## **SETUP AND INSTALLATION**

## **Attaching the Stand / Wall Mounting**

Your ATYME TV can be placed on a flat surface using the included feet or mounted on a wall using a compatible VESA mount (sold separately).

- For Stand Installation: Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface. Align the TV feet with the designated slots on the bottom of the TV and secure them with the provided screws. Ensure the feet are firmly attached before placing the TV upright.
- For Wall Mounting: This TV supports standard VESA mounting. Refer to your wall mount's instructions for proper installation. Ensure the wall mount is compatible with the TV's VESA pattern and weight.

#### **Connecting External Devices**

The ATYME 320AM5DVD offers various input and output ports for connecting external devices.

- **HDMI:** Connect high-definition devices such as Blu-ray players, game consoles, or cable/satellite boxes to the HDMI ports. This TV features two HDMI 1.4 ports, one of which supports ARC (Audio Return Channel).
- USB: Insert a USB drive to play compatible media files.
- VGA: Connect a computer using a VGA cable for use as a monitor.
- Composite (CVBS)/Audio: Use for older devices with composite video and stereo audio outputs.
- Antenna/Cable: Connect an antenna for over-the-air broadcasts or a cable TV connection.
- Optical Audio Out: Connect to a soundbar or home theater system for digital audio output.
- Headphone Analog Audio Out: Connect headphones or external speakers.



Image: Connectivity diagram showing available ports and compatible devices.




Image: The TV connected to multiple external devices, highlighting its input capabilities.

## **Powering On**

After connecting all desired devices and ensuring the TV is securely placed, plug the power cord into a wall outlet. Press the power button on the TV or the remote control to turn on the television.

## **Using the Remote Control**

The included remote control allows you to access all functions of your ATYME TV. Insert the two AAA batteries (included) into the remote control, observing polarity.

#### **Navigating Menus**

Use the directional buttons on the remote to navigate through the on-screen menus. The 'OK' or 'Enter' button confirms selections, and the 'Back' or 'Exit' button returns to the previous screen or exits the menu.

## **Picture and Sound Settings**

Access the 'Picture' menu to adjust settings such as brightness, contrast, color, and sharpness. The 'Sound' menu allows you to modify volume, bass, treble, and select sound modes. The TV features a Wide Color Controller for an enhanced color spectrum.

## **DVD Player Operation**

To use the built-in DVD player, gently insert a DVD disc into the slot located on the side of the TV. The TV will automatically switch to DVD mode or prompt you to select it. Use the remote control for playback functions such as Play, Pause, Stop, Fast Forward, and Rewind.

## Maintenance and Care

- Cleaning the Screen: Gently wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a specialized screen cleaner. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Cleaning the Cabinet: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the TV cabinet.
- Ventilation: Ensure adequate ventilation around the TV. Do not block the ventilation openings.
- Power Cord: Regularly check the power cord for any damage. If damaged, discontinue use and contact customer support.
- **Storage:** If storing the TV for an extended period, disconnect it from power and store it in a cool, dry place, preferably in its original packaging.

## **T**ROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ATYME TV, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
No Power	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into the TV and a working electrical outlet. Check if the power outlet is active.
No Picture / Poor Picture Quality	Verify that the correct input source is selected. Check all cable connections (HDMI, VGA, etc.) are secure. Adjust picture settings (brightness, contrast). If using an antenna, check signal strength.
No Sound / Poor Sound Quality	Check the volume level and ensure the TV is not muted. If using external speakers or a soundbar, ensure they are properly connected and powered on. Adjust sound settings in the TV menu.
Remote Control Not Working	Replace the batteries in the remote control. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor.

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
DVD Not Playing	Ensure the disc is inserted correctly with the label side facing up. Check if the disc is clean and free of scratches. Verify the disc format is compatible with the built-in DVD player.
Cannot Connect to PC as Monitor	Ensure the VGA cable is securely connected. Adjust display settings on your computer (resolution, aspect ratio) to match the TV's capabilities (1366x768 resolution).




Image: Energy Guide label for the ATYME 320AM5DVD.
