# SUAAT S3 10-inch Android 14 Tablet User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your SUAAT S3 10-inch Android 14 Tablet. Please read this manual thoroughly before using your device to ensure proper functionality and to maximize your user experience. Keep this manual for future reference.

### 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The SUAAT S3 tablet is designed for versatile use, featuring an octa-core processor and the Android 14 operating system for enhanced performance and user experience.

#### Key Features:

- **Processor:** Octa-core A523, up to 1.8GHz for smooth operation.
- **Operating System:** Android 14, offering improved security, privacy, and efficiency.
- **Memory & Storage:** 20GB RAM (14GB virtual + 6GB physical) and 128GB ROM, expandable up to 1TB via microSD card.
- **Display:** 10.1-inch IPS HD display with 1280 x 800 resolution, supporting Widevine L1 for high-quality streaming.
- **Cameras:** 5MP front camera and 8MP rear camera for video calls and photography.
- **Battery:** 6000mAh capacity for extended usage.
- **Connectivity:** Dual-band Wi-Fi 6 (5G+2.4G) and Bluetooth 5.0.

- **Audio:** Dual stereo speakers for immersive sound and a 3.5mm headphone jack.

## 4. SETUP

### 4.1 Charging the Tablet

Before first use, fully charge the tablet using the provided charger and USB-C cable. Connect the USB-C cable to the tablet's charging port and the adapter to a power outlet. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging status.

### 4.2 Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button until the SUAAT logo appears on the screen.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button, then select 'Power off' from the options that appear.
- **To Restart:** Press and hold the Power button, then select 'Restart' from the options.

### 4.3 Initial Setup

Upon first power-on, the tablet will guide you through the initial setup process. Follow the on-screen prompts to:

- Select your language.
- Connect to a Wi-Fi network.
- Sign in with your Google account or create a new one.
- Set up screen lock (PIN, pattern, password, or face unlock).

### 4.4 Inserting a MicroSD Card

To expand storage up to 1TB, locate the microSD card slot on the side of the tablet. Gently insert a compatible microSD card into the slot until it clicks into place. The tablet will prompt you to format the card for use.

### 4.5 Connecting Keyboard and Mouse

The included keyboard and mouse connect wirelessly via Bluetooth.

- **Keyboard:** Turn on the keyboard. On your tablet, go to **Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth**, and pair with the keyboard.
- **Mouse:** Insert 2xAAA batteries into the mouse. The mouse dongle is typically stored in the battery

compartment. Plug the USB dongle into the provided USB-A to USB-C adapter, then connect the adapter to the tablet's USB-C port. The mouse should connect automatically.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 5.1 Basic Navigation

The tablet uses standard Android touch gestures:

- **Tap:** Select an item or open an app.
- **Swipe:** Scroll through pages or lists.
- **Pinch:** Zoom in or out on images and web pages.
- **Long Press:** Access contextual menus or move icons.

### 5.2 Wi-Fi and Bluetooth Connectivity

Access these settings via **Settings > Network & internet** for Wi-Fi or **Settings > Connected devices** for Bluetooth. Ensure Wi-Fi 6 is enabled for optimal wireless performance.



### 5.3 Using the Cameras

Open the Camera app to capture photos and videos. The tablet features a 5MP front camera and an 8MP rear camera. Tap the screen to focus and press the shutter button to capture.

### 5.4 Split-Screen Functionality

The tablet supports split-screen mode, allowing you to run two applications simultaneously. To activate, open a recent apps view, long-press an app icon, and select 'Split screen'. Choose a second app to fill the other half of the screen.

### 5.5 Widevine L1 Support

With Widevine L1 certification, the SUAAT S3 tablet can stream high-definition content (1080p) from supported streaming services, providing a clear and immersive viewing experience.

The S3 tablet is powered by the Octa-Core processor which improves running speed, reduces power consumption and extends battery life.

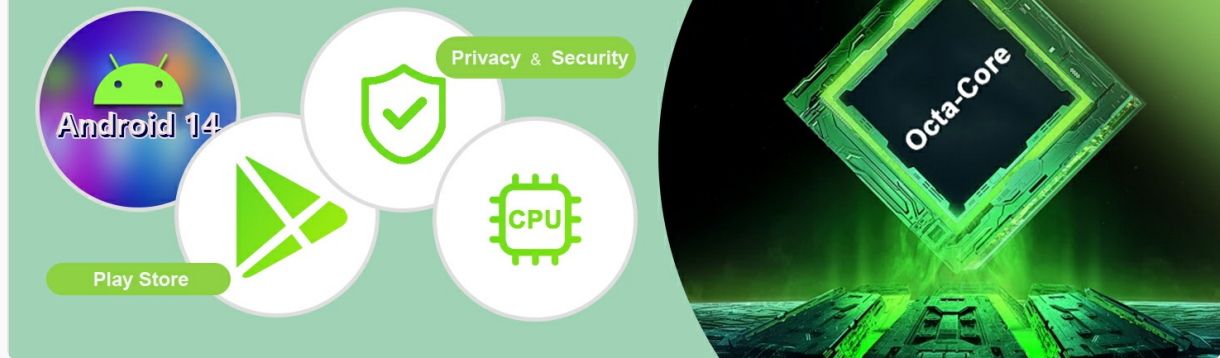


Image: A visual comparison of Widevine L1 and L3, demonstrating the tablet's ability to display 1080p video quality for streaming services.

### 5.6 Face Unlock

Set up face unlock for convenient and secure access to your tablet. Go to **Settings > Security & privacy > Face unlock** and follow the instructions to register your face.

### 5.7 Screen Casting

## 5.8 Connecting to a Printer

The SUAAT S3 tablet can connect to compatible printers via Bluetooth 5.0. Ensure your printer supports Bluetooth printing. Go to **Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth** to pair with your printer and follow the printer's instructions for setup.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

- For optimal battery longevity, keep the charge level between 20% and 80%.

### 6.2 Cleaning the Device

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the tablet. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-cleaning solution. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

### 6.3 Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure your tablet has the latest features, security patches, and performance improvements. Go to **Settings > System > System update**

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your SUAAT S3 tablet, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Solution

Problem	Solution
Tablet does not power on	Ensure the tablet is charged. Connect it to the charger for at least 30 minutes, then try powering on again. If unresponsive, perform a force restart by holding the Power button for 10-15 seconds.
Wi-Fi connection issues	Check if Wi-Fi is enabled in Settings. Restart your router and the tablet. Forget the network and reconnect. Ensure you are within range of the Wi-Fi signal.
Slow performance or freezing	Close unused apps running in the background. Clear app caches (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache > Clear cache). Restart the tablet. Ensure sufficient storage space is available.
Keyboard/Mouse not connecting	Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on the tablet and the keyboard/mouse are powered on and in pairing mode. For the mouse, verify batteries are installed correctly and the USB dongle is connected. Re-pair the devices if necessary.
Apps crashing or not responding	Update the app to its latest version. Clear the app's cache and data (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache). Reinstall the app if the issue persists.
