# PeriPage Pino Wireless Tattoo Stencil Printer User Manual

Model: Pino (ALD-P900)

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your PeriPage Pino Wireless Tattoo Stencil Printer. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device to ensure proper functionality and to prevent damage.

The PeriPage Pino is a portable thermal transfer machine designed for creating tattoo stencils. It offers wireless connectivity via Bluetooth for smartphones and tablets, and a USB connection for computers, making it a versatile tool for tattoo artists.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

### Important Safety Precautions:

- Keep the device away from naked flames or direct heat sources.
- Do not expose the device to water or excessive moisture.
- Use only the specified power adapter and accessories.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the device yourself. Contact customer support for assistance.
- Ensure proper ventilation during operation.

## 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

## 4. SETUP

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### 4.1 Charging the Printer

Before first use, fully charge the printer using the provided power adapter and USB cable. The charging indicator light will typically change color or turn off when charging is complete.

### 4.2 Installing the App (for Mobile Devices)

1. Search for the "PeriPage" app in your device's app store (iOS or Android).
2. Download and install the application.
3. Open the app and follow any on-screen prompts for initial setup.

### 4.3 Connecting to a Device

#### 4.3.1 Bluetooth Connection (Mobile Devices)

1. Ensure the PeriPage Pino printer is powered on.
2. Enable Bluetooth on your smartphone or tablet.
3. Open the PeriPage app. The app will guide you to search for and connect to the printer. Select "Pino" from the list of available devices.
4. Confirm the pairing request on your device if prompted.

#### 4.3.2 USB Connection (PC)

1. Ensure the PeriPage Pino printer is powered on.
2. Connect the printer to your computer (Mac or Windows) using the provided USB cable.
3. Your computer may automatically install necessary drivers. If not, visit the official PeriPage website for driver downloads.
4. Once drivers are installed, the printer will be recognized as a printing device.



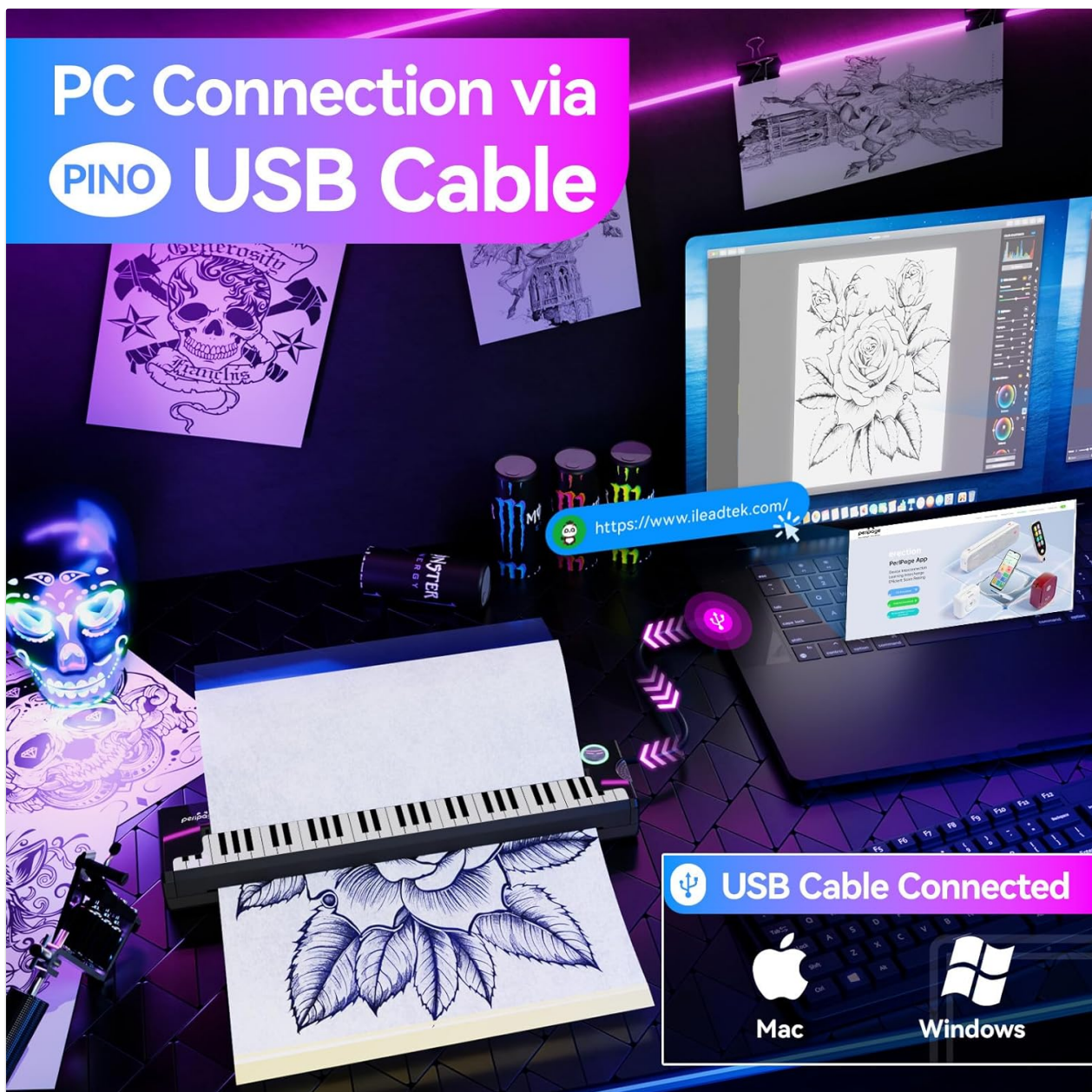


Figure 2: USB Connection to PC

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 5.1 Preparing the Stencil Paper

1. Tear off the yellow protective paper from the thermal stencil sheet.
2. Remove the transparent protective film from the stencil sheet.

### 5.2 Printing a Stencil

1. Turn on the PeriPage Pino printer by pressing and holding the power button.
2. Carefully insert the prepared stencil paper into the printer's paper feed slot. Ensure it is aligned correctly.
3. Using the PeriPage app (for mobile) or your computer's print function (for PC), select your desired tattoo design.
4. In the app, navigate to the "tattoo" function or print option. Adjust settings as needed (e.g., size, darkness).
5. Initiate the print command. The printer will feed the paper and print the stencil.

### 5.3 Transferring the Stencil to Skin

1. Cleanse the skin area where the tattoo will be applied using wet wipes or an appropriate skin prep solution.
2. Apply a thin, even layer of tattoo transfer cream to the cleaned skin area.
3. Carefully place the printed stencil onto the prepared skin, pressing gently without rubbing. Ensure full contact.
4. Slowly peel back the stencil paper to reveal the transferred stencil outline on the skin.

## 5.4 Using the PeriPage App Features

The PeriPage app offers various functionalities to enhance your stencil creation:

- **Personalized Editing:** Adjust images, add text, and modify designs directly within the app.

- **3D Tattoo Preview:** Visualize how the stencil might appear on a 3D body model.
- **Image Editing:** Tools for refining and optimizing images for stencil printing.

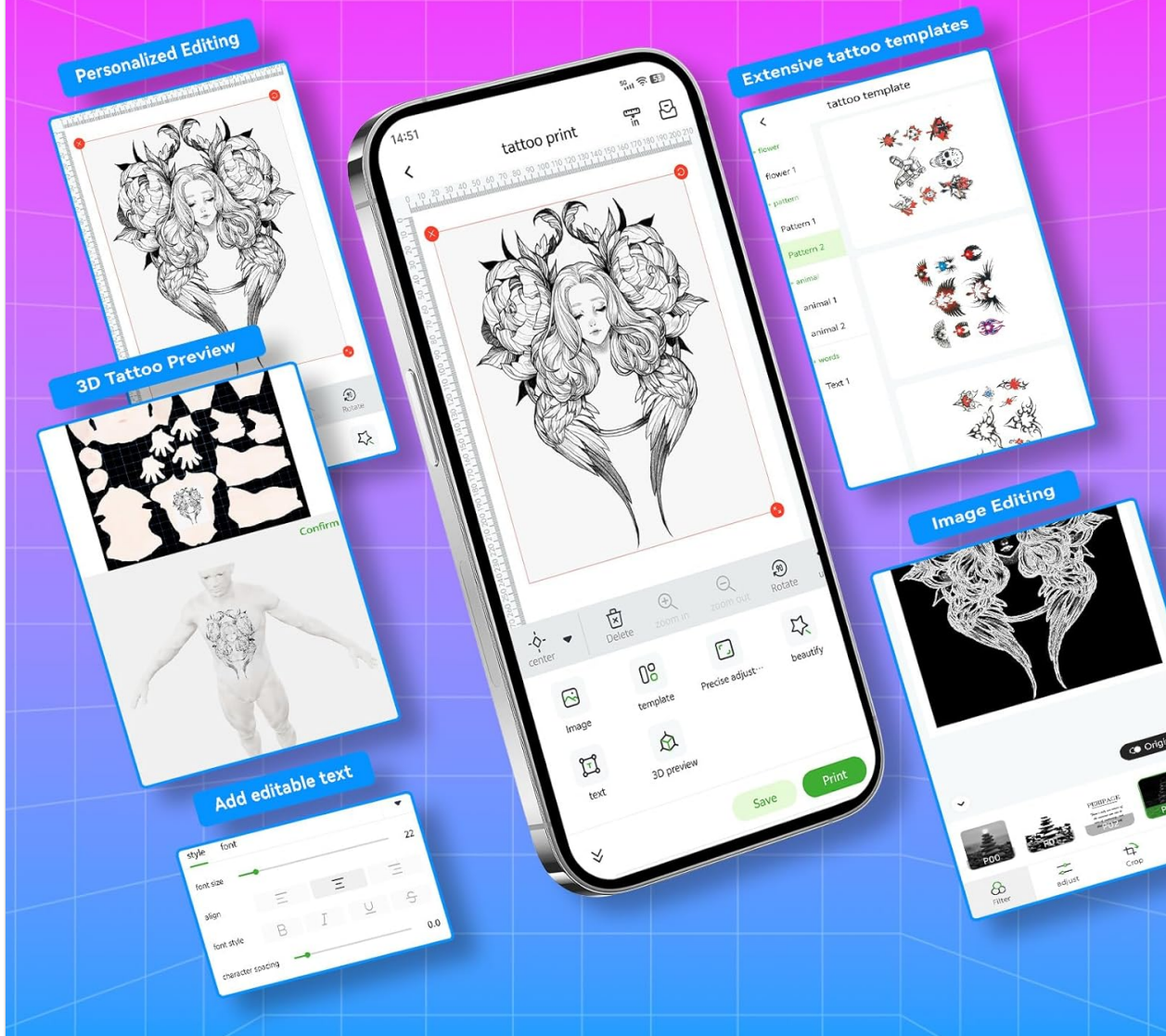


Figure 6: PeriPage App Features

## 6. MAINTENANCE

### 6.1 Cleaning the Printer

- Ensure the printer is powered off and disconnected from any power source before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior of the printer with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or alcohol, as these can damage the surface.
- Periodically check the paper feed area for any dust or debris and gently remove it.

### 6.2 Storage

- Store the printer in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Keep the printer covered to prevent dust accumulation.
- If storing for an extended period, ensure the battery is partially charged (around 50%) to prolong its lifespan.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING



This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your PeriPage Pino printer.

## **7.1 Printer Not Turning On**

- Ensure the printer is fully charged. Connect it to a power source and allow it to charge for at least 30 minutes.
- Check the power button for proper engagement.

## **7.2 Unable to Connect via Bluetooth**

- Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your mobile device.
- Ensure the printer is within range (typically 10 meters or 33 feet).
- Restart both the printer and your mobile device.
- Forget the device in your phone's Bluetooth settings and try pairing again through the PeriPage app.

## **7.3 Poor Print Quality (Blurred or Faint Stencils)**

- Ensure you are using high-quality thermal stencil paper.
- Check the paper for proper insertion and alignment.
- Clean the print head if there is any visible debris (refer to Maintenance section).
- Adjust the print density settings within the PeriPage app or printer driver.
- Ensure the image resolution is adequate for printing.

## 7.4 Paper Jams

- Power off the printer immediately.
- Gently pull out any jammed paper in the direction of the paper path. Avoid tearing the paper inside the printer.
- Ensure the paper is inserted straight and not wrinkled before printing.

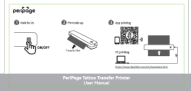
