# 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The GeekTale F08 Fingerprint Smart Deadbolt Lock offers advanced security and convenient keyless entry for your home or office. This smart lock integrates multiple unlocking methods including fingerprint recognition, smartphone app control via Bluetooth, and traditional physical keys. It is designed for easy installation and provides robust security features.

# **Key Features:**

- **Rechargeable Battery:** Built-in battery provides up to 8 months of use on a 2-hour charge, with low-battery alerts and emergency USB power access.
- **Durable Construction:** Made from aluminum alloy, suitable for both indoor and outdoor use (under covered entries for exterior doors).

## 2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning installation:

- GeekTale F08 Fingerprint Deadbolt Lock (Exterior and Interior Assemblies)
- Deadbolt Latch
- Strike Plate
- Mounting Hardware (Screws)
- Physical Keys (2-3, quantity may vary)
- Installation Guide (this document)

## 3. Installation Guide

# 3.1. Door Compatibility Check

Ensure your door meets the following specifications:

- Door Hole Diameter: 2-1/8 inches (54mm)
- Door Thickness: 1-3/8 inches to 2-1/8 inches (35mm to 54mm)
- **Backset:** Adjustable for 2-3/4 inches (70mm) or 2-3/8 inches (60mm). If your door's backset is 2-3/4 inches (70mm), pull out the face plate to extend.



## 3.2. Installation Steps

- 1. Prepare the Door: If replacing an existing lock, remove it. Ensure the door frame is clean and free of debris.
- 2. **Install the Deadbolt Latch:** Insert the deadbolt latch into the door edge. Ensure the "UP" arrow on the latch is facing upwards. Adjust the backset if necessary (60mm or 70mm). Secure with screws.
- 3. **Install the Exterior Assembly:** Route the cable from the exterior assembly through the door hole, ensuring the spindle passes through the latch mechanism.
- 4. **Install the Interior Mounting Plate:** Secure the interior mounting plate to the door using screws, ensuring it aligns with the exterior assembly.
- Connect the Cable and Install the Interior Assembly: Connect the cable from the exterior assembly to the
  interior assembly. Attach the interior assembly to the mounting plate, ensuring the thumb turn operates
  smoothly. Secure with screws.

- 6. Install the Strike Plate: Install the strike plate on the door frame, aligning it with the deadbolt latch.
- 7. **Test Operation:** Manually test the lock and unlock function with the thumb turn and physical key to ensure smooth operation.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## 4.1. Unlocking Methods

The GeekTale F08 offers three primary ways to unlock your door:

#### • Fingerprint Unlock:

Place your registered finger on the fingerprint sensor. The lock will recognize your fingerprint in approximately 0.3 seconds. Once recognized, twist the deadbolt knob to unlock the door.

## · App Unlock (Bluetooth):

Download the dedicated GeekTale app (or compatible smart home app like Tuya Smart). Pair your lock via Bluetooth. Within 10 meters of the lock, open the app and tap the unlock icon. Once unlocked, twist the

deadbolt knob to open the door.

#### • Key Unlock:

In case of emergency or preference, use the provided physical key to unlock the deadbolt. The keyhole is discreetly located on the exterior assembly.

## 4.2. Locking the Door

To lock the door, simply twist the deadbolt knob from either the interior or exterior side. The lock will engage automatically.



## 4.3. App Management and Remote Control

The companion app allows for comprehensive management of your lock:

- User Management: Add or delete fingerprint profiles for family members or guests.
- Access Logs: Review a history of entries and exits, including the method used (fingerprint, app).
- Remote Unlock (Requires Gateway): For remote unlocking functionality and real-time door status
  notifications from anywhere, a GeekTale G3 Gateway (sold separately) is required. Pair the gateway with your
  lock and connect it to your home Wi-Fi network.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

# 5.1. Battery Management

The lock is equipped with a rechargeable Lithium-Ion battery. A full charge takes approximately 2 hours and provides up to 8 months of use.

- Charging: Use a standard USB cable to charge the lock. The charging port is typically located on the interior assembly.
- Low Battery Alert: The lock will provide visual or audible alerts when the battery level is low. The app will also display battery status.
- Emergency Power: If the battery completely drains, you can use a portable power bank connected via USB to temporarily power the lock for entry, or use the physical key.



## 5.2. Cleaning and Care

- Wipe the lock surface with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- While the lock is constructed for durability, for exterior doors, installation under covered entries (e.g., porches) is recommended to protect it from direct rain exposure and extreme weather conditions.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

#### • Fingerprint Not Recognized:

Ensure your finger is clean and dry. Try repositioning your finger on the sensor. If issues persist, delete and reregister your fingerprint in the app. Ensure the sensor is clean.

#### · Lock Not Responding:

Check the battery level in the app or look for low battery alerts on the lock. Recharge the battery if necessary. If completely drained, use a physical key or emergency USB power.

#### • App Connectivity Issues (Bluetooth):

Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your smartphone and you are within 10 meters of the lock. Restart the app or your phone. If using a gateway, ensure the gateway is powered on and connected to Wi-Fi.

## • Remote Unlock Not Working:

Verify that the GeekTale G3 Gateway is properly installed, powered, and connected to your home Wi-Fi network. Ensure the lock is paired with the gateway. Check your internet connection.

#### • Lock Malfunctions / Unlocks Randomly:

This is an uncommon issue. If the lock exhibits unpredictable behavior, try resetting the lock to factory settings (refer to the app or manufacturer's instructions for specific steps) and re-pairing it. If the problem persists, contact customer support.
