1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW


2. SETUP AND ADJUSTMENT

2.1. Measuring for Correct Size

Before first use, ensure the helmet is the correct size for the user. Measure the head circumference just above the ears and level from front to back. Refer to the sizing chart below:

X-Small (XS): 18.98–20.08 inches (48-51cm)

Small (S): 20.08–21.26 inches (51-54cm)



XS 18.98–20.08 inch (48–51cm)

S 20.08–21.26 inch (51–54cm)

HOW TO MEASURE?

Measure your head circumference just above the ears and level from front to back to determine the correct helmet size.

2.2. Adjusting Helmet Fit

The helmet features an adjustable dial system located at the back to ensure a secure and comfortable fit. Place the helmet on the user's head, then turn the dial clockwise to tighten or counter-clockwise to loosen until a snug fit is achieved without discomfort.

2.3. Attaching Goggles

The helmet is designed for seamless integration with the included goggles. The goggles feature an adjustable strap. Secure the goggle strap around the helmet, utilizing the built-in goggle clip at the back of the helmet to prevent slippage and ensure a stable fit.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1. Wearing the Helmet and Goggles

After adjusting the helmet for a snug fit, fasten the chin strap securely. The soft chin strap padding enhances comfort. Position the goggles over the eyes, ensuring they sit comfortably against the face and integrate smoothly with the helmet's brim to prevent gaps.

3.2. Ventilation System

The helmet features 12 vents designed to provide optimal air circulation. This system allows hot and humid air to escape, keeping the user's head dry and comfortable during extended periods of activity. The

ventilation works in conjunction with the goggles' anti-fog technology to maintain clear vision.

3.3. Goggle Features

The included goggles offer UV400 protection and feature an ultra anti-fog coating. This ensures clear vision and protects the eyes from harmful UV rays in various weather conditions.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1. Cleaning the Helmet

The helmet features removable ear pads and an inner fleece liner for easy cleaning. Gently detach these components. Hand wash with mild soap and water, then air dry completely before reattaching. The outer PC shell can be wiped clean with a damp cloth.

4.2. Cleaning the Goggles

Carefully clean goggle lenses with a soft, non-abrasive cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could damage the anti-fog coating. The goggle strap can be hand washed if necessary.

4.3. Storage

Store the helmet and goggles in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Use the provided storage bags to protect the goggles from scratches and the helmet from dust and damage during transport or storage.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1. Helmet Feels Loose or Too Tight

Adjust the dial at the back of the helmet to achieve a snug, comfortable fit. Ensure the chin strap is properly fastened and adjusted. If the helmet is consistently too loose or too tight even after adjustment, verify the head circumference against the sizing chart to ensure the correct helmet size was selected.

5.2. Goggles Fogging Up

Ensure the goggles are properly seated against the helmet to allow for adequate airflow through the helmet's ventilation system. Avoid wiping the inside of the goggle lens, as this can damage the anti-fog coating. If fogging persists, ensure the user is not overheating, which can contribute to moisture buildup.

5.3. Goggles Slipping

Confirm that the goggle strap is securely fastened around the helmet and that the built-in goggle clip at the back of the helmet is engaged. Adjust the goggle strap for a firm but comfortable tension.
