

1. Introduction

Welcome to the world of vinyl with your new Crosley Nocturne CR7501A-CL 2-Speed Bluetooth Record Player Turntable. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your turntable and matching stereo speakers. Please read these instructions carefully before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your product.



2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Verify that all components are present before proceeding with setup:

- Turntable Unit
- Matching Stereo Speakers (2 units)
- Tonearm
- · Adjustable Counterweight
- 45 RPM Adapter
- Slip Mat
- Tinted Dust Cover
- Power Adapter
- · Speaker Cables

3. KEY FEATURES

• Two-Speed Belt-Drive Turntable with Auto Stop: Plays 33 1/3 and 45 RPM records on a full-size aluminum platter. Includes a tinted dust cover, 12-inch slipmat, and a 45 adapter.

 Exceptional Sound Control: Boost bass and balance treble using the built-in controls. The cueing lever facilitates smooth playback with a high-performance Audio-Technica needle and vibrationcontrol feet.

• **High-End Components:** Features a carbon fiber tonearm for reduced vibration, an adjustable counterweight, and anti-skate for precise needle placement. The pre-mounted moving magnet cartridge is a standard 1/2-inch mount for easy upgrades.




Image 3.3: The carbon fiber tonearm and Audio-Technica cartridge ensure high-fidelity audio.

• Bluetooth Connectivity: Stream music through the included matching full-range bookshelf speakers from your mobile device, or stream vinyl playback to your own Bluetooth-enabled speakers. The included speakers offer 80W Peak, 40W RMS (20W RMS x 2) with a frequency response of 20Hz-20Khz.

• Versatile Connection Options: Connect to your stereo system, active speakers, or other external devices using the line in/out audio jacks.

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for future transport or storage.
- 2. **Placement:** Place the turntable on a stable, level surface away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and excessive vibration. Position the speakers on either side of the turntable for optimal stereo separation.

- 3. **Platter and Belt Installation:** Place the aluminum platter onto the turntable spindle. Locate the drive belt and carefully loop it around the motor pulley and the inner rim of the platter. Ensure the belt is not twisted.
- 4. **Dust Cover:** Attach the tinted dust cover to the hinges at the back of the turntable.
- 5. **Tonearm Assembly:** Install the adjustable counterweight onto the rear of the tonearm. Adjust the counterweight and anti-skate settings according to the included quick start guide or detailed instructions for optimal tracking force. The pre-mounted Audio-Technica cartridge is ready for use.
- 6. **Speaker Connection:** Connect the included speaker cables from the turntable's speaker outputs to the corresponding inputs on the matching stereo speakers. Ensure correct polarity (red to red, black to black).
- 7. **Power Connection:** Connect the power adapter to the DC IN port on the turntable and then plug it into a wall outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Playing a Record

1. Power On: Press and hold the POWER/MODE knob for a few seconds to turn on the unit.

- 2. **Select Speed:** Set the speed selector switch (33 1/3 or 45 RPM) to match the record you are playing. Use the 45 RPM adapter for singles if needed.
- 3. Place Record: Place your record on the platter and ensure the slipmat is underneath.
- 4. Lift Tonearm: Gently lift the tonearm using the cueing lever.
- 5. **Position Needle:** Move the tonearm over the desired track on the record.
- 6. **Lower Tonearm:** Slowly lower the tonearm using the cueing lever. The needle will make contact with the record, and playback will begin.
- 7. Adjust Sound: Use the BASS and TREBLE knobs to fine-tune the audio output to your preference.
- 8. **Auto Stop:** The turntable features an auto-stop function that will stop the platter rotation when the record reaches the end. This can be toggled on/off via a switch on the rear panel.

5.2 Bluetooth Streaming (Input)

To stream music from your mobile device to the Nocturne's speakers:

- 1. **Activate Bluetooth Mode:** Press the POWER/MODE knob until the Bluetooth indicator light illuminates (usually blue).
- 2. **Pair Device:** On your mobile device, enable Bluetooth and search for "Crosley Nocturne" in the list of available devices. Select it to pair.
- 3. **Play Music:** Once paired, you can play audio from your device, and it will output through the Nocturne's speakers.

5.3 Bluetooth Streaming (Output)

To stream vinyl playback from the Nocturne to external Bluetooth speakers (not included):

- 1. Enable External Speaker Pairing: Ensure your external Bluetooth speaker is in pairing mode.
- Activate Turntable Bluetooth Output: Refer to the specific instructions for activating Bluetooth output on your Nocturne turntable. This typically involves a dedicated button or a specific mode selection.
- 3. **Connect:** The turntable will search for and connect to your external Bluetooth speaker.

6. MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning the Dust Cover: Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the dust cover. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Cleaning the Stylus (Needle): Gently brush the stylus from back to front using a soft brush designed for stylus cleaning. Do not use excessive force.
- Cleaning the Cabinet: Wipe the turntable and speaker cabinets with a soft, slightly damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or solvents.
- Record Care: Keep your records clean and stored vertically in their sleeves to prevent dust accumulation and warping.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power adapter not connected; outlet not active.	Ensure power adapter is securely connected and plugged into a working outlet. Press and hold POWER/MODE knob to turn on.
No sound from speakers	Speakers not connected; volume too low; incorrect mode.	Check speaker cable connections. Increase volume. Ensure correct input mode (Phono for records, Bluetooth for streaming).
Skipping or distorted sound	Dirty record; dirty or damaged stylus; incorrect tracking force/anti-skate.	Clean record. Clean stylus. Check stylus for damage. Re-adjust counterweight and anti-skate settings.
Bluetooth pairing issues	Device too far; incorrect pairing mode; interference.	Ensure devices are within range. Put both devices in pairing mode. Turn off other Bluetooth devices.


Image 8.1: Detailed dimensions of the turntable and speakers for placement planning.
