INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Merax Full Size Metal Bunk Bed. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new bunk bed. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

This is a heavy-duty bunk bed. Always assemble with care to prevent injury. Do not exceed the weight capacity of 400lbs for the upper bed and 450lbs for the lower bed. Be cautious of sharp edges and heavy components during assembly and use.

- Always follow the manufacturer's recommended mattress size and thickness.
- Ensure all connections are tight and secure before use. Periodically check and tighten hardware.
- Do not allow children under 6 years of age on the upper bunk.
- Prohibit more than one person on the upper bunk.
- Always use the ladder for entering and exiting the upper bunk.
- Prohibit jumping on the bed.
- Prohibit horseplay on or under the bed.
- Use guardrails on both sides of the upper bunk.
- The use of a night light may provide added safety for a child using the upper bunk.
- If the bunk bed is placed against a wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and the wall.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Merax Bunk Bed requires careful attention to detail. It is recommended to have at least two adults for assembly due to the size and weight of the components. Please ensure you have all parts and hardware before beginning.

Before You Begin:

- Clear a spacious area for assembly, preferably near the final location of the bed.
- Keep children and pets away from the assembly area to prevent accidents.
- Use the provided tools or appropriate household tools. Do not overtighten screws until instructed.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Bunk Beds:

- **Upper Bunk:** Access the upper bunk using the integrated ladder. Ensure the mattress does not exceed the recommended thickness of 6 inches to maintain proper guardrail height.
- **Lower Bunk:** The lower bunk provides a comfortable sleeping area.

Built-in Desk and Light:

- The desk provides a stable surface for studying, working, or placing personal items.
- To activate the integrated light strip, locate the power cord and plug it into a standard electrical outlet. The light is controlled by an inline switch on the cord.

Storage Drawers:

- The two under-bed drawers are on wheels for easy access. Pull them out to store clothing, toys, books, or other items.
- Push them back in completely when not in use to keep the area tidy.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life and ensure the safety of your Merax Bunk Bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down metal and MDF surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they are tight. Retighten if necessary. Do not overtighten.
- **Slats:** Ensure bed slats are properly seated and not damaged. Replace any broken slats immediately.
- **Light:** If the integrated light stops working, check the power connection. If the light strip itself is damaged, contact customer support for assistance. Do not attempt to repair electrical components yourself.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose hardware connections.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure all parts are correctly assembled according to the manual.
Drawers do not slide smoothly.	Obstruction under the drawer; wheels are dirty or damaged.	Clear any debris from under the bed. Clean drawer wheels. Check for damage to wheels or drawer frame.
Integrated light is not working.	Not plugged in; power outlet issue; light strip damage.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check the inline switch. If still not working, contact customer support.

Squeaking noises.	Loose connections; friction between metal parts.	Tighten all hardware. Apply a small amount of silicone lubricant to metal-on-metal contact points if necessary (avoiding areas that contact mattresses).
