It streamlines the process of shuffling and dealing, ensuring fair and efficient gameplay for a variety of card games, including Poker, UNO, Phase 10, Skip-Bo, Rummy, and more. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your device.

3. KEY FEATURES

3.1. 2-in-1 Shuffling & Dealing




Image: The KPAW MAX 6 dealing cards in a circular pattern, illustrating its support for up to 12 players with 360-degree rotation.




Image: The KPAW MAX 6 dealing cards in a semi-circular, back-and-forth pattern, suitable for up to 8 players.

3.4. Wireless Drawing Remotes

4. SETUP GUIDE

- 1. Unboxing: Carefully remove all components from the packaging box. Retain the packaging for future storage or transport.
- 2. **Charging the Device:** Connect the provided USB-C charging cable to the device's charging port and a compatible USB power adapter (not included). The battery indicator on the display will show charging status. A full charge can take a few

hours. Ensure the device is fully charged before first use for optimal performance.

- 3. **Inserting Cards:** Place up to two standard decks of cards into the card input trays. Ensure cards are neatly stacked and aligned. The retractable card baffle can be adjusted to fit different card sizes.
- 4. Power On: Press and hold the power button (usually located on the control panel) until the display illuminates.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **Selecting Game Mode:** Use the navigation buttons on the control panel to browse through available game modes (e.g., Texas Hold'em, Bridge, UNO, Custom). Select your desired game mode.
- 2. **Adjusting Settings (Custom Mode):** If using Custom mode, you can adjust parameters such as number of players (up to 12), number of cards per player, dealing direction (180° or 360° rotation), and dealing distance (Far, Mid, Close). Refer to the on-screen prompts for specific adjustments.
- 3. **Shuffling Cards:** Once the game mode and settings are confirmed, press the 'Shuffle' button. The device will automatically shuffle the cards placed in the input trays.
- 4. **Dealing Cards:** After shuffling, press the 'Deal' button. The device will begin dealing cards according to the selected game mode and settings. For games like Texas Hold'em, it will deal hole cards, then community cards (Flop, Turn, River) upon subsequent presses of the 'Deal' button.
- 5. Using Wireless Drawing Remotes: For games requiring players to draw cards (e.g., UNO, Rummy), distribute the wireless remotes to each player. When a player needs to draw a card, they simply press the button on their remote. The machine will automatically deal a card to the corresponding player's position. Ensure a clear line of sight between the remote and the device for optimal performance.
- 6. Power Off: To turn off the device, press and hold the power button until the display shuts down.

6. MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Regularly wipe the exterior of the device with a soft, dry cloth. For internal cleaning, ensure the device is powered off and unplugged. Use a soft brush or compressed air to remove any dust or card residue from the card pathways and sensors. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the device in water.
- Battery Care: To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the device regularly, even if not in use for extended periods (e.g., once every 3 months). Store the device in a cool, dry place.
- Card Condition: Use clean, undamaged cards for optimal performance. Bent, sticky, or excessively worn cards can lead to jams or misfeeds.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cards not shuffling/dealing smoothly or stopping early.	Cards are bent, worn, or dirty; card baffle not adjusted correctly; low battery.	Use new or clean cards. Adjust the retractable card baffle to fit the card size. Ensure the device is fully charged. Clean card pathways.
Device not dealing cards after shuffling.	Internal mechanism jam; software glitch.	Power off the device, remove all cards, and inspect the card path for obstructions. Power on again. If the issue persists, contact customer support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Wireless remotes not responding.	Remotes not paired; battery in remote is low; obstruction between remote and device.	Ensure remotes are paired according to the operating instructions. Replace remote batteries if necessary. Ensure a clear line of sight to the device.
Device not powering on.	Battery is completely drained; power button not held long enough.	Connect the device to the charger and allow it to charge for at least 30 minutes before attempting to power on again. Press and hold the power button for 3-5 seconds.
