INTRODUCTION

Welcome to your new Neretva Burr Coffee Grinder. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your appliance. Please read it thoroughly before first use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your grinder.

PRODUCT FEATURES

- Professional Conical Burr Grinding Technology:** Ensures uniform grinding for optimal flavor extraction.
- 30 Precise Grinding Settings:** Customize grind fineness for various brewing methods, from espresso to French press.
- 2-in-1 Design for Espresso:** Includes a portafilter holder suitable for 51mm and 58mm portafilters for direct grinding.
- Anti-Static & Minimal Residue:** Equipped with a plasma generator and 20° angled powder outlet to reduce clumping and mess.
- Precision Electronic Timer:** Adjust grind time up to 60 seconds for precise control.

COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the main components of your coffee grinder:

- Bean Hopper:** Transparent container for holding whole coffee beans.
- Grind Adjustment Collar:** Rotatable ring with numbered settings to select grind fineness.
- Control Panel:** LED touch screen with manual grind, time adjustment (+/-), and start/pause buttons.
- Grind Outlet:** Chute from which ground coffee is dispensed.
- Portafilter Cradle:** Adjustable holder for direct grinding into espresso portafilters.
- Ground Coffee Container:** Clear container for collecting ground coffee when not using a portafilter.
- Cleaning Brush:** Small brush for removing residual coffee grounds.
- Silicone Air Blower:** Accessory for clearing fine coffee grounds.

SETUP

- Unpack all components and remove any protective packaging materials.
- Place the grinder on a stable, flat, and dry surface, ensuring adequate ventilation.

3. Ensure the bean hopper is securely seated on the grinder base.
4. Connect the power cord to a suitable 120V electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Filling the Bean Hopper

Remove the lid from the bean hopper and pour fresh, whole coffee beans into the hopper. Replace the lid securely.

2. Adjusting Grind Settings

The grinder offers 30 precise grind settings. Rotate the grind adjustment collar to select your desired fineness. The arrow

on the base indicates the current setting.

- **Espresso:** Settings 1-10 (finer grind)
- **Drip/Pour Over:** Settings 10-20 (medium grind)
- **French Press/Cold Brew:** Settings 20-30 (coarser grind)

3. Grinding Coffee

You can grind coffee directly into a portafilter or the provided container.

Grinding into a Portafilter:

Attach the portafilter cradle to the machine. Adjust its height using the side knob to fit your 51mm or 58mm portafilter. Place your portafilter securely in the cradle.

Grinding into the Ground Coffee Container:

Remove the portafilter cradle. Place the provided ground coffee container on the base. Ensure the lid's opening aligns with the grind outlet.

Compact size, Large Capacity

6.34oz bean hopper can make 15~20 cups of coffee at a time.

Using the Control Panel:

The LED touch screen allows for both manual and timed grinding.

- **Manual Grinding:** Press the button with the finger icon to start grinding. Release the button to stop.
- **Timed Grinding:** Use the '+' and '-' buttons to set the desired grinding time (from 1 to 60 seconds, with 0.1s increments for 1-25s and 1s increments for 26-60s). Press the play/pause button to start. The grinder will automatically stop when the set time is reached.

MAINTENANCE & CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures consistent performance and extends the life of your grinder.

- **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, use the provided cleaning brush to remove any residual coffee grounds from the grind outlet and around the burrs.
- **Hopper Cleaning:** The bean hopper can be removed for thorough cleaning. It is not dishwasher safe; wash with warm water and mild soap, then dry completely before reattaching.
- **Anti-Static Feature:** The built-in plasma generator minimizes static electricity, but occasional residue is normal.

Use the silicone air blower (if included) to clear any remaining grounds from the grind path.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your grinder, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Grinder not starting:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged in. Check that the bean hopper lid is properly closed and seated. Verify there are no coffee beans jamming the burrs.
- **Inconsistent grind:** Confirm the grind setting is appropriate for your brewing method. Clean the burrs and grind path thoroughly to remove any obstructions or build-up.
- **Excessive static/mess:** Ensure the anti-static feature is functioning. Regularly clean the grind path and collection

container to minimize static buildup.





