INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the Ninja Luxe Pro 3-in-1 Coffee Machine. This appliance is designed to provide a versatile coffee experience, allowing you to prepare espresso, latte, cappuccino, and cold brew beverages. It features an integrated bean grinder, assisted tamper, and an automated milk frother. Please read this manual thoroughly before initial use to ensure proper operation and maintenance.

INITIAL SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging materials for future transport or storage.
2. **Placement:** Place the machine on a stable, level surface away from heat sources and water. Ensure adequate ventilation.
3. **Water Reservoir:** Fill the removable water reservoir with fresh, cold water up to the MAX fill line.
4. **Bean Hopper:** Open the bean hopper lid and fill with whole coffee beans. Close the lid securely.
5. **Initial Cleaning Cycle:** Before first use, perform a cleaning cycle by filling the water reservoir and running a brew cycle without coffee grounds. Refer to the 'Operating Instructions' for basic brewing steps.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Preparing Espresso or Coffee

1. **Select Basket:** Choose the appropriate filter basket (single, double, or Luxe) for your desired coffee strength and quantity. Insert it into the portafilter.
2. **Grind Beans:** Place the portafilter under the integrated grinder. Use the grind size selector to choose from 25 available settings. The Barista Assist Technology provides recommendations for optimal grind size. Press the grind button to dispense fresh coffee grounds into the portafilter.
3. **Tamp Grounds:** Use the integrated assisted tamper to compress the coffee grounds evenly in the portafilter.
4. **Attach Portafilter:** Insert the portafilter into the brew head and twist to lock it securely in place.
5. **Select Brew:** Choose your desired coffee style (Espresso, Coffee, Cold Brew) and brew intensity from the control panel.
6. **Brew:** Press the brew button to start the brewing process. The machine will automatically dispense your selected beverage.

2. Frothing Milk

The automated frother allows for hands-free milk preparation with various textures.

1. **Fill Pitcher:** Fill the XL frothing pitcher with milk or a plant-based alternative to the desired level.
2. **Place Pitcher:** Position the frothing pitcher under the frothing wand.
3. **Select Foam Preset:** Choose one of the 5 automated foam presets: Steamed Milk, Fine Foam, Thick Foam, Ultra-Thick Foam, or Cold Foam.
4. **Start Frothing:** Press the frothing button. The machine will heat and whisk the milk to create the selected micro-foam texture.
5. **Manual Steam Wand:** For manual frothing, use the steam wand function to control milk texture and temperature directly.

3. Creating Specialty Drinks

Combine your freshly brewed coffee or espresso with frothed milk to create a variety of specialty beverages like lattes and cappuccinos.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and longevity of your coffee machine.

- **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, rinse the portafilter and filter basket. Wipe down the steam wand and frothing pitcher.
- **Removable Parts:** Many removable parts, including the frothing pitcher and certain upper components, are dishwasher-safe (top rack only). Refer to the user guide for specific dishwasher-safe components.
- **Grinder Cleaning:** Use the provided cleaning brush to remove any residual coffee grounds from the grinder area.
- **Descaling:** The machine will indicate when descaling is required. Follow the instructions in the full user manual for the descaling process using a suitable descaling solution.
- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the machine with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter. For more detailed troubleshooting, refer to the complete user manual.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No coffee dispenses	Water reservoir empty; clogged filter basket; machine not primed.	Fill water reservoir; clean filter basket; run a priming cycle.
Weak coffee	Grind too coarse; insufficient coffee grounds; low brew intensity.	Adjust grind to finer setting; use more coffee grounds; select higher brew intensity.
Milk not frothing properly	Frothing wand/whisk dirty; incorrect milk type/temperature.	Clean frothing components; use cold, fresh milk; ensure whisk is properly installed.
Machine displays 'Descale'	Mineral buildup in the system.	Perform a descaling cycle as per the full user manual.
