Daiso Double Coffee Dripper Instruction Manual

Model: 6867

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Daiso Double Coffee Dripper. This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your new coffee dripper. Designed for convenience, this dripper allows you to brew 1 to 4 cups of coffee, including the option to brew two cups simultaneously. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of the product.

SETUP

Before first use, wash all components with warm, soapy water and rinse thoroughly. Ensure the dripper is completely dry before use.

Components:

- Daiso Double Coffee Dripper unit

Preparing the Coffee Filter:

1. Select a cone-shaped or trapezoidal paper filter suitable for 1 to 4 cups.
2. Fold the filter along its seams to ensure it fits snugly into the dripper. For trapezoidal filters, fold the bottom and side seams. For cone filters, fold the side seam.
3. Place the folded filter into the dripper. Ensure it is fully seated and covers the drip holes.

Important: Do not use with filters or cups of different sizes or shapes than recommended, as this may cause the filter to tear or lead to improper brewing.

Positioning the Dripper:

- Place the dripper directly over one or two coffee cups. The dripper is designed to fit cups with an inner diameter of approximately 65mm to 90mm (2.55 to 3.54 inches).
- If brewing only one cup, center the cup directly under one of the drip outlets.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Add Coffee Grounds:** Place the desired amount of coffee grounds into the prepared filter. Gently shake the dripper to level the grounds.
- 2. Bloom the Coffee:** Slowly pour a small amount of hot water (just off the boil, around 195-205°F or 90-96°C) over the coffee grounds, ensuring all grounds are saturated. Allow the coffee to "bloom" for approximately 20-30 seconds. This step helps release gases and enhances flavor.
- 3. Continue Pouring:** After blooming, continue to pour hot water slowly and evenly over the coffee grounds in a circular motion, starting from the center and moving outwards. Maintain a steady stream to ensure consistent extraction.
- 4. Monitor Brewing:** The coffee will drip into the cups below. Adjust the pouring speed to achieve your desired brew strength.
- 5. Remove Dripper:** Once the desired amount of coffee has been brewed, or the water has fully drained, carefully remove the dripper from the cups. Discard the used filter and coffee grounds.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life of your Daiso Double Coffee Dripper.

- **Cleaning:** After each use, remove the used coffee filter and grounds. Rinse the dripper thoroughly with warm water. For a more thorough cleaning, use a mild dish soap and a soft sponge.
- **Drying:** Allow the dripper to air dry completely before storing.
- **Storage:** Store the dripper in a clean, dry place.
- **Material:** The dripper is made of polypropylene, which is heat resistant up to 212°F (100°C). Avoid exposing it to temperatures exceeding this limit.




Image: A clear side view of the Daiso Double Coffee Dripper, highlighting its transparent design and the dual drip outlets.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Slow Drip:**

- Ensure coffee grounds are not too fine. Coarser grounds allow water to pass through more easily.
- Check that the filter is not clogged.
- Verify the filter is properly seated and not blocking the drip holes.

- **Weak Coffee:**

- Use more coffee grounds.
- Grind coffee finer (but not too fine to cause slow drip).
- Pour water more slowly to increase extraction time.
- Ensure water temperature is appropriate (195-205°F or 90-96°C).

- **Filter Collapse:**

- Ensure the filter is folded correctly and fits snugly into the dripper. Refer to the "Preparing the Coffee Filter" section.
- Use a filter size appropriate for the dripper.



