1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Sheawasy Digital Camera SHXJ-02. This compact and user-friendly camera is designed for beginners, offering 1080P Full HD photo and video capabilities. It features dual screens, a 16X digital zoom, and an LED fill light, making it suitable for capturing everyday moments, selfies, and vlogs. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your camera.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

3. SETUP

3.1 Battery Installation and Charging

The camera is powered by an included Lithium Polymer battery. Ensure the battery is fully charged before initial use. Connect the camera to a power source using the provided USB cable. The charging indicator will show the charging status.

3.2 Memory Card Insertion

A 32GB memory card is included with your camera. Locate the memory card slot, typically on the side or bottom of the camera. Insert the memory card gently until it clicks into place. Ensure it is inserted in the correct orientation to avoid damage.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Power On/Off

To power on the camera, press and hold the Power button located on the top of the device. To power off, press and hold the Power button again until the screen turns off.

4.2 Taking Photos

- 1. Turn on the camera.
- 2. Frame your shot using either the main rear screen or the front screen for selfies.
- 3. The camera features autofocus. Allow it a moment to adjust for clarity.
- 4. Press the Shutter button firmly to capture the photo.

4.3 Recording Videos

- 1. Turn on the camera.
- 2. Switch to video recording mode using the Mode button.
- 3. Press the Shutter button once to start recording.
- 4. Press the Shutter button again to stop recording.

4.4 Using Dual Screens

The camera is equipped with a 2.4-inch main screen on the back and a 1.5-inch front screen. The front screen is particularly useful for:

- Selfies: Easily compose self-portraits.
- Vlogging: Monitor your framing while recording videos of yourself.
- Composition Adjustment: Ensure everyone is in the frame for group shots.

4.5 Digital Zoom

Use the Zoom In (+) and Zoom Out (-) buttons to digitally magnify or reduce your subject. The camera features 16X digital zoom. Note that digital zoom may reduce image quality compared to optical zoom.

4.6 LED Fill Light

For shooting in low-light environments, activate the built-in LED fill light. Refer to the camera's menu or a dedicated button (if available) to toggle this feature on or off.




Figure 4.3: LED Fill Light in Action

4.7 Music Playback Function

The camera includes a music playback feature. Press the dedicated MP3 button to access music files stored on the memory card. You can connect headphones via the 3.5mm audio jack for private listening.




Figure 4.4: Music Functionality

4.8 Playback Mode

To review your captured photos and videos, switch to Playback mode using the Mode button. Use the navigation buttons to browse through your media. Press the OK button to view a selected item.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Camera

- Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the camera body.
- For the lens and screens, use a specialized lens cleaning cloth and solution to avoid scratches.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

5.2 Storage

Store the camera in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. If storing for an

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- Camera not turning on: Ensure the battery is fully charged and correctly inserted.
- Images are blurry or dark: Check lighting conditions. Use the LED fill light in low light. Hold the camera steady during capture. Note that this is an entry-level camera, and image quality expectations should be set accordingly.
- Cannot view images on camera: Ensure you are in Playback mode. Navigate through files using the directional buttons.
- **Memory card error:** Reinsert the memory card. If the issue persists, try formatting the card (this will erase all data) or use a different compatible memory card.
- Camera freezes: Remove and reinsert the battery to reset the camera.


