4. SETUP AND CHARGING

4.1 Initial Setup (Bluetooth Pairing)

1. Ensure your iPad's Bluetooth is enabled.
2. Attach the QDSYLQ Pencil magnetically to the side of your compatible iPad.
3. The stylus will automatically connect via Bluetooth. You can observe the power level of the stylus on your iPad's screen.

4.2 Charging Methods

The QDSYLQ Pencil offers two convenient charging methods:

- **Magnetic Wireless Charging:** Simply snap the stylus to the side of your compatible iPad. This will initiate wireless charging and trigger startup. The power display will show on your iPad.
- **Type-C Quick Charging:** For a full charge, connect the stylus using a Type-C data cable. A full charge takes approximately 60 minutes and provides up to 10 hours of working time.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Shortcut Functions

After connecting via Bluetooth, the button at the top of the stylus provides convenient shortcut functions:

- **Single Tap:** Returns to the main screen.
- **Double Tap:** Opens the APP selection page or task manager, showing recently used applications.
- **Screenshot:** Swipe from the bottom left to the top right corner of the iPad screen using the stylus to take a screenshot.

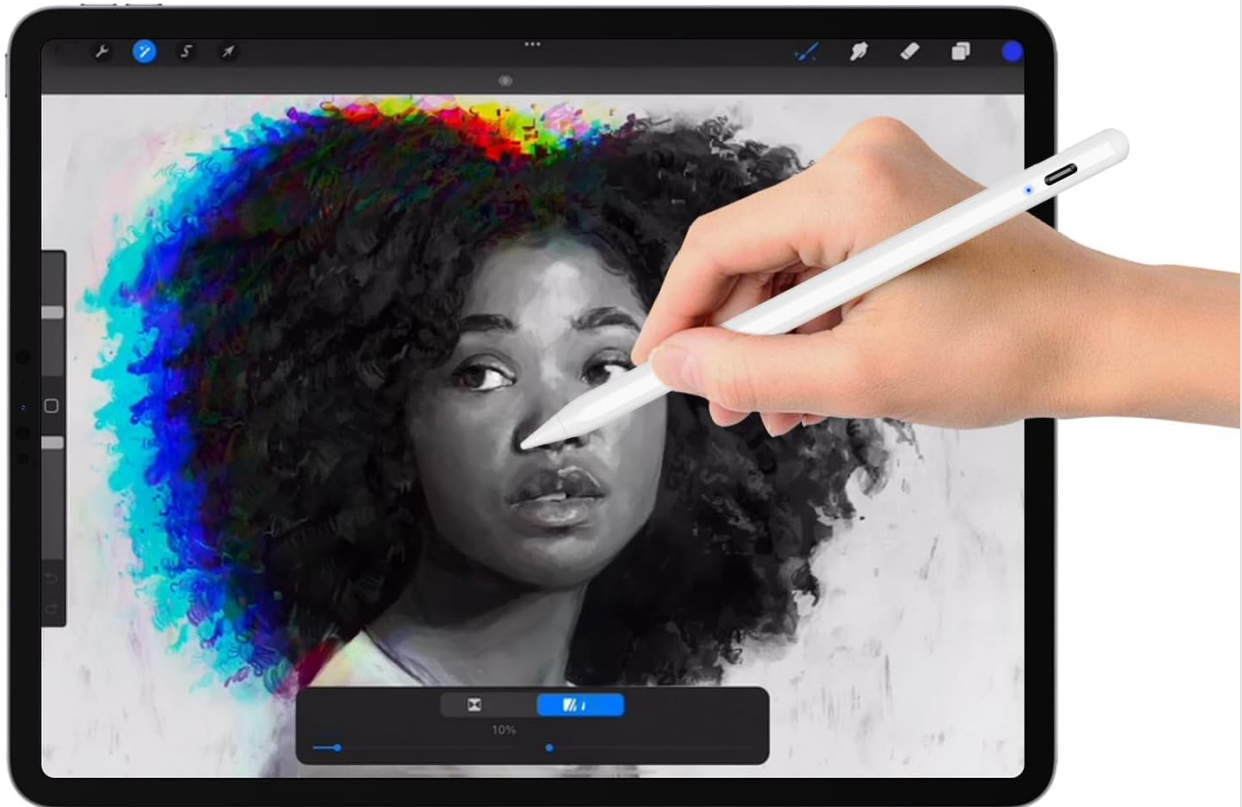
Image: Visual guide to the single-tap and double-tap shortcut functions on the stylus.

5.2 Palm Rejection

5.3 Tilt Function

The tilt and thickening function enables you to draw lines of varying thickness and depth by simply altering the inclination of the stylus tip. This is ideal for sketching, shading, and artistic applications.

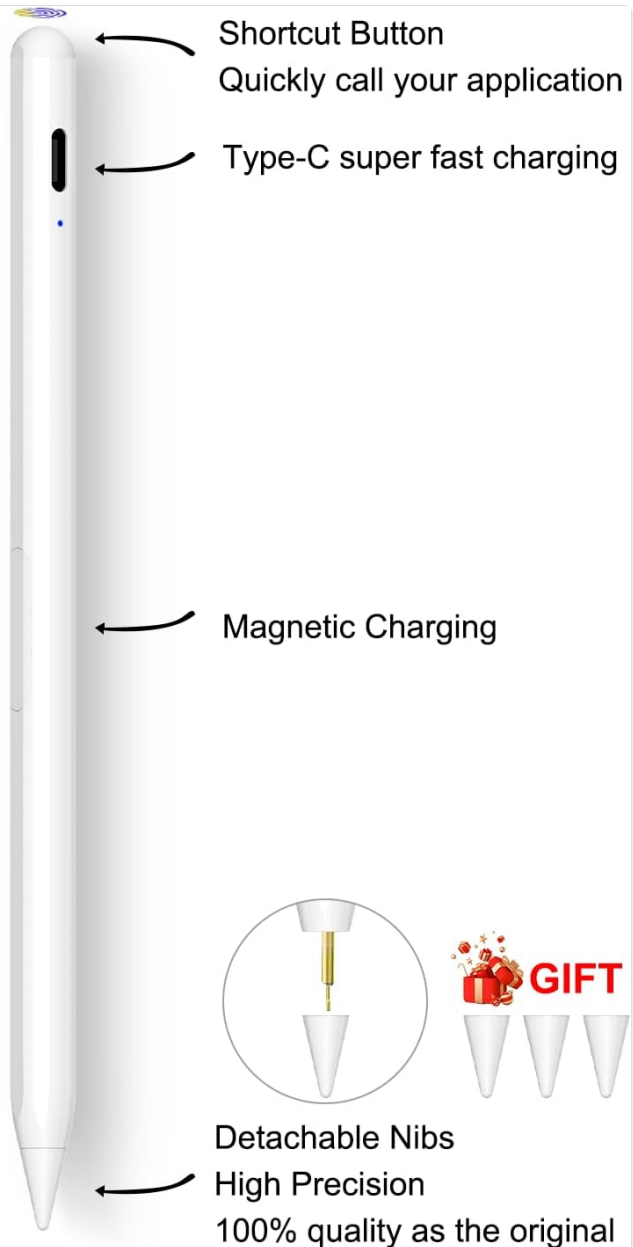


Image: Illustration showing how different tilt angles of the stylus produce varying line thicknesses.

5.4 Precision and Smoothness

The 1.5mm pen tip provides precise control, allowing for fine instructions and smooth gliding across the tablet screen without lag, offset, or breakpoints. It offers higher sensitivity and a more accurate signal compared to ordinary styluses.

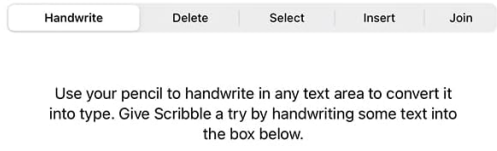

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the stylus body with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Nib Replacement:** The stylus comes with replacement nibs. If the tip becomes worn or damaged, gently twist the old nib counter-clockwise to remove it, and then twist a new nib clockwise until secure.
- **Storage:** Store the stylus in a safe place when not in use, ideally attached magnetically to your iPad or in a protective case, to prevent loss or damage.

Lag or inaccurate input.	Low battery, worn nib, or software issue.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Charge the stylus. 2. Replace the nib. 3. Restart your iPad.
Palm rejection not working.	Not all apps support palm rejection, or a setting issue.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ensure the app you are using supports palm rejection. 2. Check iPad settings for stylus-related options. 3. Ensure the app you are using supports palm rejection. 4. Check iPad settings for stylus-related options.
