1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Dreo 11L Smart Humidifier HM735S. This manual provides important information regarding the safe operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new humidifier. Please read it thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

Important Safety Instructions

- Always place the humidifier on a firm, flat, water-resistant surface at least 12 inches (30 cm) away from walls and appliances.
- Do not place the humidifier directly on carpet, rugs, or absorbent surfaces.
- Ensure the power cord is not pinched or damaged.
- Use only clean, cool tap water or distilled water. Do not add essential oils directly into the water tank; use the aroma box.
- Unplug the humidifier before filling, cleaning, or moving it.
- Keep out of reach of children and pets.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Dreo 11L Smart Humidifier HM735S is designed to provide efficient and quiet humidification for large rooms. It features smart controls, a large capacity tank, and an aroma box for enhanced comfort.

3. SETUP

3.1 Unpacking and Placement

- Carefully remove all packaging materials from the humidifier.
- Place the humidifier on a flat, stable surface. Ensure it is at least 12 inches (30 cm) away from walls, furniture, and electronic devices.
- Avoid placing the unit on carpets or surfaces that may be damaged by moisture.

3.2 Filling the Water Tank

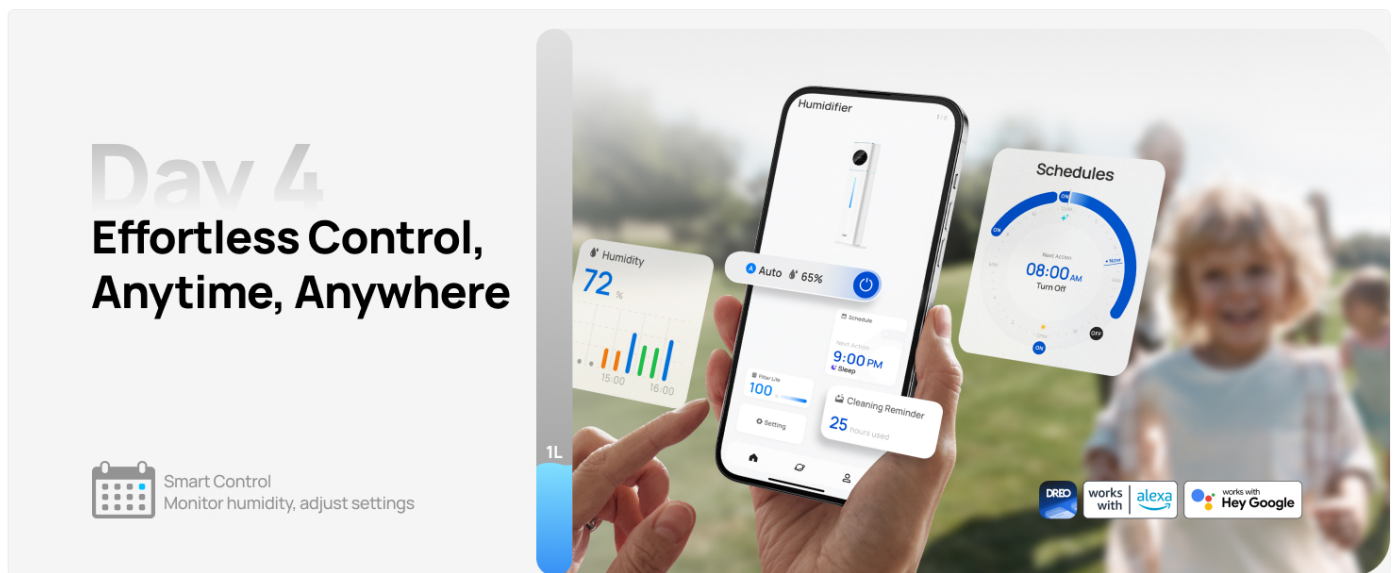


Figure 3.1: Illustration of the humidifier's top-fill design, self-cleaning tank, 360° adjustable mist outlet, 12H timer, scale-inhibitor cartridge, remote control, and customizable RGB light.

1. Ensure the humidifier is unplugged.
2. Remove the top cover of the humidifier.
3. Pour clean, cool tap water or distilled water directly into the water tank. Do not exceed the maximum fill line indicated on the unit.
4. Replace the top cover securely.

3.3 Power Connection

- Plug the power cord into a standard 120V AC electrical outlet.
- The unit will emit a beep, and the display will illuminate briefly.

4. OPERATION

4.1 Control Panel

The control panel is located on the top front of the humidifier and features a digital display and touch-sensitive buttons.

- **Power Button:** Turns the humidifier On/Off.
- **Mist Level Button:** Adjusts mist output (Low, Medium, High).
- **Mode Button:** Cycles through Auto, Sleep, and Manual modes.
- **Humidity Setting Button:** Sets desired humidity level in Auto mode.
- **Timer Button:** Sets an auto-off timer (1-12 hours).
- **Light Button:** Controls the RGB night light.

4.2 Remote Control

The included remote control allows for convenient operation from a distance. It mirrors most functions of the control panel.

4.3 Smart Control (Dreo App & Voice Control)

The humidifier can be controlled via the Dreo app on your smartphone or through voice commands with compatible smart assistants (Alexa, Google Assistant).

1. **Download the Dreo App:** Search for "Dreo" in your smartphone's app store and install it.
2. **Pairing:** Follow the in-app instructions to pair your humidifier via Bluetooth, then connect it to your Wi-Fi network.
3. **Voice Control Setup:** Link your Dreo account with Amazon Alexa or Google Home apps to enable voice commands.

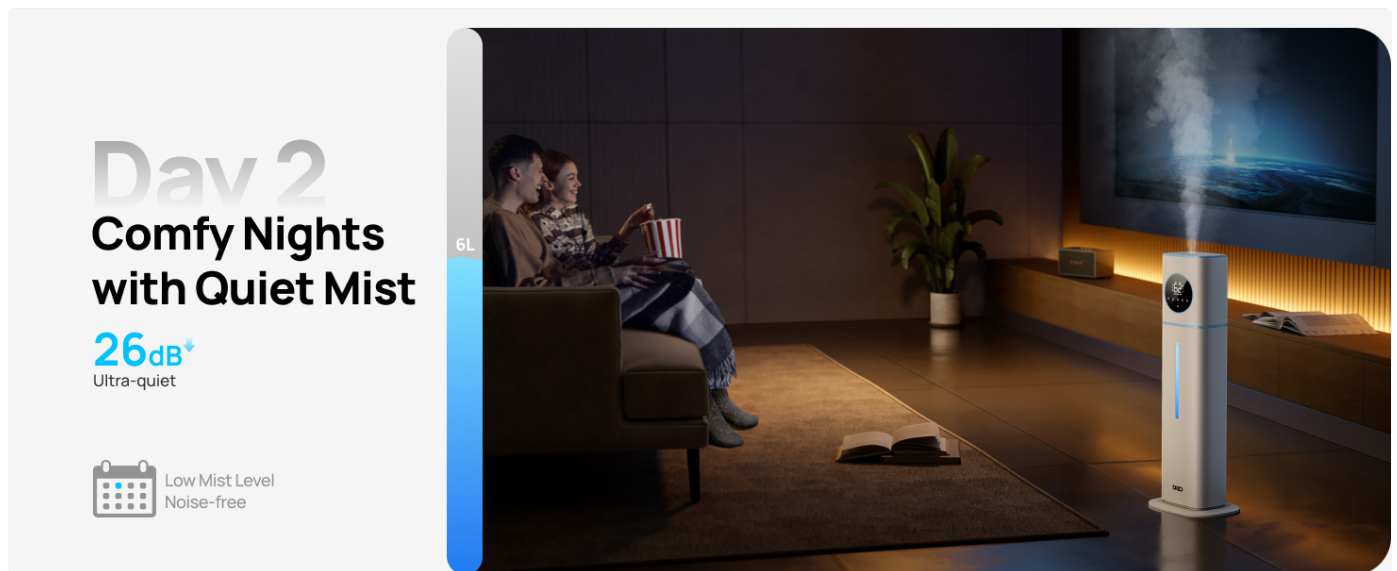


Figure 4.2: The Dreo app interface on a smartphone, demonstrating features like humidity monitoring, scheduling, and cleaning reminders, with the humidifier visible in the background.

4.4 Operating Modes

- **Auto Mode:** The humidifier automatically adjusts mist output to maintain a preset humidity level.
- **Sleep Mode:** Operates at the lowest mist level with minimal noise (26dB) and turns off display lights for undisturbed rest.
- **Manual Mode:** Allows manual selection of mist levels (Low, Medium, High, or up to 6 levels via app).

4.5 Aroma Box

To use the aroma function, locate the aroma box on the side or back of the unit. Add a few drops of essential oil onto the aroma pad (do not add oils directly into the water tank). The mist will then carry the fragrance into the air.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and maintenance are crucial for optimal performance and longevity of your humidifier.

5.1 Daily Maintenance

- Empty and rinse the water tank daily.
- Wipe the base and mist outlet with a clean, dry cloth.

5.2 Weekly Cleaning

1. Unplug the humidifier.
2. Remove the top cover and water tank.
3. Pour 1 cup (240ml) of white vinegar into the water tank and base. Let it soak for 20 minutes.
4. Use the provided cleaning brush to clean the nebulizer and other hard-to-reach areas.
5. Rinse all components thoroughly with clean water until the smell of vinegar is gone.
6. Dry all parts completely before reassembling.

5.3 Demineralization Cartridge Replacement

The Dreo Demineralization Cartridge helps reduce mineral buildup and white dust. It is recommended to replace it monthly, or more frequently depending on water hardness and usage.

- To replace, remove the old cartridge from the water draw tube in the base.
- Install a new Dreo demineralization cartridge (search for "dreo demineralization cartridge" for purchase).

5.4 Storage

- Clean and dry the humidifier thoroughly before storing.
- Store in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No mist or low mist output	No water in tank Water tank not properly seated Nebulizer dirty or scaled	Refill water tank Ensure tank is correctly placed Clean nebulizer and base (refer to Maintenance)
White dust around humidifier	Hard water used	Use distilled or demineralized water. Replace demineralization cartridge.
Unpleasant odor from mist	Stagnant water Dirty tank or base	Empty and rinse tank daily Clean humidifier thoroughly (refer to Maintenance)
Humidifier leaks water	Overfilled tank Tank not properly seated Damaged tank	Do not exceed max fill line Ensure tank is correctly placed Contact customer support if damaged
Error Code E1	Faulty humidity sensor	Contact Dreo Customer Service for assistance.
