INTRODUCTION

This comprehensive music system combines a classic turntable with modern connectivity options, including Bluetooth, Internet Radio, DAB+, CD, and MP3 playback. This manual provides detailed instructions for setup, operation, and maintenance to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your device. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Lenco MC-660 is a versatile audio system designed for various listening experiences. It features a top-loading turntable, a front-loading CD player, a digital display for radio and internet functions, and multiple input/output options.

Main Components:

- Turntable: For playing vinyl records. Includes a dust cover, platter, and tonearm.
- Main Unit: Houses the CD player, radio tuner, amplifier, and control interface.
- Speakers: Two external speakers for stereo sound output.
- Remote Control: For convenient operation from a distance.

SETUP

1. Unpacking and Placement:

- · Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
- Place the main unit and speakers on a stable, flat surface, away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and excessive
 dust or moisture.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit.

2. Speaker Connection:

• Connect the speaker wires from the main unit's speaker terminals to the corresponding terminals on each speaker. Ensure correct polarity (+ to + and - to -) for optimal sound.

3. Antenna Connection:

• Connect the supplied FM/DAB+ antenna to the antenna input on the rear of the main unit. Extend the antenna fully

for best reception.

4. Power Connection:

- Connect the power adapter to the DC IN port on the rear of the main unit.
- Plug the power adapter into a suitable wall outlet.

5. Initial Power On:

- Press the Power button on the unit or remote control to turn on the system.
- Follow any on-screen prompts for initial setup, such as language selection and network configuration for Internet Radio.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

General Operation:

- Power On/Off: Press the POWER button.
- Volume Control: Rotate the VOLUME knob or use the VOL+/- buttons on the remote.
- Source Selection: Press the MODE or SOURCE button to cycle through Turntable, CD, DAB+, FM, Internet Radio, Bluetooth, AUX, and USB modes.

Turntable Operation:

- 1. Open the dust cover.
- 2. Place a vinyl record on the platter.
- 3. Select the appropriate speed (33 1/3, 45, or 78 RPM) using the speed selector switch.
- 4. Release the tonearm lock.
- 5. Gently lift the tonearm using the cueing lever and position the stylus over the desired track on the record.
- 6. Lower the tonearm slowly using the cueing lever. The record will begin to play.
- 7. At the end of the record, the tonearm may return automatically (if auto-return feature is present) or you may need to manually lift and return it to the tonearm rest.

CD Player Operation:

- 1. Press the CD button to select CD mode.
- 2. Press the OPEN/CLOSE button to open the CD tray.
- 3. Place a CD with the label side facing up into the tray.
- 4. Press OPEN/CLOSE again to close the tray. The CD will load and begin playing automatically.
- 5. Use PLAY/PAUSE, STOP, SKIP FORWARD/BACKWARD buttons for playback control.

Radio Operation (DAB+/FM):

- 1. Press the **DAB+** or **FM** button to select the desired radio mode.
- 2. For DAB+, the system will perform an auto-scan for available stations on first use.
- 3. For FM, use the TUNE+/- buttons to manually tune or press and hold for auto-scan.
- 4. To save a preset, tune to the desired station, then press and hold the PRESET button, select a preset number, and press ENTER.

Bluetooth Operation:

1. Press the **BLUETOOTH** button to select Bluetooth mode. The display will show "Pairing" or "Waiting for connection".

- 2. Enable Bluetooth on your mobile device (smartphone, tablet, etc.).
- 3. Search for "Lenco MC-660" in your device's Bluetooth list and select it to pair.
- 4. Once paired, you can play audio from your device through the Lenco MC-660 system.

Internet Radio Operation:

- 1. Ensure the unit is connected to your Wi-Fi network (configured during initial setup or via settings menu).
- 2. Press the INTERNET RADIO button.
- 3. Use the navigation buttons to browse stations by genre, location, or search for specific stations.
- 4. Press ENTER to select and play a station.

USB/MP3 Playback:

- 1. Insert a USB flash drive containing MP3 files into the USB port on the front panel.
- 2. Select **USB** mode. The system will automatically detect and begin playing MP3 files.
- 3. Use playback controls (PLAY/PAUSE, SKIP) to navigate your music.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Unit:

- · Always unplug the unit from the power outlet before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the exterior surfaces.
- For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water. Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents.

Turntable and Stylus Care:

- Keep the dust cover closed when not in use to prevent dust accumulation on the platter and stylus.
- · Clean the stylus gently with a soft brush designed for stylus cleaning, brushing from back to front.
- Replace the stylus approximately every 300-500 hours of playback, or if you notice a degradation in sound quality.

CD Player Care:

- Handle CDs by their edges to avoid fingerprints and scratches.
- Clean CDs with a soft, lint-free cloth, wiping from the center outwards.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cord not connected; Power outlet faulty	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in; Try a different outlet
No sound from speakers	Volume too low; Speakers not connected; Incorrect source selected	Increase volume; Check speaker connections; Select correct input source
Turntable sound distorted/skipping	Dirty or worn stylus; Dirty record; Unit not level	Clean or replace stylus; Clean record; Place unit on a level surface
CD not playing	CD inserted incorrectly; CD scratched/dirty; Incorrect mode	Re-insert CD correctly; Clean or replace CD; Select CD mode

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Poor radio reception	Antenna not extended; Weak signal	Extend and adjust antenna; Try repositioning the unit
Bluetooth pairing failure	Device too far; Bluetooth not enabled on device; Unit not in pairing mode	Move device closer; Enable Bluetooth; Ensure unit is in Bluetooth pairing mode
