INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper use, setup, and maintenance of your Zacro Adult Bike Helmet. Please read these instructions carefully before using the helmet to ensure maximum safety and comfort.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Your Zacro Adult Bike Helmet is certified to meet safety standards for riders. It is CE Marked (European Standard) and U.S. CPSC Approved for ages 5 and up. The helmet features a durable polycarbonate (PC) shell and high-density EPS foam for excellent shock absorption.

- Always wear your helmet when cycling, scootering, or commuting.
- Ensure the helmet fits snugly and is properly secured.
- Replace the helmet after any significant impact, even if visible damage is not apparent.
- Do not modify the helmet in any way.
- Clean the helmet only with mild soap and water.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND COMPONENTS

The Zacro Adult Bike Helmet is designed for comfort and protection during various activities such as urban commutes, road biking, and scooter rides. Key features include:

- **Ultra-Lightweight Design:** Weighing approximately 260g.

- **18-Vent Breathable System:** For optimal airflow and heat dissipation.
- **Detachable Visor:** Provides protection from sun glare and rain.
- **Washable Liner:** Removable for easy cleaning.
- **Adjustable Fit System:** Easy-turn dial and adjustable straps for a custom fit.
- **Durable Construction:** Polycarbonate (PC) shell and high-density Expanded Polystyrene (EPS) foam.

SAFE & STURDY INTEGRATED STRUCTURE

SETUP AND ADJUSTMENT

1. Measure Head Circumference:

Before adjusting, measure your head circumference to ensure you have the correct helmet size (Universal Adult: 54-62 cm or 58-65 cm). Wrap a non-stretchy tape measure horizontally around your head, aligning the front 1-2 cm above your eyebrows. Keep the tape gently snug, then repeat 2-3 times and take the average measurement.

2. Adjust the Fit System:

- **Adjustable Spin Dial:** Located at the back of the helmet, turn the dial clockwise to tighten or counter-clockwise to loosen the internal retention system for a snug, comfortable fit.
- **Chin Strap Adjuster:** Adjust the side straps to ensure they form a 'V' shape just below your ears.
- **Quick-Release Buckle:** Fasten the buckle under your chin. Ensure there is enough room for one or two fingers between the strap and your chin.
- **Thickened Chin Pad:** The chin strap includes a thickened pad for pressure relief and enhanced comfort.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once your helmet is properly adjusted, it is ready for use. Always ensure the helmet is level on your head, covering your forehead, and the straps are securely fastened before beginning your ride. The 18 vents are designed to keep your head cool and dry during extended rides.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Helmet:

- The internal wrap-around pad is detachable for cleaning. Gently remove the padding.
- Wash the padding by hand with mild soap and water. Allow it to air dry completely before reattaching.
- Clean the helmet shell with a soft cloth, mild soap, and water. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Zacro Adult Bike Helmet, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **Helmet feels loose:** Tighten the adjustable spin dial at the back and ensure the chin straps are snug but comfortable.
- **Helmet feels too tight:** Loosen the adjustable spin dial. If still too tight, verify your head circumference against the helmet's size range.
- **Visor detaches easily:** Ensure the visor is correctly aligned and securely snapped into its designated slots on the helmet.
- **Discomfort from straps:** Adjust the side strap dividers to position the 'V' shape just below your ears. Utilize the thickened chin pad for added comfort.
