1. Introduction

Welcome to your new Amazon Fire TV 55-inch 4-Series 4K UHD Smart TV. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your television. Your Fire TV combines stunning 4K Ultra HD visuals with the intelligence of Alexa, offering a seamless entertainment experience.

2. SETUP

2.1 Unpacking and Inspection

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Inspect the TV and accessories for any signs of damage. Retain the packaging for future transport or service needs.

2.2 Stand Assembly (Optional)

If you are not wall-mounting your TV, attach the included TV stand legs:

- 1. Place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
- 2. Align each stand leg with the corresponding slots on the bottom of the TV.
- 3. Secure each leg using the provided screws (4 screws total).

The distance between the TV legs is approximately 43.3 inches.

2.3 Wall Mounting (Optional)

For wall mounting, use a VESA-compatible mount that supports a 300 mm x 300 mm standard. Consult a professional for installation if you are unsure.

2.4 Connecting Peripherals

Connect your devices to the TV using the available ports:

- **HDMI Ports:** 3 HDMI 2.0 ports and 1 HDMI 2.1 port with eARC for high-definition audio and video devices (e.g., gaming consoles, Blu-ray players, soundbars).
- USB Port: 1 USB 3.0 port for connecting external storage devices.
- Digital Optical Audio Port: 1 port for connecting to external audio systems.
- Ethernet Port: 1 port for a wired internet connection.

Ensure all cables are securely connected.

2.5 Power Connection

Plug the power cord into the TV's power input, then into a wall outlet.

2.6 Remote Control Setup

Insert the two included AAA batteries into the Alexa Voice Remote Enhanced. The remote will automatically pair with your TV upon initial setup.

2.7 Initial Power On and Network Setup

Press the power button on the remote. Follow the on-screen instructions to:

- · Select your language.
- Connect to your Wi-Fi network (supports Wi-Fi 6) or use the Ethernet connection.
- · Sign in with your Amazon account.
- Complete the guided setup for your Fire TV experience.

3. OPERATING

3.1 Power On/Off

Press the power button on the Alexa Voice Remote Enhanced to turn the TV on or off. The TV may enter a sleep mode rather than fully powering down, allowing for quick startup and Ambient Experience features.

3.2 Alexa Voice Remote Enhanced

Your TV comes with an Alexa Voice Remote Enhanced, designed for intuitive control:

- **Voice Control:** Press and hold the Alexa button and speak naturally to find content, manage smart home devices, or ask guestions.
- Preset Buttons: Use the dedicated app buttons for quick access to your favorite streaming services.
- Navigation: Use the directional pad and select button to navigate the Fire OS interface.

Alternatively, you can use the free Fire TV app on your smartphone (available for Fire OS, Android, and iOS) for voice control and navigation.




Image: The Fire TV interface showing the Alexa search bar and icons for popular streaming applications, demonstrating voice control capabilities.

The Fire OS provides a personalized home screen where you can easily find and launch apps, movies, TV shows, and live TV. Navigate through categories and recommendations to discover new content. You can access over 1.8

million movies and TV episodes, including over 400,000 episodes of free content. Subscription fees may apply for certain services.




Image: A collage of streaming service logos and content thumbnails on the Fire TV screen, illustrating the wide range of available entertainment.

3.4 Picture Quality




Image: A visual comparison demonstrating the superior detail and clarity of 4K resolution compared to HD, using a close-up of a chameleon.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning Your TV

- Screen: Gently wipe the screen with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-cleaning solution specifically designed for electronics. Do not spray liquid directly onto the screen.
- Casing: Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the TV casing. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.

Always unplug the TV from the power outlet before cleaning.

4.2 Software Updates

Your Fire TV receives automatic software security updates. Ensure your TV is connected to the internet to receive these updates, which improve performance and security. This device receives guaranteed software security updates until at least four years after the device is last available for purchase as a new unit on our websites.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Amazon Fire TV, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

- No Power: Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the TV and a working wall outlet. Try a
 different outlet.
- No Picture/Sound: Verify that all HDMI cables are correctly connected to both the TV and your external devices. Check the input source on your TV.
- Remote Not Responding: Replace the AAA batteries in the Alexa Voice Remote Enhanced. Ensure there are
 no obstructions between the remote and the TV.
- **Network Connection Issues:** Check your Wi-Fi router and ensure it is functioning correctly. Restart your router and the TV. If using a wired connection, ensure the Ethernet cable is securely connected.
- Slow Performance: Restart your TV by unplugging it from the power outlet for 30 seconds and then plugging it back in. Clear cache for apps if necessary.
