INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your OLAKIDS 12V Battery Powered Electric Ride-on Truck. Please read this manual thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

The OLAKIDS 12V Ride-on Truck is designed with safety features including double-lock doors, a 2-point safety belt, and a smooth start function. Parental supervision is required during operation.

- Always ensure the child is securely fastened with the safety belt.
- Operate the vehicle on flat, even surfaces away from traffic, pools, or steep inclines.
- The remote control allows parents to override manual operation for immediate safety intervention.
- This product complies with US. CPSIA and ASTM Requirements, made from non-toxic materials.
- Maximum load capacity is 66 lbs.
- Suitable for children aged 3-8 years.

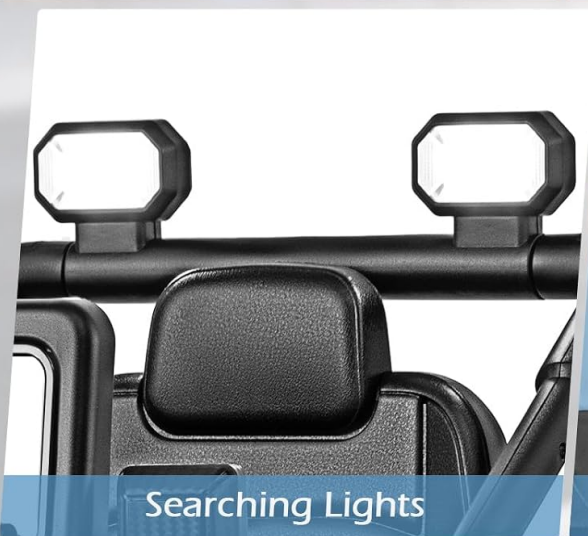

SETUP

Assembly of the ride-on truck is required. Follow the detailed instructions provided in the separate assembly guide included with your product.

Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the 12V battery for 8-12 hours. Do not overcharge. The charger is included.

Remote Control Battery Installation

The parental remote control requires 2 x 1.5V AAA batteries (not included). Insert them into the remote control's battery compartment, observing correct polarity.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Manual Operation (Child Control)

- **Start:** Press the one-click start button.
- **Steering:** Use the steering wheel to control direction.
- **Acceleration:** Press the foot pedal to move forward.
- **Braking:** Release the foot pedal to engage the brake. The soft start function ensures smooth acceleration and deceleration.

Parental Remote Control Operation

The 2.4GHz remote control allows parents to guide the vehicle. The remote control can override manual operation for safety.

- **Forward/Backward:** Use the directional buttons to move the truck.
- **Left/Right:** Use the directional buttons to steer.
- **Speed Adjustment:** Select from 3 adjustable speeds (1.86-2.37-3 mph).

- **Emergency Brake:** Press the 'P' button on the remote to stop the vehicle immediately.

Soft Start Function

The vehicle is equipped with a soft start function to prevent sudden acceleration, ensuring a smooth and comfortable ride for the child.

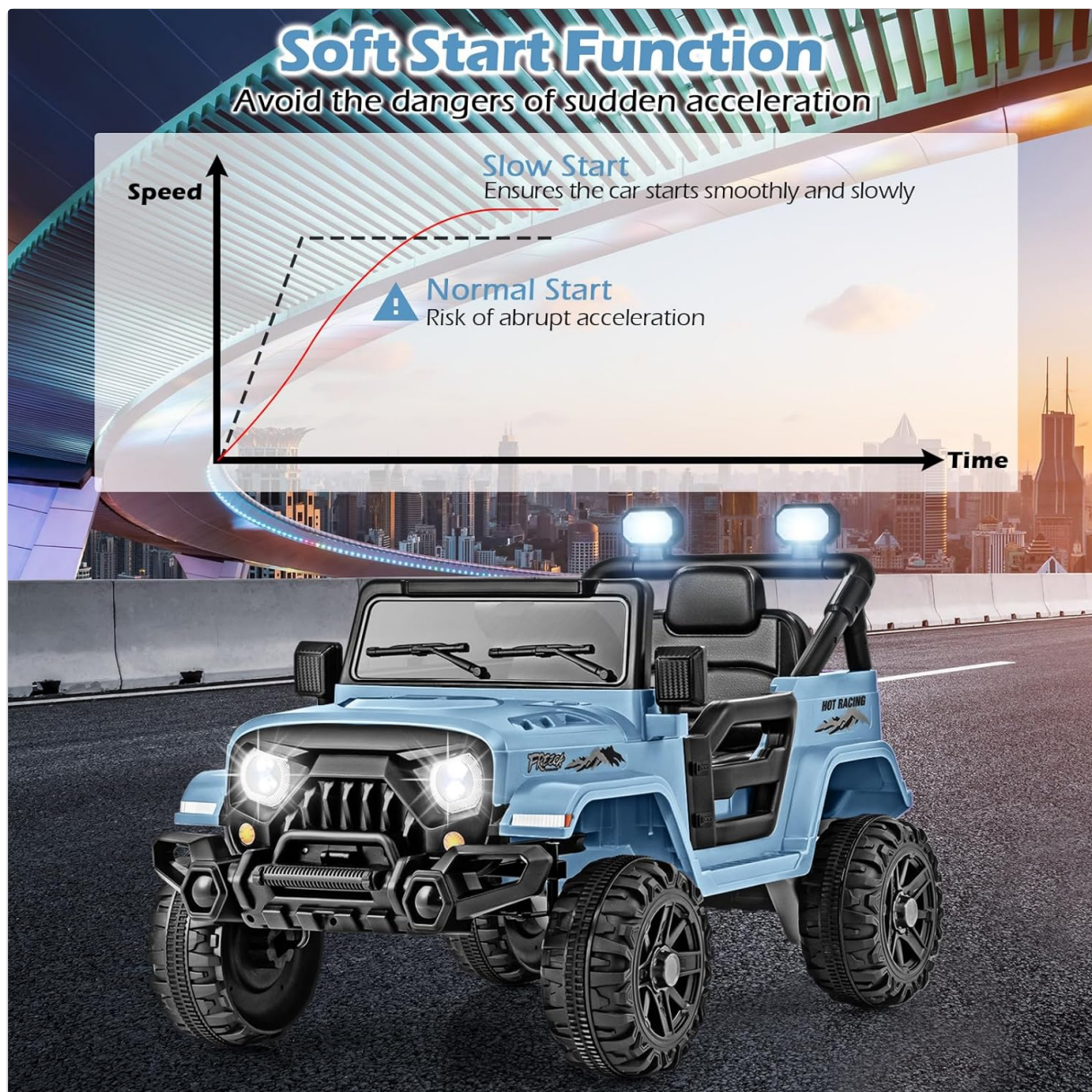

Multimedia Functions

- **Music Player:** Built-in music, Bluetooth connectivity, USB port, and MP3 input allow for playing various audio.
- **Controls:** Buttons on the steering wheel control music playback and horn.
- **LED Lights:** Bright LED headlights and searching lights enhance the driving experience.

MAINTENANCE

Battery Care

- Recharge the 12V battery for 8-12 hours after each use.
- Do not allow the battery to fully discharge.
- If the vehicle is not used for an extended period, charge the battery at least once a month to prolong its lifespan.
- Average battery life for play is 90 minutes (1-2 hours).

General Care

- Clean the vehicle with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Store the vehicle in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and moisture.
- Regularly inspect wheels and connections for wear and tear.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vehicle does not move	Battery is low or not connected; Power switch off; Loose wiring.	Charge battery fully; Ensure power switch is on; Check all connections.
Short play time after full charge	Battery not fully charged; Old battery; Overloaded vehicle.	Ensure 8-12 hour charge; Replace battery if old; Reduce load.
Remote control not working	AAA batteries low or incorrectly installed; Remote not paired.	Replace/reinstall AAA batteries; Refer to remote pairing instructions (if applicable).
Vehicle moves slowly	Low battery; Overloaded; Operating on rough terrain.	Charge battery; Reduce load; Move to smoother surface.
