## 4. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps for proper installation of your cabinet pull handles.

### 4.1 Tools Required

- Measuring Tape or Ruler
- Pencil or Marker
- Drill
- Drill Bit (appropriate size for mounting screws)
- Screwdriver (Phillips head recommended)
- Optional: Cabinet Hardware Jig for precise hole placement

### 4.2 Installation Steps

1. **Determine Placement:** Decide on the desired location for each pull handle on your cabinet doors or drawers. Standard placement for pulls on cabinet doors is typically on the stile opposite the hinges, and centered vertically. For drawers, pulls are usually centered horizontally and vertically.
2. **Mark Hole Centers:** Using a measuring tape or a cabinet hardware jig, accurately mark the two hole centers for each pull. The center-to-center distance for these pulls is 12.6 inches (320mm). Ensure marks are level and consistent across all installations.
3. **Drill Pilot Holes:** Select a drill bit slightly smaller than the diameter of the mounting screws. Carefully drill pilot holes through the marked points. Drill slowly and steadily to prevent splintering, especially on the back side of the cabinet door or drawer.
4. **Attach the Pull:** Align the pull handle with the drilled holes. Insert the mounting screws from the inside of the cabinet door or drawer through the pilot holes and into the threaded posts of the pull handle.
5. **Tighten Screws:** Using a Phillips head screwdriver, gently tighten the screws until the pull handle is secure. **Do not overtighten**, as this can strip the screw threads or damage the cabinet material.
6. **Repeat:** Follow these steps for all remaining cabinet pull handles.

## 5. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

---

Proper care will help maintain the finish and longevity of your Silverline Hardware cabinet pulls.

- **Cleaning:** Clean regularly with a soft, damp cloth. For stubborn marks, use a mild soap solution and immediately dry with a clean, soft cloth.
- **Avoid Harsh Cleaners:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, ammonia-based products, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the brushed satin nickel finish.
- **Periodic Inspection:** Periodically check the tightness of the mounting screws. If any pull feels loose, gently tighten the screws with a screwdriver.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

- **Pull Handle is Loose:** If a pull handle becomes loose, gently tighten the mounting screws from the inside of the cabinet door or drawer using a Phillips head screwdriver. Avoid overtightening.
- **Screws Do Not Fit:** The package includes standard screws. If your cabinet thickness requires different screw lengths, please contact Silverline Hardware customer support for assistance.
- **Scratches or Finish Damage:** Minor scratches may be buffed out with a very fine-grit polishing cloth designed for brushed metals. For significant damage, replacement may be necessary.
