# LOUTOC TCL Smart TV Voice Remote Control User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the LOUTOC TCL Smart TV Voice Remote Control, designed for use with TCL Android/Google TV models. It covers setup, operation, maintenance, troubleshooting, and product specifications to ensure optimal performance and user experience.

The remote control features voice functionality and dedicated shortcut buttons for popular streaming services and TV functions.

## 3. SETUP AND PAIRING

### 3.1. Battery Installation

The remote control requires 2 x AAA batteries (not included). To install:

1. Open the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote control.
2. Insert two AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+ and -).
3. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

### 3.2. Voice Function Pairing Steps

To enable the voice control feature, the remote must be paired with your TCL Android/Google TV. Follow these steps:

1. Press the **Voice button** (microphone icon) on the remote control first.
2. Press and hold the **HOME** (house icon) and **OK** (center button) buttons on the remote control simultaneously.
3. Keep the remote control within one meter (approximately 3 feet) of the TV during the pairing process.
4. When your TV displays "Google Assistant" on the screen, the pairing process is complete, and the voice function is ready for use.

## Pairing Steps :




- 1 Press the Voice button (  ) firstly.
- 2 Press and hold the "  " and "  " buttons on the remote control at the same time.
- 3 Keep the remote within 3ft of the TV during the pairing process.
- 4 Finally, when the TV displays **Google Assistant** everything is ready.

Follow the on-screen guide to pair the remote control with the TV when pressing the Google Assistant button for the first time. Google TV is the name of this device's software experience and a trademark of Google LLC. The Google Assistant is not available in certain languages and countries.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The LOUTOC remote control provides intuitive access to your TCL Smart TV's features. Below is a guide to its main functions:



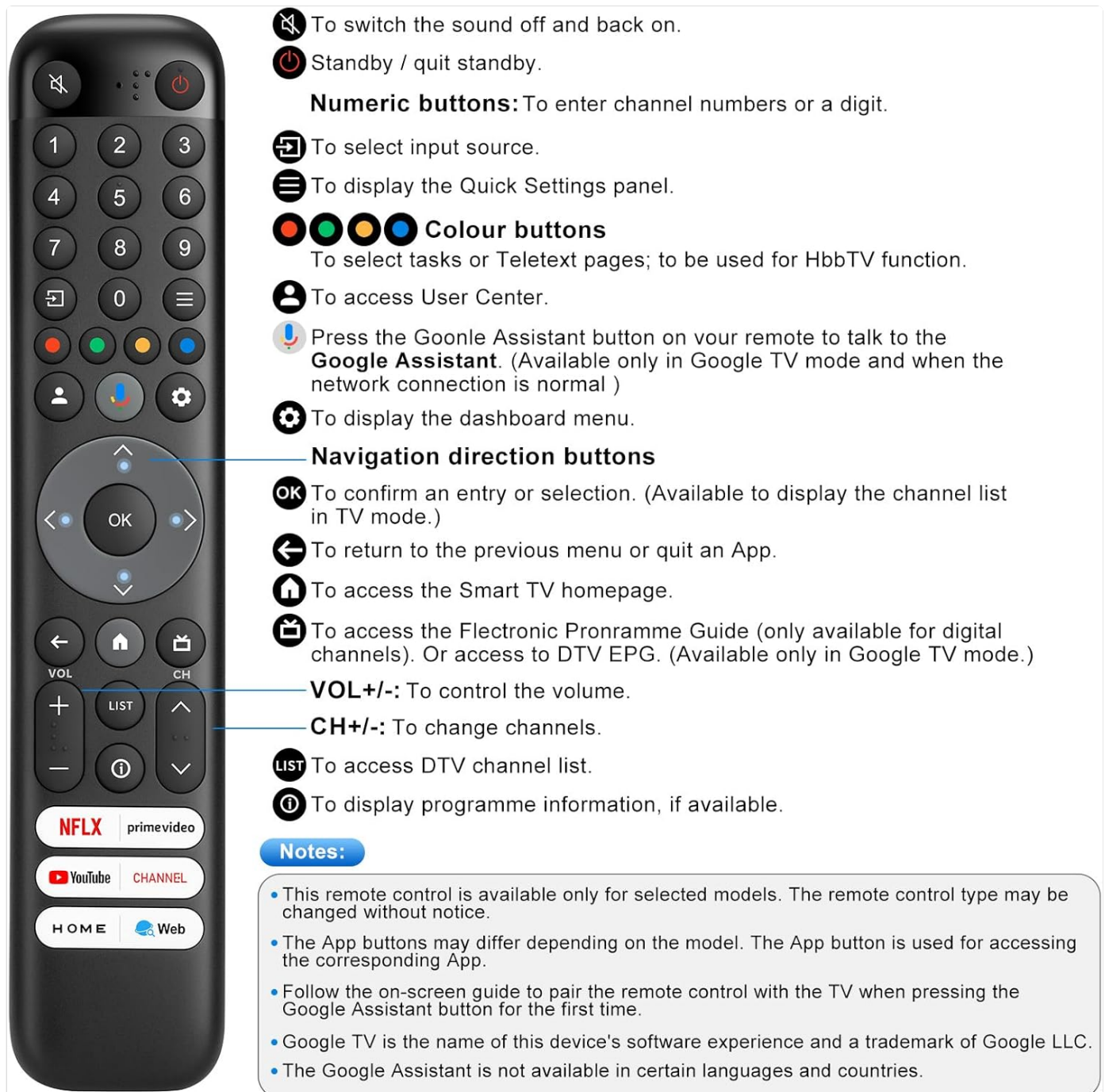


Image: An overview of the remote control's buttons and their corresponding functions.

**Power Button ( ):** To switch the TV on and off, or put it in standby.

**Numeric Buttons (0-9):** To enter channel numbers or digits.

**Quick Settings Button (≡):** To display the Quick Settings panel.

**Colour Buttons (Red, Green, Yellow, Blue):** Used for HbbTV functions or Teletext pages.

**User Center Button ( ):** To access the User Center.

**Google Assistant Button ( ):** Press to talk to Google Assistant. (Available only in Google TV mode and when network connection is normal).

**Dashboard Menu Button (⚙):** To display the dashboard menu.

**Navigation Direction Buttons (◀, ▶, ▲, ▼):** For navigating menus and options.

**OK Button (OK):** To confirm an entry or selection. (Available to display the channel list in TV mode).

**Back Button (←):** To return to the previous menu or exit an App.

**Home Button ( ):** To access the Smart TV homepage.

**EPG/Guide Button ( ):** To access the Electronic Program Guide (EPG) (only available for digital channels). Or access to DTV EPG. (Available only in Google TV mode).

**Volume Buttons (VOL +/-):** To control the volume.

**Channel Buttons (CH +/-):** To change channels.

**List Button (LIST):** To access DTV channel list.

**Information Button ( ):** To display program information, if available.

## 4.1. Shortcut Buttons

The remote control includes dedicated shortcut buttons for quick access to popular streaming services and functions:

- **Netflix**
- **Prime Video**
- **YouTube**
- **TCL Channel**
- **TCL Home**
- **Web**

## 5. MAINTENANCE

- Keep the remote control clean by wiping it with a soft, dry cloth.
- Avoid exposing the remote control to extreme temperatures, humidity, or direct sunlight.
- Do not drop the remote control or subject it to strong impacts.
- If the remote control will not be used for an extended period, remove the batteries to prevent leakage.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
---------	---------------------------

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Remote control not responding.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Check if batteries are inserted correctly and have sufficient charge. Replace if necessary.</li><li>• Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote control and the TV's IR receiver.</li><li>• Re-pair the remote control with the TV if using voice or Bluetooth functions.</li></ul>
Voice function not working.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ensure the remote is properly paired with the TV (refer to Section 3.2).</li><li>• Verify that the TV has a stable internet connection.</li><li>• Confirm that the TV is in Google TV mode.</li><li>• Check if Google Assistant is supported in your region and language.</li></ul>
Limited range or delayed response.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Replace batteries with new ones.</li><li>• Ensure you are within the effective transmission distance (up to 8 meters / 26 feet).</li><li>• Minimize interference from other electronic devices.</li></ul>
