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1. Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the Monitech Mo-S200 Digital Camera. This compact camera is designed for ease of use, offering various features for capturing high-quality photos and videos. 2. Safety Information

To prevent damage to the camera or injury to yourself or others, please observe the following safety precautions:

- Do not expose the camera to water or moisture.
- Avoid dropping the camera or subjecting it to strong impacts.
- Keep the camera away from direct sunlight or high temperatures for extended periods.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or modify the camera. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.
- Use only Monitech approved accessories and power sources.
- Keep batteries out of reach of children.

3. Package Contents

4. Initial Setup

4.1. Battery Installation

1. Open the battery compartment cover located at the bottom of the camera.
2. Insert the Lithium-Cobalt battery, ensuring the correct orientation as indicated by the markings inside the compartment.
3. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

4.2. Memory Card Installation

The camera supports memory cards up to 32 GB. A memory card is required to store photos and videos.

1. Locate the memory card slot, usually next to the battery compartment.
2. Insert the memory card with the contacts facing the correct direction until it clicks into place.
3. To remove, press the card gently until it springs out.

4.3. Charging the Battery

Connect the camera to a power source using the provided USB cable. The charging indicator light will illuminate. Once fully charged, the light will change or turn off.

5. Operating the Camera

5.1. Powering On/Off

Press and hold the Power button to turn the camera on or off. The 3-inch LED display will activate.

5.2. Basic Photography

To take a photo, select the photo mode using the mode dial. Frame your shot using the 3-inch LED screen. The camera features auto-focus to ensure clear images. Press the shutter button halfway to focus, then fully to capture the image.

5.3. Digital Zoom

The camera features a 16x digital zoom. Use the zoom lever (T/W) to adjust the magnification. 'T' zooms in (telephoto), and 'W' zooms out (wide-angle).

5.4. Shooting Modes

The Mo-S200 offers multiple shooting functions:

- **Continuous Shooting:** Capture a rapid sequence of photos by holding down the shutter button.
- **Time-lapse Shooting:** Record a series of images over an interval to create a time-lapse video.

5.5. Video Recording

Switch to video mode using the mode dial. The camera supports 4K video recording and includes features like HDR, fast lens, slow motion, and loop recording. Press the record button to start and stop recording.

5.6. Connectivity

The camera offers versatile connectivity options:

- **HDMI Output:** Connect the camera to a TV or monitor using an HDMI cable to view your photos and videos on a larger screen.
- **WiFi Transmission:** Transfer photos and videos wirelessly to your smartphone or other devices via WiFi.
- **USB:** Connect to a computer for file transfer or charging.

6. Maintenance

6.1. Cleaning the Camera

Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the camera body. For the lens, use a specialized lens cleaning cloth and solution. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.

6.2. Storage

When not in use for extended periods, remove the battery and store the camera in a cool, dry place, away from dust and extreme temperatures.

7. Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Camera does not power on.	Battery is depleted or incorrectly inserted.	Charge the battery or re-insert it correctly.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cannot take photos/videos.	Memory card is full or not inserted.	Insert a memory card or delete unnecessary files.
Images are blurry.	Lens is dirty, or camera is not focused.	Clean the lens. Ensure auto-focus is engaged by pressing the shutter button halfway.
No image on external display via HDMI.	HDMI cable is loose or incorrect input selected on TV.	Check HDMI connection. Select correct HDMI input on your TV/monitor.
