INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper use, setup, and maintenance of your SGNICS X13 Bluetooth 5.3 Earbuds. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in your package:

- SGNICS X13 Earbuds (Left and Right)
- Charging Case
- USB-C Charging Cable
- Eartips (S, M, L sizes)

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The SGNICS X13 Earbuds feature an ergonomic ear hook design for secure fit during activities, a portable charging case with an LED display, and touch controls for easy operation.

Easy to Wear

SETUP

1. Charging the Earbuds and Case

Before first use, fully charge the earbuds and charging case.

- Charging the Case:** Connect the provided USB-C cable to the charging port on the case and to a USB power adapter (not included). The LED display on the case will show the charging progress. A full charge takes approximately 1.5 hours.
- Charging the Earbuds:** Place the earbuds into the charging case. Ensure they are correctly seated in their respective slots (L for left, R for right). The earbuds will automatically begin charging. The LED display on the case will indicate the charge level of the earbuds.

Fully charged earbuds provide up to 9 hours of playback, and the charging case extends total playtime to approximately 48 hours.

2. Bluetooth Pairing

The earbuds utilize Bluetooth 5.3 for a stable and fast connection.

1. Initial Pairing:

- a. Open the charging case. The earbuds will automatically power on and enter pairing mode.
- b. Enable Bluetooth on your device (smartphone, tablet, etc.).
- c. Search for "X13 Earbuds" in the list of available Bluetooth devices and select it to connect.
- d. Once connected, you will hear a confirmation tone, and the earbuds will be ready for use.

2. **Automatic Reconnection:** After initial pairing, the earbuds will automatically connect to the last paired device when removed from the charging case, provided Bluetooth is enabled on the device.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Wearing the Earbuds

For optimal sound quality and comfort, choose the correct eartip size (S/M/L) and adjust the ear hooks.

- Select the eartips that provide a snug fit in your ear canal.
- Insert the earbud into your ear, then gently rotate it to secure.
- Adjust the flexible ear hook over your ear for a stable and comfortable fit, especially during sports or exercise.

Touch Controls

The earbuds feature touch-sensitive areas for controlling various functions. The exact touch patterns may vary slightly, but common functions include:

- **Play/Pause:** Single tap on either earbud.
- **Next Track:** Double tap on the right earbud.
- **Previous Track:** Double tap on the left earbud.
- **Answer/End Call:** Single tap on either earbud during an incoming call.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold either earbud for 2 seconds during an incoming call.
- **Activate Voice Assistant:** Triple tap on either earbud.

Making and Receiving Calls

The SGNICS X13 Earbuds are equipped with 4 microphones and Environmental Noise Canceling (ENC) technology to ensure clear call quality.

- Refer to the "Touch Controls" section for answering, ending, and rejecting calls.
- During a call, audio will be routed through the earbuds.

Music Playback

Experience Hi-Fi stereo sound with deep bass. Use the touch controls to manage your music.

- Refer to the "Touch Controls" section for playing, pausing, and skipping tracks.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and performance of your earbuds.

- **Cleaning:** Regularly clean the earbuds, eartips, and charging contacts with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Water Resistance:** The earbuds are IPX6 waterproof, protecting them from sweat and rain. However, they are not designed for submersion in water. Ensure they are dry before placing them back in the charging case.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the earbuds in their charging case to protect them and keep them charged. Store in a cool, dry place away from extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Earbuds not pairing:**

- Ensure earbuds are charged and removed from the case.
- Turn off and on Bluetooth on your device.
- Forget "X13 Earbuds" from your device's Bluetooth list and try pairing again.

- **No sound:**

- Check device volume and earbud volume.
- Ensure earbuds are properly connected to your device.
- Try playing audio from a different application or source.

- **Charging issues:**

- Verify the USB-C cable and power adapter are working correctly.

- Ensure charging contacts on earbuds and case are clean and free of debris.




- Do not disassemble, repair, or modify the product.

How to Wear the Earbuds Correctly?

Choose best-fit ear tips, gently push the earbuds into your ears and adjust them to get a comfortable fit.



Safety Attention

1. Do not use the earbuds while driving a car, operating machinery or performing other activities that require hearing remaining sounds.
2. Listen to earbuds at high to moderate volumes for extended periods of time will result in permanent hearing damage. It is advised you keep volume levels moderate to low at times for your safety.
3. Do not use earbuds in extremely hot or cold environments to prevent damage or electrical shock.
4. Please do not expose the earbuds out of extreme heat or humidity, do not use any corrosive cleaner to clean the earbuds.
5. Please do not use any sharp object to clean the product in case of failure or fire accident.
6. Please keep beyond the reach of kids or pets.
7. Please do not carry the device if it causes any discomfort or pain.
8. As the Bluetooth signal cannot transmit in water it is not suitable for swimming or diving. If submerged in water, do not turn the device on until completely dry.

How to Sync Volume on Android?

To protect users from potential hearing damage, Android's limit on max volume is quite low for Bluetooth audio devices.

If you feel the volume is too low, please access developer options and enable absolute volume, so you'll be able to raise the volume at the maximum level. The full capabilities of your earbuds are available.

Find Build Number First

Android 4.1 and lower: the Developer options screen is available by default.

Android 4.2 and higher: the Developer options in Android phones are located in the Settings > About Phone > Build Number > Build Number.

Enable Developer Options

Locate the Build number and tap it about 7 times in succession to enable Developer options. You may also have to tap in your PN for confirmation. Once developer options are activated, you will see a message that reads: You are now a developer.



Enable Absolute Volume

Scroll down until you reach the Networking section. Once there, enable (tapping ON) the absolute volume option as figure 2.



Note: These options in the figures may be different from the device you're using. Typically, the choices depend on the type and model of the device you are working with.
