1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your new Blackview Tab 60WiFi Android 15 Tablet. This guide provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your device. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your tablet.

The Blackview Tab 60WiFi is designed for efficient work, immersive entertainment, and seamless connectivity, featuring an octa-core processor, a 10.1-inch HD+ IPS display, Wi-Fi 6, and Bluetooth 5.3.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

2.1 Key Features

- **Processor:** Octa-core for smooth multitasking and application performance.
- **Display:** 10.1-inch HD+ IPS screen (1280x800 resolution, 60Hz refresh rate, 300 nits brightness) with Widevine L1 support for high-definition streaming.
- **Memory & Storage:** 4GB RAM (expandable to 12GB virtual RAM) and 128GB internal storage, expandable up to 2TB via TF card.
- **Connectivity:** Wi-Fi 6 for ultra-fast and stable wireless connections, Bluetooth 5.3 for enhanced device pairing.
- **Battery:** 5100mAh high-capacity battery with 10W fast charging support.
- **Cameras:** 8MP rear camera and 5MP front camera.
- **Operating System:** Android 15 with continuous update support.
- **Design:** Sleek all-metal body, 8.5mm thin, weighing 538g.

3. SETUP

3.1 Initial Charging

1. Connect the provided USB cable to the tablet's Type-C port and the power adapter.
2. Plug the power adapter into a wall outlet.
3. Allow the tablet to charge until the battery indicator shows a full charge before first use.

3.2 Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button located on the side of the tablet until the Blackview logo appears.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button, then select 'Power off' from the options on the screen.
- **To Restart:** Press and hold the Power button, then select 'Restart' from the options on the screen.

3.3 Initial Setup Wizard

Upon first power-on, the tablet will guide you through an initial setup process:

1. Select your preferred language.
2. Connect to a Wi-Fi network.
3. Sign in with your Google account or create a new one. This is essential for accessing the Google Play Store and other Google services.
4. Follow the on-screen prompts to set up security features (PIN, pattern, or password) and other preferences.

3.4 Inserting a MicroSD Card (Optional)

To expand storage, you can insert a microSD (TF) card up to 2TB:

1. Locate the SIM/microSD card tray on the side of the tablet.
2. Use the provided ejector tool to open the tray.
3. Place the microSD card into the designated slot with the gold contacts facing down.
4. Gently push the tray back into the tablet until it clicks into place.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Basic Navigation

- **Tap:** Select an item or open an app.
- **Swipe:** Scroll through screens or lists.
- **Pinch:** Zoom in or out on images and web pages.
- **Long Press:** Access contextual menus or move icons.

4.2 Wi-Fi 6 Connectivity

To connect to a Wi-Fi 6 network:

1. Go to **Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi**.
2. Turn on Wi-Fi. The tablet will scan for available networks.
3. Select your desired Wi-Fi 6 network and enter the password if prompted.

4.3 Bluetooth 5.3 Pairing

To pair with a Bluetooth device:

1. Go to **Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth**.
2. Turn on Bluetooth.
3. Ensure your Bluetooth device is in pairing mode.
4. Select your device from the list and follow any on-screen instructions to complete pairing.

4.4 Using the Cameras

The tablet features an 8MP rear camera and a 5MP front camera.

- Open the **Camera** app from your home screen or app drawer.
- Tap the camera switch icon to toggle between front and rear cameras.
- Tap the shutter button to take a photo or start/stop video recording.

4.5 Media Consumption with Widevine L1

The Blackview Tab 60WiFi supports Widevine L1, allowing you to stream high-definition content from services like Netflix, Disney+, and Hulu. Simply download the respective apps from the Google Play Store and log in to enjoy your content in crisp detail.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Tablet

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the tablet.
- For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-cleaning solution.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

5.2 Battery Care

- To prolong battery life, avoid extreme temperatures.
- Use the provided 10W charger for efficient and safe charging.
- It is recommended to keep the battery charge between 20% and 80% for optimal long-term health, though occasional full charges/discharges are acceptable.

5.3 Software Updates

Your tablet runs on Android 15 and receives continuous update support. Regularly check for and install system updates to ensure your device has the latest features, security patches, and performance improvements.

1. Go to **Settings > System > System update**.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to check for and install any available updates.

5.4 Storage Management

With 128GB of internal storage and support for up to 2TB via TF card, you have ample space. To manage your storage:

- Go to **Settings > Storage** to view storage usage.
- Delete unnecessary files, apps, or move them to the microSD card to free up space.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1 Common Issues and Solutions

- **Tablet not powering on:** Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to the charger for at least 30 minutes, then try powering on again.
- **Wi-Fi connection issues:** Restart your tablet and Wi-Fi router. Forget the network in settings and reconnect.
- **Slow performance:** Close unused apps, clear cache, or free up storage space. Consider a factory reset as a last resort.
- **Apps crashing:** Ensure apps are updated. Clear the app's cache and data in Settings > Apps. Reinstall the app if the issue persists.

6.2 Factory Reset

A factory reset will erase all data on your tablet and restore it to its original factory settings. **Backup all important data before proceeding.**






1. Go to **Settings > System > Reset options**.
2. Select **Erase all data (factory reset)**.
3. Confirm your decision and enter your PIN/pattern/password if prompted.
