SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety is paramount. Please adhere to the following guidelines:

- Always follow the assembly instructions carefully.
- Ensure the gazebo is assembled on a stable, level surface.
- Do not exceed the weight limit of **44 lbs** on the roof.
- Be cautious when handling sharp edges and heavy components during assembly and disassembly.
- Securely anchor the gazebo to the ground to prevent wind damage.
- In extreme weather conditions (e.g., heavy snow, strong winds), it is recommended to remove curtains and netting and take additional precautions to secure the structure.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly typically requires 3-4 people and takes approximately 2-4 hours. Careful organization and adherence to the provided instructions are crucial for a successful setup.

Preparation

- Unpack all components and verify against the parts list.
- Lay out all parts and hardware in an organized manner to facilitate easy access.
- Ensure you have all necessary tools as specified in the assembly guide.

Frame Assembly

Begin by assembling the main aluminum frame. The thick powder-coated aluminum frame provides strong load-bearing capacity and wind resistance.

Roof Installation

The double galvanized steel roof is designed for durability and weather resistance. When installing roof panels, ensure they are correctly aligned and secured. It is recommended to loosely fasten screws initially and tighten them fully once all panels are in

place to allow for adjustments.

Curtains and Netting

The gazebo includes netting with zippers and curtains with binding belts for privacy and insect protection. These can be easily installed along the tracks.

Anchoring

Four ground piles and expansion screws are included to add extra durability and safety. Ensure the gazebo is securely anchored to prevent movement, especially in windy conditions.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Curtains and Netting Usage

- The netting can be zipped closed to provide insect protection while maintaining ventilation.
- The curtains can be drawn for privacy or tied back with the provided binding belts to keep the space open.

Multifunctional Top Design

The gazebo roof includes hooks to hang decorations such as lights or fans, enhancing your outdoor experience.

MAINTENANCE

- Regularly inspect all bolts and connections to ensure they remain tight.
- Clean the galvanized steel roof and aluminum frame with mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Periodically clean the netting and curtains according to their fabric care instructions to maintain appearance and functionality.
- Clear any debris, such as leaves or snow, from the roof to prevent excessive weight accumulation. Remember the roof weight limit is 44 lbs.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Assembly Difficulties

- If parts do not align, re-check the instruction manual for correct orientation and ensure all screws are loose enough to allow for adjustment.
- Ensure you have enough people to assist with lifting and securing larger components, especially the roof.

Water Accumulation

The gazebo features a slope drainage system to prevent rainwater accumulation. If water collects, check for any blockages in the drainage channels or ensure the roof panels are correctly installed.
