INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper use and maintenance of your CNBRO M80A Handsfree Bluetooth Headset. Please read this manual carefully before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your device.

SETUP

1. Charging the Headset

Before first use, fully charge the headset. The headset has a built-in battery with a capacity of 150 mAh.

- Connect the provided TYPE-C cable to the charging port on the headset and to a compatible USB power source.
- The charging time is approximately 2 hours.
- A full charge provides up to 20 hours of playtime.

2. Pairing with a Device

The headset uses Bluetooth version 5.3 for stable and efficient connection.

1. Ensure the headset is charged and powered off.
2. Press and hold the Multifunction Button (usually the main power button) for 3 seconds until the indicator light flashes, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, laptop), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "M80A" (or similar name) from the list of found devices to connect.
5. Once connected, the indicator light will change, and you may hear a confirmation tone.

The transmission distance is approximately 12 meters (39 feet) in an open environment.

Simultaneous Connection of Two Devices

The headset can be connected to two Bluetooth devices at the same time, freely switch between the two devices.

Simultaneous Connection of Two Devices: This headset can connect to two Bluetooth devices simultaneously. After pairing with the first device, disable Bluetooth on the first device, then pair with the second device. Once the second device is paired, re-enable Bluetooth on the first device, and the headset should connect to both. You can then switch between them as needed.

Widely Compatible



As long as your device has Bluetooth function, whether you are IOS system or Android system, the headset can be connected and used.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

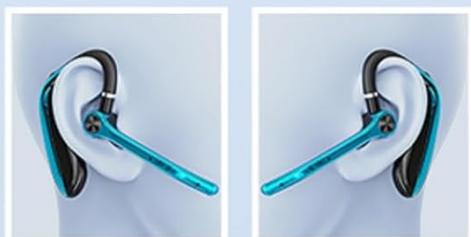
1. Wearing the Headset

The headset is designed for universal use on both the left and right ear.

- The microphone arm can be rotated 270° to position it optimally for your mouth.
- The earpiece angle can be rotated 180° to comfortably fit your ear.
- Adjust the headset for a secure and comfortable fit.

- **'+' Key:**

- Long press: Volume increase

- Double-click: Last number redial
- Click three times: Activate Game mode
- Press for 1 second: Wake up voice assistant

- Hold for 3 seconds: Power On/Off

3. Making and Receiving Calls

The headset features ENC (Environmental Noise Cancelling) technology for clear calls.

- **Answering a Call:** Press the Multifunction Button once.
- **Ending a Call:** Press the Multifunction Button once during a call.
- **Rejecting a Call:** Press and hold the Multifunction Button for approximately 2 seconds.
- **Redialing Last Number:** Double-click the Multifunction Button.
- **Voice Assistant:** Press and hold the Multifunction Button for 1 second to activate your device's voice assistant.

The ENC Noise Cancellation Technology effectively reduces ambient noise, ensuring your calls are clear even in noisy environments.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the headset. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Water Resistance:** The headset has an IPX5 waterproof rating, meaning it is protected against low-pressure water jets from any direction. It is resistant to sweat and light splashes but should not be submerged in water.
- **Storage:** Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the headset regularly, even if not in use for extended periods.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headset does not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headset for at least 30 minutes.
Cannot pair with device.	Bluetooth is off on device; headset not in pairing mode; too far from device.	Ensure Bluetooth is enabled. Put headset in pairing mode (hold Multifunction Button for 3s). Move headset closer to device (within 12m).
No sound or poor sound quality.	Volume too low; headset not properly connected; interference.	Increase volume on headset and device. Re-pair the headset. Move away from sources of interference.
Call quality is poor.	Microphone not positioned correctly; environmental noise.	Adjust the microphone closer to your mouth. Ensure ENC is active. Move to a quieter environment if possible.
