


Image 1.2: Overview of the AKAI QLED Google TV's advanced features and sleek design.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

4. SETUP

4.1 Physical Installation

Depending on your preference, you can either mount your TV on a wall or place it on a table using the provided stands.

4.1.1 Table Mount Installation

- 1. Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, flat surface to prevent damage.
- 2. Attach the table mount stands to the designated slots on the bottom of the TV using the screws provided. Ensure they are securely fastened.
- 3. Place the TV on a stable, level surface.

4.1.2 Wall Mount Installation

For wall mounting, use the provided wall mount bracket. It is recommended to have this installation performed by qualified personnel to ensure safety and proper mounting.

- 1. Refer to the separate wall mount installation guide for detailed instructions.
- 2. Ensure the wall can support the weight of the TV (approximately 14.6 kg).

3. Securely attach the wall mount bracket to the wall and then to the TV.

4.2 Initial Power On and Connections

- 2. Connect any external devices (e.g., set-top box, gaming console) to the HDMI or USB ports.




Image 5.1: Using the remote control for voice commands with Google Assistant.




Image 5.2: Access to over 10,000+ apps through Google TV.




Image 5.4: Visual comparison demonstrating the enhanced color and clarity of QLED displays.



Image 5.5: HDR 10 and HLG technologies provide superior image quality with greater detail in highlights and shadows.




Image 5.6: Dolby Vision enhances screen visuals for a more lifelike experience.

6. MAINTENANCE

- · Avoid placing heavy objects on the TV.
- Keep the TV away from direct sunlight and heat sources.
- Ensure proper ventilation to prevent overheating.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cable disconnected; Power outlet not working.	Check power cable connection; Try a different outlet; Ensure power switch is on.
No picture, but sound is present	Incorrect input source selected; Loose HDMI/AV cable.	Press 'Input' button on remote to select correct source; Check cable connections.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound, but picture is present	Volume muted or too low; Incorrect audio output setting.	Unmute or increase volume; Check audio settings in TV menu.
Remote control not working	Batteries depleted; Obstruction between remote and TV.	Replace batteries; Remove any obstructions; Ensure remote is pointed at the TV's IR sensor.
Wi-Fi connection issues	Incorrect password; Router issues; TV too far from router.	Re-enter Wi-Fi password; Restart router; Move TV closer or use a Wi-Fi extender.


