# YASHE Induction Hob User Manual

MODEL: FS-IC018

## 1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your YASHE Single Induction Hob, Model FS-IC018. Please read these instructions carefully before using the appliance and retain them for future reference.

The YASHE Induction Hob offers precise control with 10 power settings and 10 temperature levels, a 2000W heating element, and a 4-hour timer. It features safety mechanisms such as overheating protection and a child lock, designed for reliable and energy-efficient cooking.

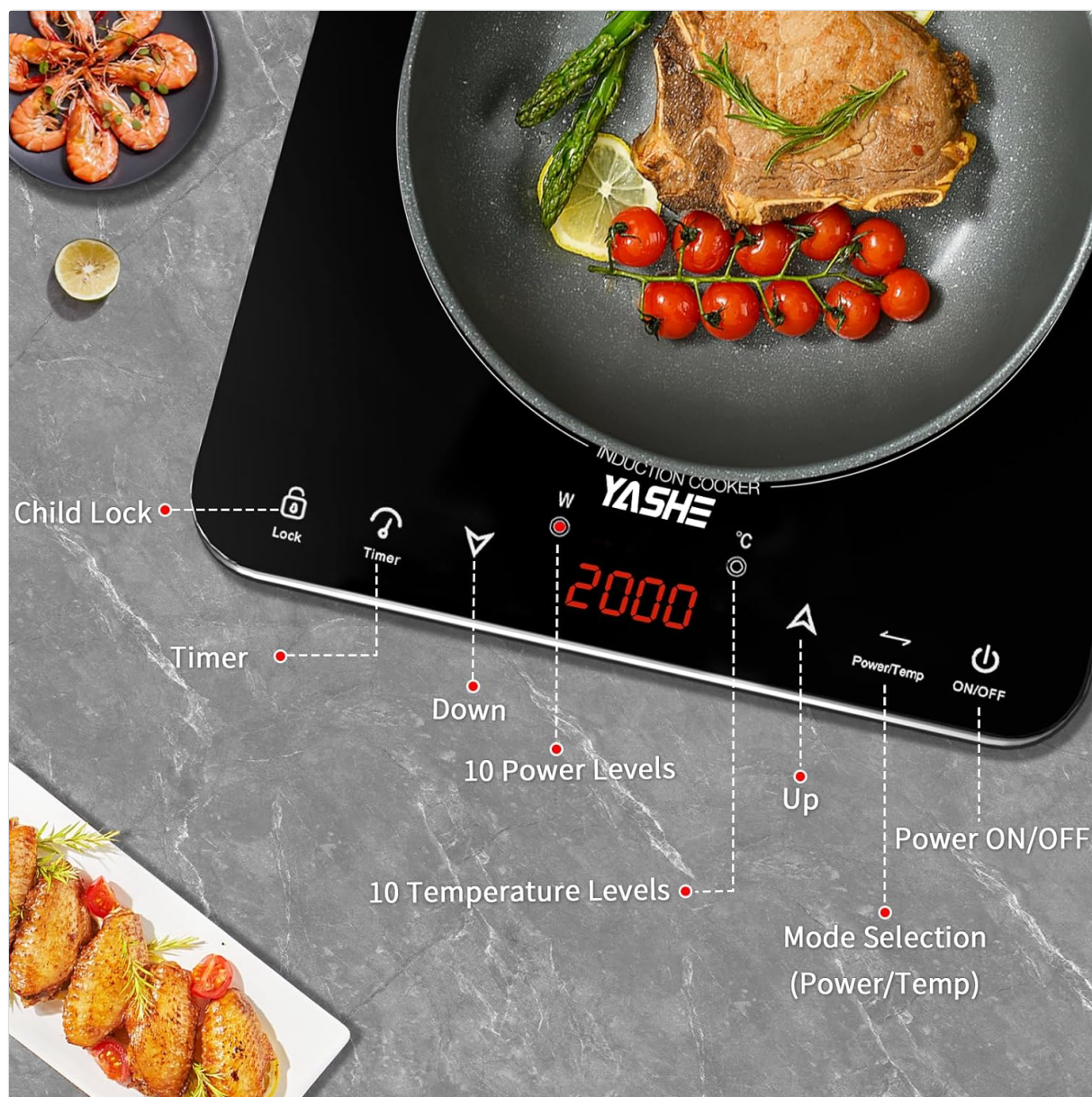
## 2. Safety Information

To prevent injury or damage to the appliance, always observe the following safety precautions:

- **Electrical Safety:** Ensure the power outlet matches the voltage requirements (230 Volts). Do not immerse the hob in water or other liquids. Do not operate with a damaged cord or plug.
- **Cookware:** Use only magnetic cookware with a base diameter between 12-26 cm. The hob will not operate without suitable cookware.
- **Overheating Protection:** The hob is equipped with an automatic shut-off feature if temperatures exceed safe limits.
- **Child Lock:** Activate the child lock function to prevent accidental operation.
- **Placement:** Place the hob on a stable, flat, heat-resistant surface. Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance.
- **Flameless Operation:** Induction cooking generates heat directly in the cookware, reducing the risk of open flames and kitchen fumes.
- **Hot Surface:** The cooking surface may remain hot after use. Avoid touching it until it has cooled down.

## 3. Product Overview

Familiarize yourself with the control panel and components of your YASHE Induction Hob.

- **ON/OFF Button:** Powers the unit on or off.
- **Power/Temp Button:** Toggles between power (Wattage) and temperature (°C) adjustment modes.
- **Up/Down Buttons:** Adjust power, temperature, or timer settings.
- **Timer Button:** Activates and sets the cooking timer.
- **Child Lock Button:** Locks the control panel to prevent unintended changes.
- **Digital Display:** Shows power level, temperature, or timer duration.

#### 4. Setup

1. Unpack the induction hob and remove all packaging materials.
2. Place the hob on a dry, stable, and heat-resistant surface, ensuring sufficient space for ventilation around the unit.
3. Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet (230V).

## 5. Cookware Compatibility

The YASHE Induction Hob requires cookware with a magnetic base. The hob will not generate heat if incompatible cookware is used or if no cookware is present.

### Compatible Cookware:

- Iron or magnetic stainless steel pots and pans.
- Frying pans, iron pans, magnetic non-stick pans.
- Cookware with a flat bottom and a diameter between 12 cm and 26 cm.

### Incompatible Cookware:

- Glass, ceramic, copper, or aluminum pots and pans (unless they have a magnetic base).
- Cookware with an uneven bottom or a diameter outside the recommended range.

## 6. Operating Instructions

Follow these steps for basic operation of your induction hob:



1. **Power On:** Place suitable cookware with food on the hob. Press the **ON/OFF** button. The display will light up.
2. **Select Mode:** The hob typically defaults to a power setting. Press the **Power/Temp** button to switch between Power (Wattage) and Temperature (°C) modes.
3. **Adjust Settings:** Use the **Up** and **Down** buttons to adjust the power level (200W to 2000W) or temperature (60°C to 240°C). There are 10 levels for both power and temperature.



This chart provides a visual guide to the 10 available power and temperature levels, demonstrating the versatility of the hob for various cooking needs.

4. **Timer Function:** Press the **Timer** button. Use the **Up** and **Down** buttons to set the desired cooking time, up to 4 hours. The hob will automatically turn off when the timer expires.
5. **Child Lock:** To activate, press and hold the **Child Lock** button for a few seconds. The display will indicate that the lock is active. To deactivate, press and hold the button again.
6. **Automatic Shut-off:** The hob will automatically turn off if cookware is removed from the cooking zone or after 60 seconds of inactivity in standby mode.
7. **Power Off:** Press the **ON/OFF** button to turn off the hob when cooking is complete. The fan may continue to run for a short period to cool the unit.

## 7. Cleaning and Maintenance

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your induction hob.

1. **Disconnect Power:** Always unplug the hob from the power outlet before cleaning.
2. **Cool Down:** Allow the hob to cool completely before cleaning.
3. **Cleaning the Surface:** Wipe the black crystal glass surface with a soft, damp cloth and mild detergent. For stubborn stains, use a non-abrasive cleaner specifically designed for glass cooktops.
4. **Drying:** Dry the surface thoroughly with a clean, soft cloth to prevent water spots.
5. **Base and Vents:** Wipe the exterior and ensure the cooling vents are free from dust and debris. Do not block the cooling vents during operation.

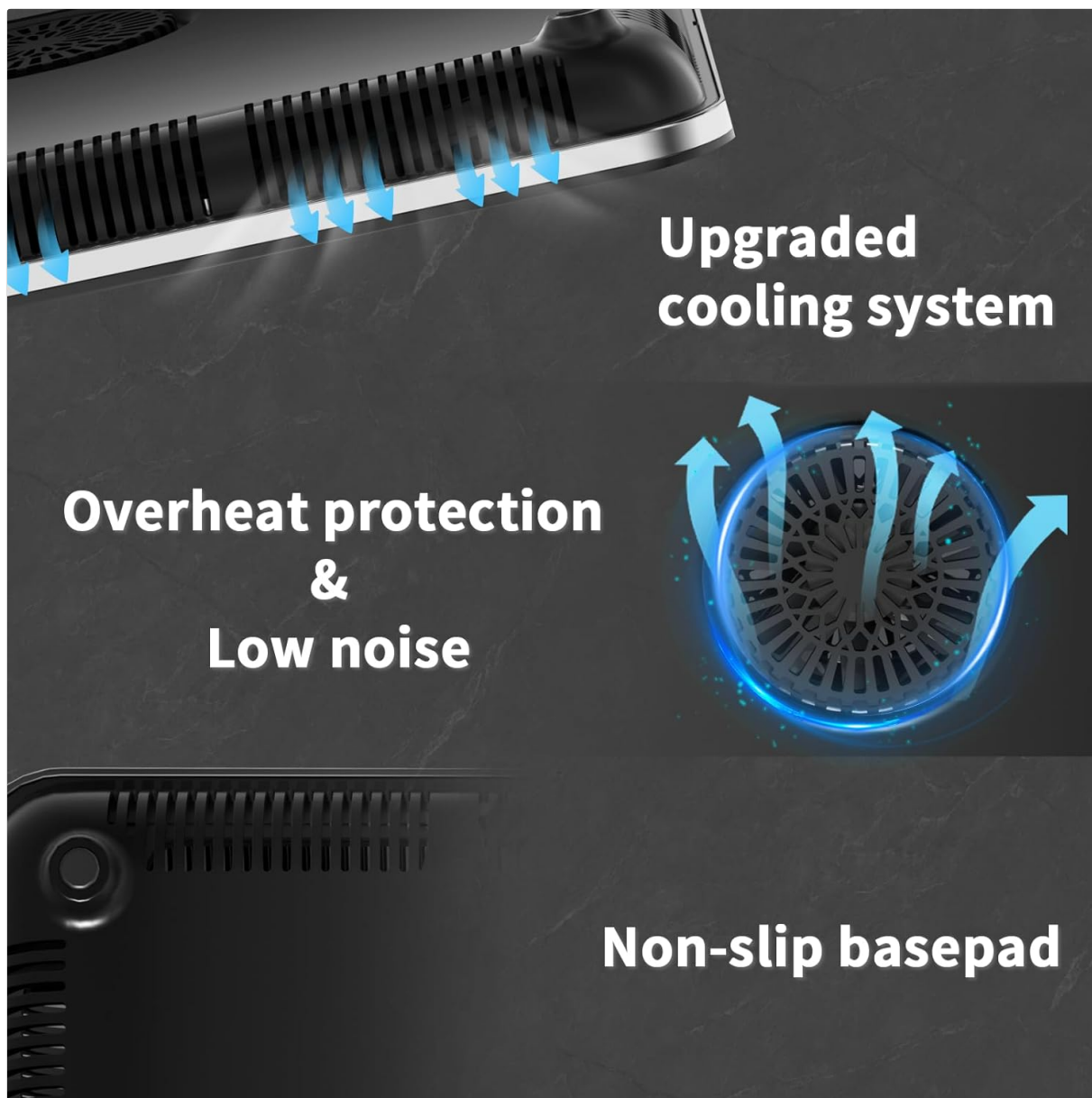

## 8. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your induction hob, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

| Problem  | Possible Cause                        | Solution   |
|--|---------------------------------------|--|
| Hob does not turn on.                            | No power supply.                      | Check if the power cord is securely plugged in and the outlet is functional.                                       |
| Hob beeps and displays an error code (e.g., E0). | Incompatible or no cookware detected. | Ensure you are using magnetic cookware with a base diameter between 12-26 cm. Place cookware centrally on the hob. |
| Hob stops heating during operation.              | Overheating protection activated.     | Turn off the hob, unplug it, and allow it to cool down. Ensure ventilation is not blocked.                         |

| Problem               | Possible Cause           | Solution  |
|-----------------------|--------------------------|---|
| Child lock is active. | Control panel is locked. | Press and hold the Child Lock button for a few seconds to deactivate. |
