1. INTRODUCTION

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

- 8. **Power On and Test:** Reconnect the battery and AC adapter. Power on the laptop and test the camera functionality using a camera application or video conferencing software.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

• Camera Not Detected:

- Verify that the camera's ribbon cable is securely connected.
- Check Device Manager (Windows) or equivalent system information for camera detection.

Reinstall drivers if necessary.

• Ensure no physical camera privacy shutter is closed (if applicable to your laptop model).

• Blurry or Poor Image Quality:

- Clean the camera lens carefully.
- Ensure adequate lighting in your environment.
- Check camera settings within your application for resolution or focus adjustments.

• Camera Freezes or Crashes:

- · Restart your laptop.
- Update or reinstall camera drivers.
- Check for conflicting software that might be accessing the camera.
