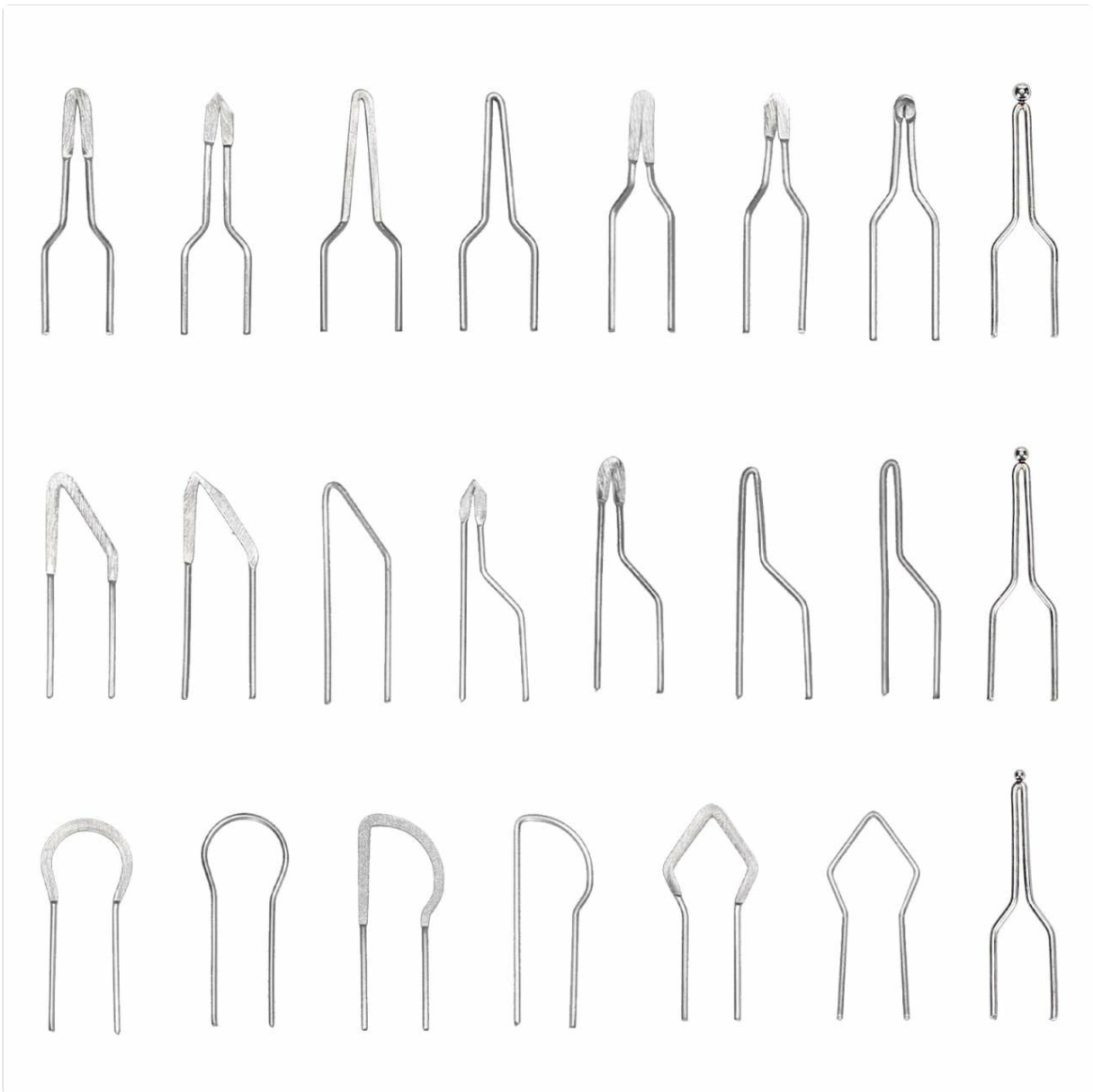


Image 1.1: The YIHUA Pyrography Tips Set, including various metal tips, a small wooden board, and a storage tin.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation of pyrography tips is crucial for safe and effective operation. Always ensure your pyrography station is turned off and completely cooled before handling tips.

1. **Power Off and Cool Down:** Ensure your YIHUA pyrography station is powered off and unplugged. Allow the handpiece and any previously used tips to cool down completely to prevent burns.
2. **Select Tip:** Choose the desired pyrography tip from the set based on your artistic needs.
3. **Install Tip:** Carefully insert the base of the chosen tip into the designated receptacle on your pyrography handpiece. Ensure the tip is seated firmly and securely. Do not force the tip.
4. **Check Connection:** Gently tug on the tip to confirm it is properly secured and will not loosen during use.
5. **Power On:** Once the tip is securely installed, you may plug in and power on your pyrography station.

Safety Note: Never attempt to change tips while the station is powered on or hot. Always use appropriate heat-resistant gloves if handling tips that may still be warm.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

These tips are designed to be used with compatible YIHUA pyrography stations. Refer to your station's instruction manual for detailed operating procedures, temperature settings, and safety guidelines.

- **Temperature Control:** Adjust the temperature on your pyrography station according to the type of wood or material you are working on and the desired effect. Start with lower temperatures and gradually increase as needed.
- **Practice:** Before working on your final project, practice on scrap pieces of the same material to familiarize yourself with the tip's performance and temperature requirements.
- **Ventilation:** Always work in a well-ventilated area to avoid inhaling fumes produced during wood burning.
- **Steady Hand:** Maintain a steady hand and consistent pressure for even burning.
- **Tip Selection:** Experiment with different tips to achieve various textures, lines, and shading effects.

Caution: Pyrography tips become extremely hot during operation. Avoid direct contact with skin or flammable materials. Always place the hot handpiece in its designated stand when not in use.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance extends the life of your pyrography tips and ensures consistent performance.

- **Cleaning Tips:** After each use, and once the tips have completely cooled, gently clean them to remove carbon buildup. A brass brush or fine-grit sandpaper can be used. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect tips for any signs of wear, bending, or damage. Replace damaged tips immediately to prevent inconsistent results or potential hazards.
- **Storage:** Store the tips in their original container or a dry, secure place to protect them from damage.

- **Avoid Overheating:** Prolonged use at excessively high temperatures can shorten the lifespan of the tips. Use the lowest effective temperature for your projects.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Tip not heating or heating unevenly.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Loose connection in handpiece.• Incompatible station model.• Excessive carbon buildup.• Damaged tip.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure tip is securely seated.• Verify station compatibility (refer to Section 2).• Clean the tip thoroughly.• Replace the tip.
Poor burning quality or inconsistent lines.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Incorrect temperature setting.• Dirty tip.• Inappropriate tip for the task.• Material surface issues.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adjust station temperature.• Clean the tip.• Select a different tip.• Ensure material is clean and dry.
