INITIAL SETUP

CAMERA AND VIDEO RECORDING

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Device Not Responding:** If your device is frozen, press and hold the Power button and Volume Down button simultaneously for about 7-10 seconds to force restart.
- **Battery Drain:** Check battery usage in *Settings > Battery and device care > Battery* to identify apps consuming excessive power. Reduce screen brightness and disable unnecessary features like Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, or GPS when not in use.
- **App Crashes:** Try clearing the app's cache and data in *Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage* If the issue persists, uninstall and reinstall the app.
- **Connectivity Issues (Wi-Fi/Bluetooth):** Toggle Wi-Fi or Bluetooth off and on. Restart your device. For Wi-Fi, also try restarting your router.
- **Slow Performance:** Clear unnecessary files and cache using *Settings > Battery and device care > Storage*. Close background apps and consider uninstalling rarely used applications.
