# Bandai Hobby - Mobile Suit Gundam Iron-Blooded Orphans - Gundam Vidar MG 1/100 Model Kit Instruction Manual

Comprehensive guide for assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Gundam Vidar Master Grade model kit.

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

The Gundam Vidar from "Mobile Suit Gundam IRON-BLOODED ORPHANS" joins the Master Grade (MG) lineup, featuring an updated Gundam Frame designed by mechanical designer Ippei Gyobu. This model kit offers a detailed and articulated representation of the Mobile Suit.

### Key Features:

- **No Glue Required:** All parts are designed for easy snap-together assembly.
- **Easy Color Recreation:** Utilizes multi-color runner technology for accurate color separation.
- **High Quality:** Manufactured with BANDAI SPIRITS' experience and technology for reliable construction.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

---

**WARNING: CHOKING HAZARD - Small parts. Not for children under 3 years.**

Please keep all small parts and plastic bags away from young children to prevent choking hazards. Adult supervision is recommended during assembly.

## 3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

This model kit is designed for snap-fit assembly, requiring no glue. Carefully follow the included graphical instructions for each step. It is recommended to use hobby nippers to cleanly remove parts from the runners.

### 3.1. Part Identification

Before beginning assembly, familiarize yourself with the various runners and their corresponding parts. Each runner is labeled with a letter, and individual parts are numbered.

## 3.2. Core Frame Assembly

Begin by assembling the internal Gundam Frame. This forms the skeleton of the Mobile Suit, providing articulation and structural integrity. Pay close attention to the orientation of joints and connection points.

## 3.3. Armor and Weapon Assembly

Once the core frame is complete, attach the external armor pieces. Assemble the various weapons and accessories separately before attaching them to the main body.

- **Handguns:** Assemble the handguns, noting the MG original gimmick for blowback action.

- **Rifle:** Assemble the rifle, ensuring the magazine is detachable.

- **Burst Sabers:** The kit includes blade parts to reproduce the tip shape during Burst Saber deployment.

## 4. OPERATING AND POSING

---

The Gundam Vidar MG 1/100 model kit is highly articulated, allowing for a wide range of dynamic poses. The updated Gundam Frame provides enhanced mobility in key areas such as the shoulders and legs.

### 4.1. Articulation Points

Utilize the multiple articulation points in the neck, shoulders, elbows, wrists, waist, hips, knees, and ankles to achieve desired poses. The shoulder joints have an expanded range of motion for more expressive stances.

### 4.2. Special Features

- **Hunter Edge:** The Hunter Edge on the toes and heels can be deployed.
- **Leg Armor and Verniers:** The knee armor and verniers operate in conjunction with leg bending movements.

- **Weapon Storage:** The handguns can be stored behind the front skirting armor, and the rifle has a slot for storage on either side of the side skirting armor.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your Gundam Vidar model kit, regular maintenance is recommended.

- **Cleaning:** Gently dust the model with a soft brush or compressed air to prevent dust buildup. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Handling:** Handle the model by its main body parts rather than delicate accessories or antennas to prevent breakage.
- **Storage:** Store the model in a stable, dust-free environment away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to prevent discoloration or material degradation.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter any issues during or after assembly, consider the following common solutions:

- **Loose Parts:** If a part feels loose, carefully re-examine the connection point in the instruction manual to ensure it is correctly inserted. A small amount of hobby cement can be used for non-articulated parts if necessary, but use sparingly.
- **Difficulty Posing:** Ensure all joints are fully engaged. If a joint is too stiff, gently work it back and forth. If too loose, a thin layer of clear nail polish or super glue on the ball joint (allow to dry completely) can add friction.
- **Missing or Damaged Parts:** Refer to the manufacturer's warranty and support information for assistance with missing or damaged components.
