1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your iDPRT MT610 Pro Portable Thermal Printer. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device and retain it for future reference.

The iDPRT MT610 Pro is a compact, inkless thermal printer designed for portability and convenience. It supports various paper sizes including US Letter, A4, and A5, and offers 300 DPI print resolution for documents. Connectivity options include Bluetooth for mobile devices and USB for computers.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The iDPRT MT610 Pro printer features a compact design for easy portability. Key physical dimensions are approximately 10.2 inches (length) x 2.2 inches (width) x 1.5 inches (height), and it weighs about 1.1 pounds (498g).

The printer operates without ink cartridges, utilizing thermal paper for printing. It is equipped with a 2000mAh battery, providing extended use on a single charge.

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Printer

Before initial use, fully charge the printer using the provided USB-C cable. Connect the USB-C cable to the printer and a compatible power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter). The charging indicator light will provide status feedback.

4.2 Loading Thermal Paper

The MT610 Pro supports various thermal paper sizes, including US Letter (8.5" x 11"), A4, A5, and B5. Ensure you use only thermal paper with this printer.

1. Open the printer's paper cover.
2. Insert the thermal paper with the printable side facing up. Ensure the paper is aligned correctly within the guides.
3. Close the paper cover securely.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Mobile Printing (Bluetooth Connection)

To print from your smartphone or tablet, follow these steps:

1. **Download the "HerePrint" App:** Search for "HerePrint" in your device's app store (App Store for iOS, Google Play for Android) or scan the QR code provided in the Quick Start Guide. [Download HerePrint App](#)
2. **Turn on the Printer:** Press and hold the power button on the MT610 Pro until the indicator light illuminates.
3. **Connect via Bluetooth:** Open the "HerePrint" app. In the app, navigate to the device connection section. Turn on Bluetooth on your mobile device and select the MT610 Pro from the list of available devices to pair.
4. **Select and Print:** Once connected, use the app to select the document or image you wish to print. Follow the on-screen prompts to initiate printing.

5.2 Computer Printing (USB Connection)

To print from your computer (Windows, macOS, Linux, ChromeOS), follow these steps:

1. **Connect the Printer:** Use the provided USB-C cable to connect the MT610 Pro to your computer. Ensure the printer is powered on.
2. **Install Drivers:** Download the appropriate printer driver for your operating system from the official iDPRT website. [iDPRT Driver Download Page](#) Install the driver following the on-screen instructions.

3. **Print Document:** Open the document you wish to print (e.g., Word, Excel, PDF). Select "Print" from the application menu. In the print dialog box, choose "iDPRT MT610 Pro" as your printer and configure paper size settings as needed. Initiate printing.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning the Printer

Regular cleaning helps maintain print quality and extends the life of your printer.

- Ensure the printer is turned off and disconnected from any power source before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or isopropyl alcohol to gently wipe the exterior of the printer.
- To clean the thermal print head, use a specialized thermal printer cleaning pen or a cotton swab lightly dampened with isopropyl alcohol. Gently wipe the print head surface. Allow it to dry completely before use.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

6.2 Battery Care

To optimize battery life:

- Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.
- Store the printer in a cool, dry place when not in use for extended periods.
- Charge the printer regularly, even if not used, to maintain battery health.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your iDPRT MT610 Pro printer.

7.1 Printer Not Connecting via Bluetooth

- Ensure the printer is powered on and within range of your mobile device.
- Verify Bluetooth is enabled on your mobile device.
- Restart both the printer and your mobile device.
- Ensure the "HerePrint" app is installed and updated to the latest version.
- If previously paired, try unpairing and re-pairing the device in your mobile device's Bluetooth settings.

7.2 Printer Not Recognized by Computer (USB)

- Confirm the USB-C cable is securely connected to both the printer and the computer.
- Ensure the printer is powered on.
- Verify that the correct printer drivers for your operating system are installed. If not, download them from the official iDPRT website.
- Try connecting to a different USB port on your computer.
- Restart your computer and the printer.

7.3 Poor Print Quality or Blank Pages

- Ensure you are using thermal paper and that it is loaded correctly with the printable side facing up.
- Check if the thermal paper is old or damaged, as this can affect print quality.
- Clean the thermal print head as described in the Maintenance section.
- For images, avoid printing entirely black images as this printer is optimized for documents and may not produce optimal results for high-density black areas.

7.4 Paper Jam

- Turn off the printer immediately.
- Open the paper cover and carefully remove any jammed paper. Avoid tearing the paper inside the mechanism.
- Ensure paper is loaded correctly and not wrinkled or bent before printing.

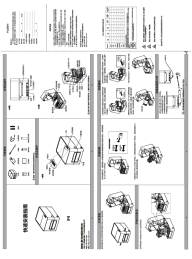
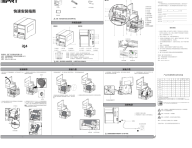
