INTRODUCTION

The Zassenhaus Worker Pepper Mill is a robust and versatile kitchen tool designed for grinding pepper, salt, and various dried herbs and spices. Crafted from durable cast iron and featuring a high-performance German ceramic grinding mechanism, this mill provides consistent and precise results for enhancing your culinary creations.

Its compact design, standing at 4 inches (10.0 cm) in height with a diameter of 2.4 inches (6.0 cm), makes it a practical addition to any kitchen. The grinding level is infinitely adjustable, allowing you to achieve your desired coarseness.

SETUP

1. **Unpack the Mill:** Carefully remove the pepper mill from its packaging. Inspect for any damage.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wipe the exterior of the mill with a slightly damp cloth. Ensure it is completely dry before filling. Do not immerse in water.
3. **Filling the Mill:**
 - Unscrew the top knob and remove the top section of the mill.
 - Fill the internal chamber with your desired whole peppercorns, coarse salt, or dried spices. Do not overfill.
 - Replace the top section and screw the knob back on securely.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Adjusting Grinding Level:**
 - The Zassenhaus Worker Pepper Mill features an infinitely adjustable grinding mechanism.

- To adjust the coarseness, turn the knob on top of the mill.
- Turn the knob clockwise for a finer grind.
- Turn the knob counter-clockwise for a coarser grind.
- Test the grind on a small surface until the desired consistency is achieved.

2. **Grinding:**

- Hold the body of the mill firmly with one hand.
- With the other hand, twist the top section of the mill clockwise.
- The ground spice will dispense from the bottom of the mill.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning the Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the cast iron mill with a soft, damp cloth. Dry immediately to prevent rust.
- **Cleaning the Grinding Mechanism:** For optimal performance, occasionally grind a small amount of coarse salt through the mill to help clean the ceramic mechanism.
- **Do NOT Dishwash:** This product is **not** dishwasher safe. Exposure to water and harsh detergents in a dishwasher can damage the cast iron and the grinding mechanism.
- **Storage:** Store the mill in a dry place away from excessive moisture to maintain the integrity of the cast iron.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No grind or inconsistent grind.	Mill is empty, grinding mechanism is too loose, or mechanism is clogged.	Refill the mill. Tighten the top knob for a finer grind. Grind coarse salt to clear any blockages.
Difficulty turning the mill.	Grinding mechanism is set too fine, or contents are too large/hard.	Loosen the top knob slightly for a coarser grind. Ensure you are using appropriate ingredients (e.g., whole peppercorns, not excessively large or hard spices).
Rust spots on cast iron.	Exposure to moisture, improper drying.	Wipe immediately with a dry cloth after cleaning. Store in a dry environment. Light rust can often be removed with a fine steel wool and then re-oiled (use food-grade oil).
