INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your new Generic 6 Qt Programmable Slow Cooker. Please read all instructions carefully before first use and retain this manual for future reference. This slow cooker is designed for preparing meals for up to 7 people, featuring a 6-quart capacity, touch-activated display, and multiple cooking presets.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always unplug the slow cooker from the outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- Do not immerse the base unit, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Avoid touching hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- Do not use the slow cooker for anything other than its intended use.
- Ensure the ceramic cooking pot is properly seated in the base unit before adding ingredients and operating.

PARTS AND FEATURES

- Slow Cooker Base Unit (with touch-activated display)
- Removable Ceramic Cooking Pot (6-quart capacity)
- Tempered Glass Lid
- Stainless-Steel Lid Rest

SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and inspect the slow cooker for any damage.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash the removable ceramic cooking pot and tempered glass lid in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Wipe the exterior of the base unit with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the base unit in water.
3. **Assembly:** Place the clean ceramic cooking pot securely into the slow cooker base unit. Position the tempered glass lid on top of the ceramic pot. The stainless-steel lid rest can be attached to the lid handle for convenient placement during cooking or serving.
4. **Placement:** Place the slow cooker on a stable, heat-resistant surface, away from walls and other appliances to allow for proper ventilation. Ensure the power cord is not dangling where it can be pulled or tripped over.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

General Operation

1. **Prepare Ingredients:** Place your desired ingredients into the ceramic cooking pot.
2. **Secure Lid:** Place the tempered glass lid onto the ceramic pot.
3. **Plug In:** Plug the slow cooker into a standard 120V AC electrical outlet. The touch-activated display will illuminate.
4. **Select Mode:** Press the "Mode" button to cycle through the available cooking settings: LOW, HIGH, and WARM.
5. **Set Time:** Use the "+" and "-" buttons to adjust the cooking time. The programmable digital timer can be set from 30 minutes to 24 hours.
6. **Start Cooking:** Once the desired mode and time are set, the slow cooker will begin heating.
7. **Automatic Keep Warm:** After the set cooking time expires, the slow cooker will automatically switch to the "WARM" setting to keep your food at a serving temperature.

Preset Functions

This slow cooker features 5 intuitive cooking presets for common dishes:

- Meat
- Poultry
- Stew
- Soup
- Chili

To use a preset, simply select the desired preset from the touch-activated display. The slow cooker will automatically set the optimal temperature and time for that specific dish. You may adjust the time using the +/- buttons if needed.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Daily Cleaning

1. **Unplug and Cool:** Always unplug the slow cooker and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. **Removable Parts:** The ceramic cooking pot and tempered glass lid are dishwasher-safe. Alternatively, wash them in warm, soapy water, rinse, and dry thoroughly.
3. **Base Unit:** Wipe the exterior of the base unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads. Never immerse the base unit in water or any other liquid.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Slow cooker not turning on.	Not plugged in; power outlet issue; unit malfunction.	Ensure unit is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check household circuit breaker. If problem persists, contact customer support.
Food not cooking properly.	Incorrect temperature setting; lid not sealed; insufficient cooking time.	Verify the correct temperature setting (LOW/HIGH) and cooking time. Ensure the lid is properly seated to retain heat. Adjust cooking time as needed for specific recipes.
Display not responding to touch.	Moisture or debris on display; temporary electronic glitch.	Wipe the display clean with a dry cloth. Unplug the unit for 1 minute, then plug back in to reset.
