# AGPTEK 64GB MP3 Player User Manual

## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides detailed instructions for the operation and maintenance of your AGPTEK 64GB MP3 Player. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device to ensure proper functionality and to maximize your user experience.

## SETUP

### 1. Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the MP3 player. Connect the device to a computer's USB port or a compatible USB wall adapter using the provided USB cable. The charging indicator will show progress and turn off when fully charged. A full charge typically takes approximately 1.5 hours.

## 2. Loading Music and Files

Connect the MP3 player to your computer using the USB cable. The device will appear as a removable disk. You can drag and drop music files (MP3, WMA, APE, FLAC, WAV, DRM, ACELP, M4A, AAC) and other supported files (TXT for e-books, JPG/BMP for photos) directly into the player's internal storage or an inserted TF card (up to 128GB, not included).

- **Internal Memory:** 64GB
- **Expandable Memory:** Supports up to 128GB TF card

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Basic Controls

The MP3 player features physical buttons for navigation and control. Refer to the diagram below for button layout and functions.

- **Menu Button:** Access main menu options.
- **Navigation Buttons (Up/Down/Left/Right):** Scroll through menus, adjust volume (Up/Down), skip tracks (Left/Right).
- **Play/Pause Button:** Start or pause playback, confirm selection.
- **Back/Return Button:** Go back to the previous screen or menu.

## Music Playback

From the main menu, select "Music" to browse your audio files. You can navigate by artist, album, genre, or all songs. The player supports Hi-Fi lossless sound quality.

## Bluetooth Connectivity

The MP3 player features Bluetooth 5.3 for wireless audio streaming. To pair with Bluetooth headphones or speakers:

1. Go to the "Bluetooth" menu.
2. Turn on Bluetooth.
3. Select "Search Device" to find available Bluetooth devices.
4. Choose your device from the list to pair.

**Note: This device cannot connect to cellphones or car systems via Bluetooth. An audio line can be used for wired connections.**

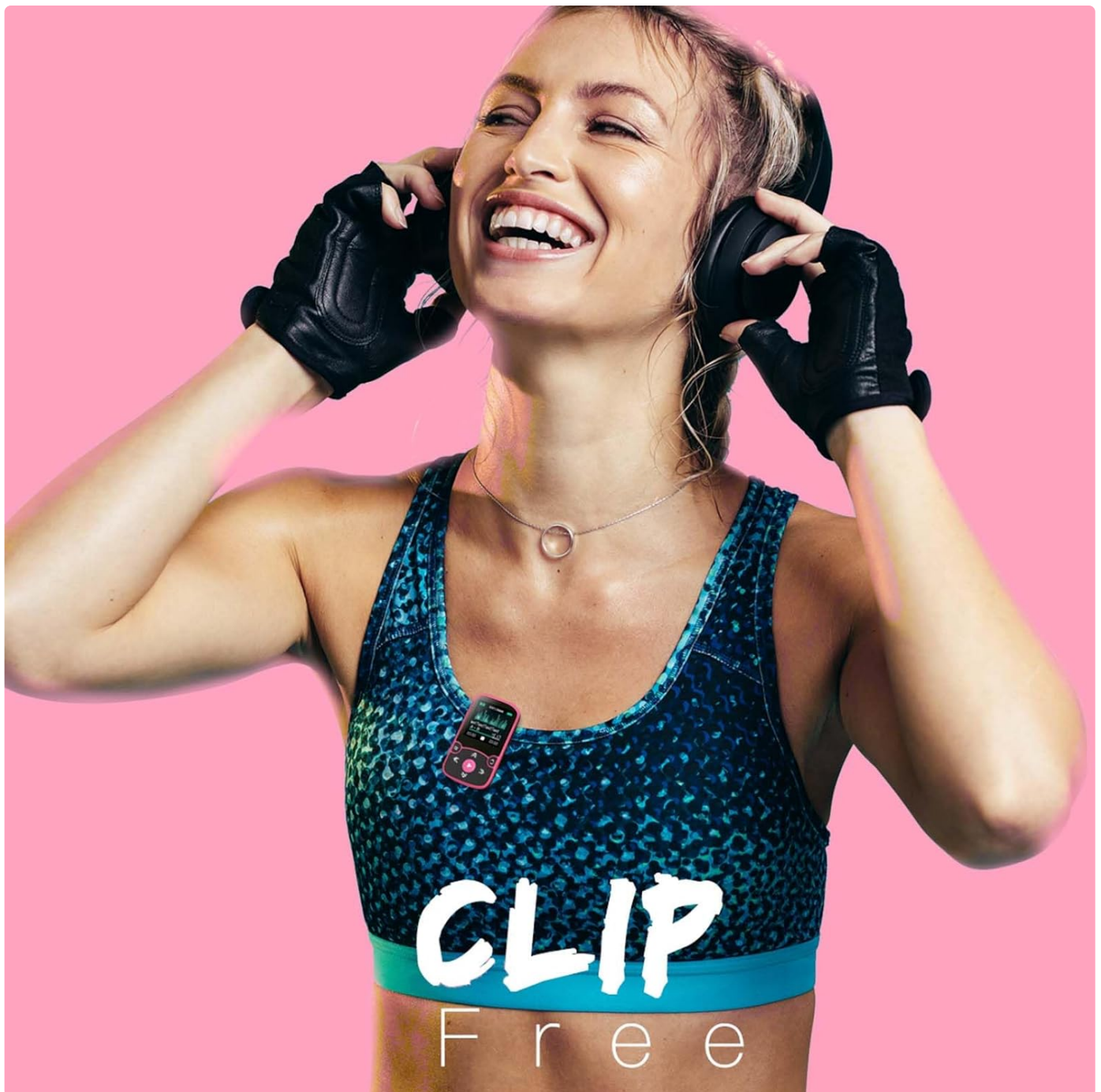

### **FM Radio**

Plug in wired earphones (acting as an antenna) to use the FM radio function. Navigate to the "FM Radio" option in the main menu. You can auto-scan for stations or manually tune.

### **Voice Recorder**

The built-in voice recorder allows you to capture audio. Access this feature from the main menu. Recordings are saved in a dedicated folder.

### **Pedometer Mode**

Activate the Pedometer Mode to track your steps, distance, and calories during physical activity. This feature is ideal for sport and running.

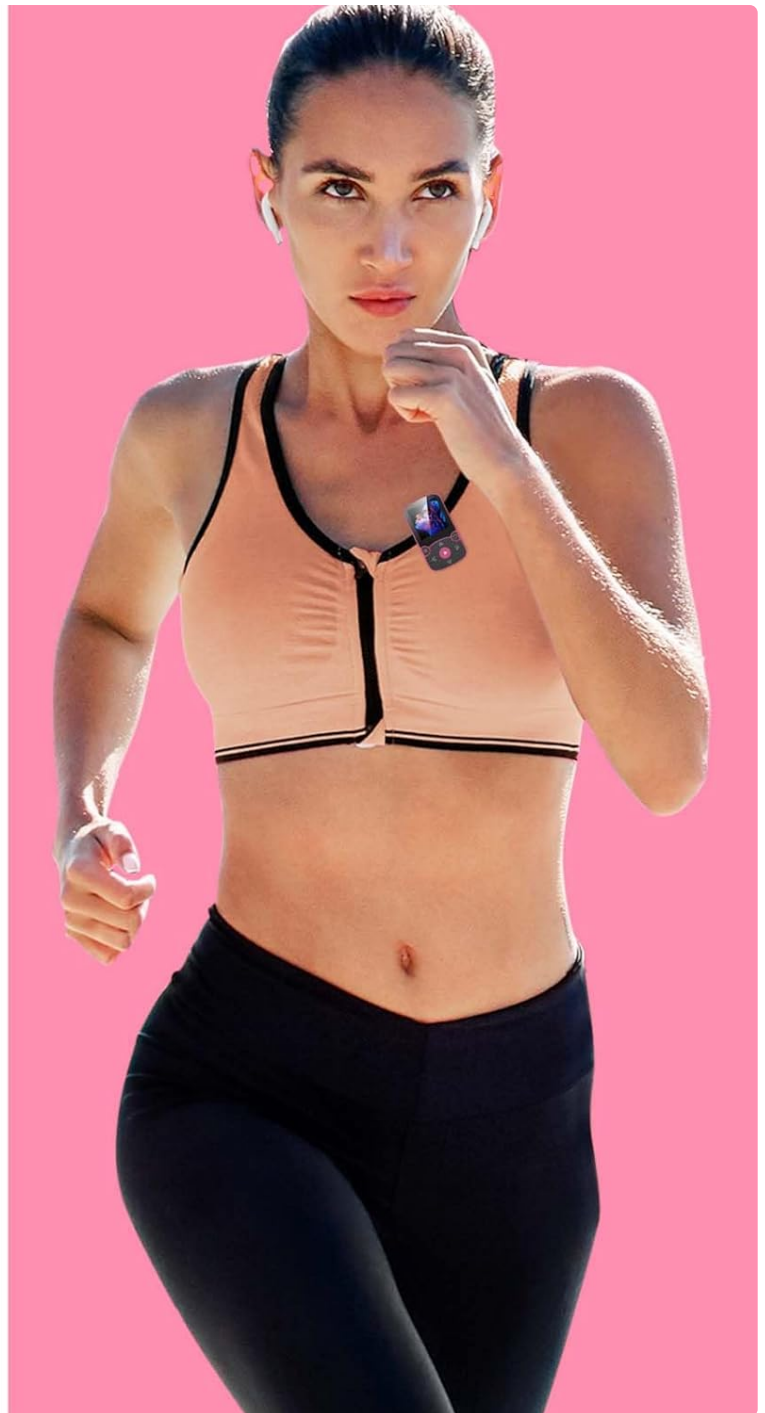
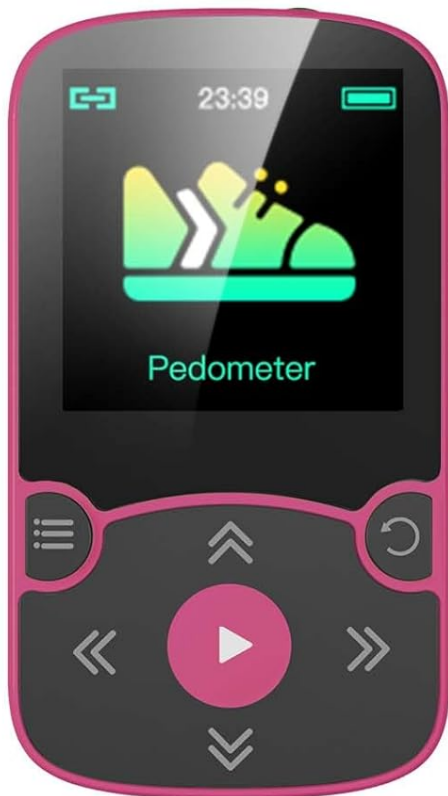

## E-book Function

The device supports E-book reading in TXT format only. Transfer TXT files to the player and access them via the "E-book" menu.

## Other Functions

The MP3 player also includes features such as photo browsing, A-B repeat for audio, alarm clock, calendar, file folders, built-in speaker, and time screen-saver.

## MAINTENANCE

- Keep the device dry. Avoid exposure to moisture or extreme temperatures.
- Clean the device with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Avoid dropping or subjecting the device to strong impacts.

- Store the device in a cool, dry place when not in use for extended periods.
- Regularly back up important files to prevent data loss.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Device does not turn on.	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to a power source and try again. If unresponsive, try resetting the device (refer to manual for reset instructions, if available, or hold power button for 10-15 seconds).
Cannot connect to computer.	Check the USB cable and port. Try a different USB port or computer. Ensure the device is in data transfer mode if prompted.
Bluetooth pairing fails.	Ensure the MP3 player and the Bluetooth device are in pairing mode and within range. Delete previous pairings and try again. Remember, it cannot connect to phones or cars via Bluetooth.
Poor sound quality.	Check earphone connection. Ensure audio files are not corrupted. Adjust equalizer settings if available.
Screen is dim or unreadable.	Adjust screen brightness in settings. Avoid direct sunlight when viewing the screen.
