1. INTRODUCTION

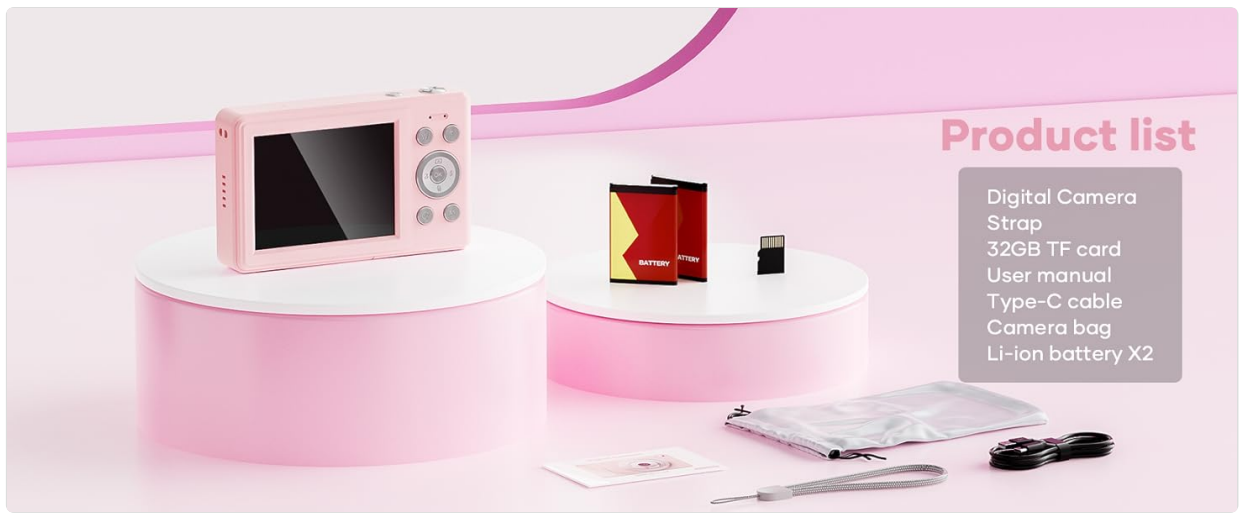


Figure 3.1: Package Contents

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

5. SETUP

5.1 Battery Installation

1. Open the battery compartment cover located on the side of the camera.
2. Insert the rechargeable battery with the metal contacts facing down and to the right, ensuring it clicks into place.
3. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

5.2 SD Card Installation

The camera supports a 32GB TF (Micro SD) card. Insert the TF card into the designated slot in the battery compartment until it clicks.

5.3 Charging the Battery

1. Connect the camera to a power source using the provided Type-C USB cable.
2. The charging indicator light will show the charging status. A bright red, steady light indicates correct charging. A dim, flickering light indicates an issue.

5.4 Attaching the Lanyard

Thread the lanyard through the designated loop on the camera body to prevent accidental drops.

6. OPERATING THE CAMERA

6.1 Power On/Off

Press and hold the Power button (labeled ON/OFF) on the top of the camera to turn it on or off.

6.2 Taking Photos

In photo mode, frame your shot using the LCD screen and press the Shutter button to capture an image. The camera features 56MP resolution for clear photos.

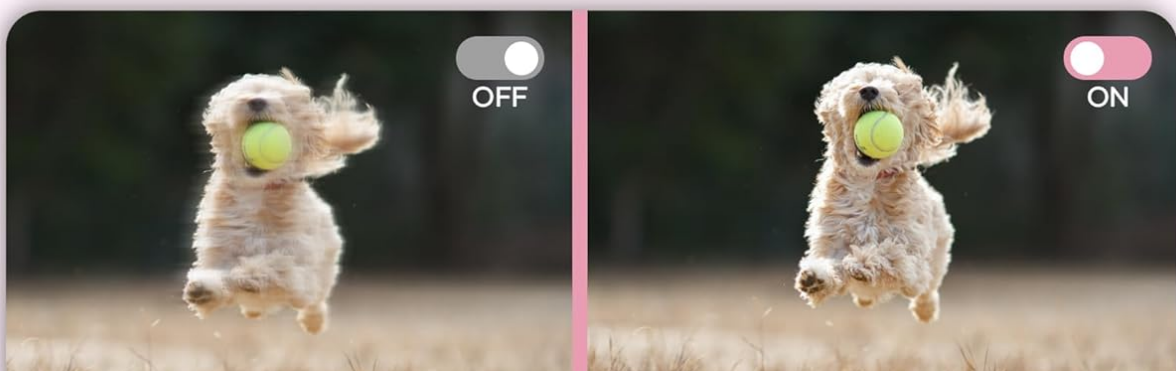
- **16x Digital Zoom:** Use the 'W' and 'T' buttons to zoom in or out.

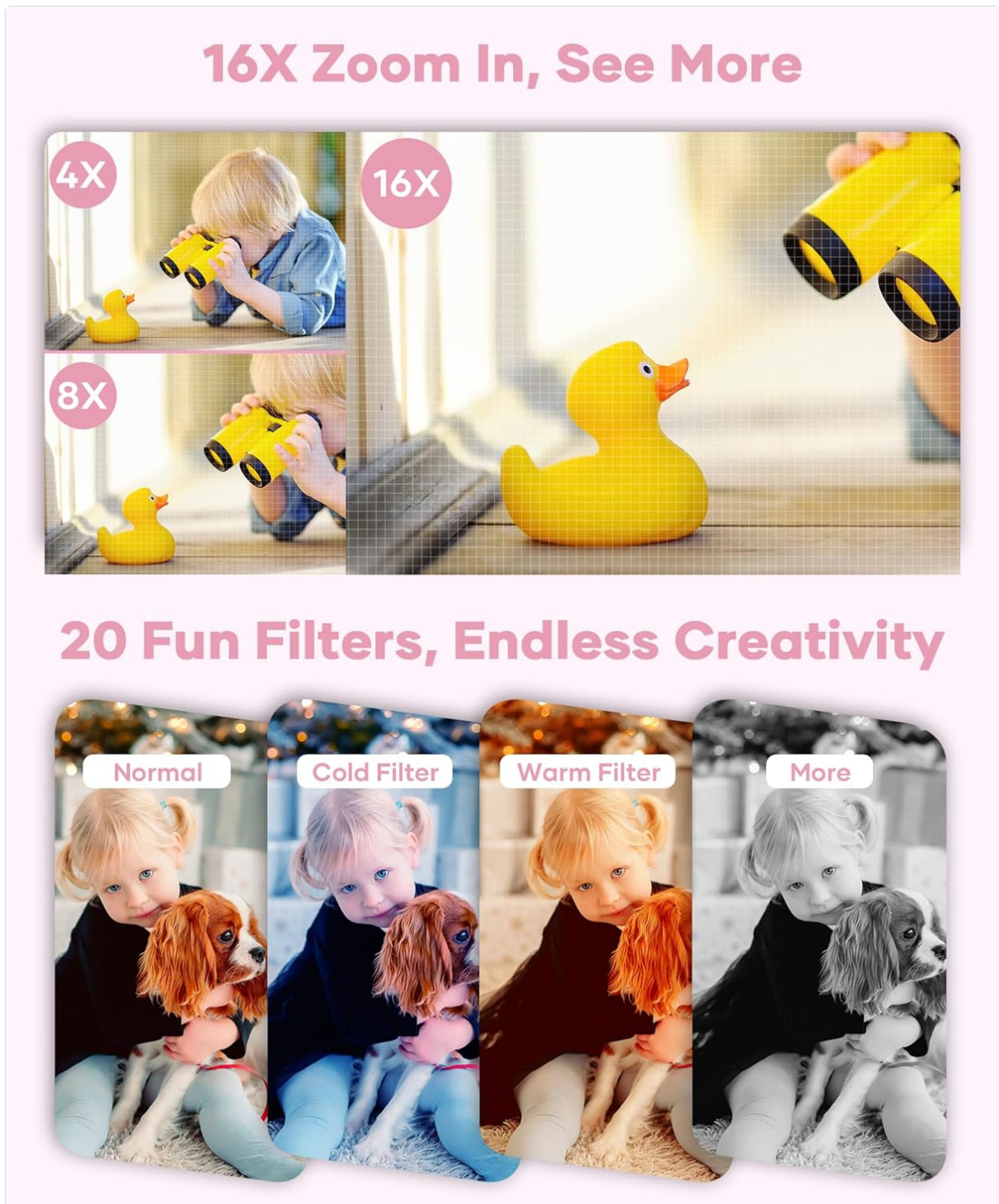


Figure 6.3: Zoom and Creative Filters

6.3 Recording Videos

Switch to video mode (usually indicated by a camcorder icon in the menu) and press the Shutter button to start recording. Press again to stop. Videos are recorded in FHD 1080P with a built-in microphone.

6.4 Playback/Viewing Media

Press the Playback button to enter playback mode. Use the navigation buttons to scroll through your photos and videos. Press the OK button to play videos.

6.5 Transferring Files

You have several options to transfer your media:

- **USB to PC:** Connect the camera to your computer using the Type-C cable. The camera will appear as a removable disk.
- **OTG to Phone:** Use a compatible OTG cable adapter (sold separately) to connect the camera to your smartphone (e.g., iPhone 15, Samsung).
- **Card Reader:** Remove the TF card and insert it into a card reader to transfer files to a computer or phone.

Connect the camera to a computer via the Type-C USB cable. Select 'Webcam' mode on the camera (if prompted) to use it for video calls or live streaming.

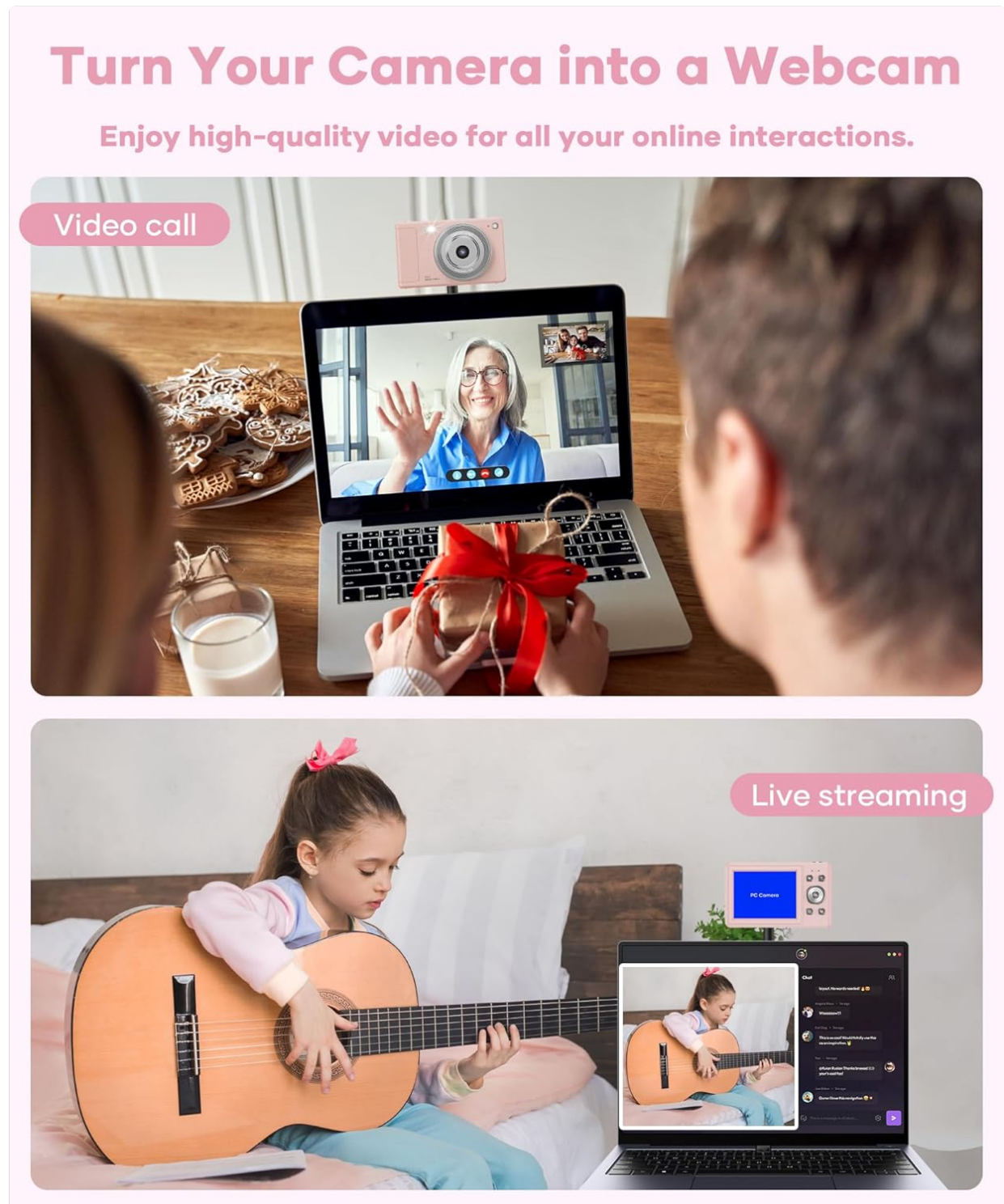


Figure 6.5: Camera as a Webcam

8. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the camera body and screen. For the lens, use a specialized lens cleaning cloth and solution.
- **Storage:** Store the camera in its provided storage bag in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and humidity. Remove the battery if the camera will not be used for an extended period.
- **Battery Care:** Fully charge batteries before first use. Avoid completely draining the battery frequently to prolong its lifespan.

9. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Camera does not power on.	Ensure the battery is correctly inserted and fully charged.
Cannot take photos/record videos.	Check if the SD card is inserted correctly and has sufficient free space. Ensure the battery is not critically low.
Images are blurry.	Ensure the lens is clean. Use the anti-shake feature. Hold the camera steady while shooting.
Cannot transfer files to computer/phone.	Verify the USB cable connection. Ensure the camera is in the correct mode for data transfer (if prompted). Try a different USB port or cable. For phones, ensure OTG compatibility and adapter.
Charging indicator is flickering.	Refer to Figure 5.2 for correct charging status. Re-insert the cable or try a different power source.
