SETUP

Speaker Placement

The SOUNDROVER PRO 650 can be placed directly on a flat surface or mounted on the included tripod stand for optimal sound projection. Ensure the speaker is stable and on a level surface to prevent tipping.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Control Panel Overview

The rear panel of the SOUNDROVER PRO 650 features a comprehensive control interface for various audio inputs and adjustments.

1. **USB/SD Media Playback:** Insert USB drives or SD cards for direct audio playback.
2. **Guitar Input:** Connect a guitar using a 1/4" cable.
3. **Mic Input:** Connect a microphone using an XLR or 1/4" cable.
4. **Graphic EQ:** Adjust the frequency response for customized sound.
5. **RCA 1/8" Input:** Connect external audio devices via RCA or 1/8" (3.5mm) auxiliary cable.
6. **Inputs with Reverb:** Apply reverb effect to specific inputs.
7. **Pro XLR & 1/4" Connectors:** Professional-grade inputs for microphones and other audio equipment.

Wireless Microphone Usage

The included wireless microphone can be used for karaoke, announcements, or performances. Ensure the microphone is powered on and paired with the speaker according to the microphone's instructions.

Bluetooth Connectivity

To connect a Bluetooth device, ensure the speaker is in Bluetooth mode. Search for "SOUNDROVER PRO 650" on your device's Bluetooth settings and pair. A confirmation sound will indicate successful pairing.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cable not connected; Power switch off	Ensure power cable is securely connected and power switch is in the ON position.
No sound output	Volume too low; Incorrect input selected; Device not paired (Bluetooth)	Increase Master Volume. Select correct input source. Repair Bluetooth device.
Microphone not working	Microphone off; Battery low; Incorrect input selected	Ensure microphone is powered on. Replace batteries if needed. Select correct microphone input.
Distorted sound	Volume too high; EQ settings incorrect	Reduce Master Volume. Adjust Graphic EQ settings.
