## INTRODUCTION

## SAFETY INFORMATION

---

- Always follow local building codes and regulations during installation.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents on the lock's finish. Use a soft, damp cloth for cleaning.
- Ensure batteries are inserted with correct polarity. Replace all batteries at the same time.
- Keep keys in a secure location away from the lock.
- Avoid exposing the electronic components to excessive moisture or extreme temperatures.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning installation, verify that all parts are present:

- Electronic Deadbolt Assembly (Exterior Keypad and Interior Unit)
- Passage Door Handle Assembly
- Deadbolt Latch
- Strike Plate
- Mounting Screws

- 1 x 9V Battery (may be included or sold separately, check packaging)
- Screwdriver (may be included or sold separately, check packaging)

## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

---

The Reliablit electronic deadbolt and passage handle are designed for easy installation, typically requiring only a screwdriver. Ensure your door thickness is between 1-3/8 inches and 1-3/4 inches.

### 1. Prepare the Door

Ensure the door is properly prepped with standard bore holes for both the deadbolt and the passage handle. If replacing an existing lock, remove the old hardware.

### 2. Install the Deadbolt Latch

Insert the deadbolt latch into the edge bore hole of the door. Ensure the "UP" arrow on the latch is facing upwards. Secure with screws.

### **3. Install the Exterior Keypad Assembly**

Feed the cable from the exterior keypad through the cross bore hole. Align the keypad assembly with the deadbolt latch and secure it to the door.

#### **4. Install the Interior Unit**

Connect the cable from the exterior keypad to the interior unit. Mount the interior unit onto the door, ensuring the deadbolt spindle engages correctly with the latch mechanism. Secure with mounting screws.

#### **5. Install Batteries**

Open the battery cover on the interior unit. Insert one 9V battery, ensuring correct polarity. Close the battery cover. The lock will perform a self-check.

#### **6. Install Passage Door Handle**

Follow the manufacturer's instructions for installing the passage door handle below the deadbolt. This typically involves inserting the spindle through the door and securing the interior and exterior levers.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Keyless Entry

To unlock the deadbolt using the keypad:

1. Enter your programmed user code (4-8 digits).
2. Press the "Lock/Unlock" button (often represented by a padlock icon).
3. The deadbolt will retract, allowing the door to be opened.

### One-Touch Locking

To lock the deadbolt from the outside:

- Simply press the "Lock/Unlock" button on the keypad. The deadbolt will extend.

### Manual Operation

- **From Outside:** Use the provided key to manually lock or unlock the deadbolt.
- **From Inside:** Use the turn button on the interior unit to manually lock or unlock the deadbolt.

### Programming User Codes

The lock supports up to 30 unique user codes. Refer to the specific programming instructions included with your lock for detailed steps on adding, deleting, or modifying user codes. This typically involves using a master code to enter programming mode.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Battery Replacement:** The 9V battery typically lasts up to 3 years. Replace the battery when the low battery indicator activates (if applicable) or if the lock's operation becomes sluggish. Always replace with a new, high-quality 9V alkaline battery.
- **Cleaning:** Clean the lock's exterior with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn marks, a slightly damp cloth can be used. Avoid harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or polishes as they can damage the finish and electronic components.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically lubricate the deadbolt latch mechanism with a silicone-based lubricant to ensure smooth operation. Do not lubricate the keypad or electronic components.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Lock does not respond to keypad entry.	Low or dead battery. Incorrect code entered.	Replace the 9V battery. Re-enter the correct user code.
Deadbolt does not extend/retract fully.	Misalignment during installation. Latch mechanism obstructed.	Check alignment of the deadbolt and strike plate. Clear any obstructions in the door frame. Lubricate the latch.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Keypad lights do not illuminate.	Battery issue.	Replace the 9V battery.
Cannot program new user codes.	Incorrect programming sequence. Master code not entered correctly.	Refer to the programming section of your specific lock's instructions. Ensure the master code is correct.
