaded, clothes too wet, drying bag not sealed, incorrect mode.	Reduce load, pre-spin clothes, ensure bag zipper is closed, select appropriate drying mode and time.
Dryer is overheating or plastic hangers are melting.	Poor ventilation, cheap plastic hangers, prolonged use.	Ensure adequate space around the unit. Use only sturdy metal or heat-resistant plastic hangers. Do not block air vents. Allow unit to cool between long cycles.
Unusual noise during operation.	Obstruction in fan, unit not hung level.	Unplug and check for obstructions. Ensure the unit is hung level and stable.
