SETUP

Charging the Speaker

- 1. Connect the provided USB charging cable to the speaker's charging port.
- Connect the other end of the cable to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
- 3. The LED indicator will show charging status. A full charge typically takes approximately 2-3 hours.
- 4. Disconnect the cable once fully charged.

Powering On/Off

- Power On: Press and hold the Power button for 2-3 seconds until the LED indicator lights up and you hear an audible prompt.
- Power Off: Press and hold the Power button for 2-3 seconds until the LED indicator turns off and you hear an audible prompt.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Ensure the speaker is powered off.
- 2. Press and hold the Power button for approximately 5 seconds until the LED indicator flashes blue and red alternately, indicating pairing mode.
- 3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, laptop), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
- 4. Select "Frewico Clip 8" from the list of devices.
- 5. Once paired, the LED indicator will turn solid blue, and you will hear a confirmation sound.
- 6. The speaker will automatically reconnect to the last paired device when powered on, if the device's Bluetooth is active and within range.

True Wireless Stereo (TWS) Pairing

To achieve stereo sound, you can pair two Frewico Clip 8 speakers together.

- 1. Ensure both Clip 8 speakers are powered off and not connected to any Bluetooth device.
- 2. Power on both speakers. They will enter pairing mode (LED flashing blue and red).

- 3. On one of the speakers, double-press the Power button. The speakers will attempt to connect to each other.
- 4. Once successfully paired, one speaker will act as the master (LED flashing blue and red) and the other as the slave (LED flashing blue slowly).
- 5. Now, connect your device to the master speaker via Bluetooth as described in the "Bluetooth Pairing" section.
- 6. Both speakers will play audio in stereo.

Music Playback Controls

- Play/Pause: Short press the Power button.
- Volume Up: Short press the Volume + button.
- Volume Down: Short press the Volume button.
- Next Track: Long press the Volume + button.
- Previous Track: Long press the Volume button.

Call Management

- Answer Call: Short press the Power button when a call comes in.
- End Call: Short press the Power button during a call.
- Reject Call: Long press the Power button when a call comes in.
- Redial Last Number: Double-press the Power button.

LED Flashlight Operation

The speaker features a multi-function LED flashlight.

- Turn On/Off: Short press the LED button.
- **Cycle Modes:** Once on, short press the LED button repeatedly to cycle through Low Light, Strong Light, Warning, and SOS modes.

Voice Assistant

 Activate: Double-press the Voice Assistant button to activate your device's Siri or Google Assistant.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Wipe the speaker with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the speaker in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Water Exposure: While IPX7 waterproof, ensure the charging port cover is securely closed before exposing the speaker to water. After water exposure, dry the speaker thoroughly before charging.
- **Magnetic Clip:** The magnetic clip is designed for secure attachment. For stronger magnetic attachment to metal surfaces, remove the magnetic clip.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Proble	em P	Possible Cause	Solution

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Speaker does not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the speaker fully.
Cannot pair with Bluetooth device.	Speaker not in pairing mode; device Bluetooth off; too far from device.	Ensure speaker is in pairing mode (flashing blue/red). Turn on device Bluetooth. Move speaker closer to device (within 100ft). Forget previous pairings on device and try again.
No sound or low volume.	Volume too low on speaker or device; speaker not connected.	Increase volume on both speaker and connected device. Ensure speaker is successfully paired.
TWS pairing fails.	Speakers not in correct mode; already paired to a device.	Ensure both speakers are powered off and disconnected from any device before initiating TWS pairing. Follow TWS pairing steps precisely.
Flashlight not working.	Low battery; button not pressed correctly.	Charge the speaker. Short press the LED button to activate.
