1. INTRODUCTION AND PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Falk Claas Axion 410 2040AM Pedal Excavator Loader. Designed for children aged 2 to 5 years, this durable plastic toy offers an authentic Claas design, promoting motor skills and imaginative outdoor play. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use, and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

To ensure the safety of the child and others, always adhere to the following guidelines:

- **Adult Supervision Required:** Always supervise children during play. Never leave a child unattended with the toy.
- **Age Recommendation:** This toy is suitable for children aged 2 to 5 years. It is not intended for children outside this age range.
- **Weight Limit:** Do not exceed the maximum user weight of 29.94 kg (66 lbs).
- **Assembly:** Ensure all parts are correctly and securely assembled by an adult before the toy is used. Regularly check for loose components.
- **Playing Environment:** Use the toy on flat, stable, and clear surfaces. Avoid slopes, uneven terrain, stairs, public roads, busy areas, and proximity to water bodies (pools, ponds, etc.).
- **Footwear:** Children should wear appropriate footwear while operating the toy.
- **No Modifications:** Do not modify the toy in any way, as this may compromise its safety and structural integrity.
- **Hazard Awareness:** Instruct children on safe operation, including avoiding obstacles and being aware of their surroundings.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Falk Claas Axion 410 2040AM Pedal Excavator Loader requires adult assembly. Please follow the detailed instructions and diagrams provided in the product packaging. A general overview of the assembly process is provided below:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and verify that all components are present against the parts list in your product box.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Falk Claas Axion 410 2040AM is designed for intuitive manual operation, allowing children to engage in active play.

- **Pedaling:** The child sits on the seat and places their feet on the pedals. By pushing the pedals in a circular motion, the toy moves forward or backward.
- **Steering:** The steering wheel controls the direction of the front wheels. Turning the wheel left or right will guide the tractor accordingly.
- **Front Loader Operation:** The front loader is manually operated. The child can use the levers or handles (if present, typically manual) to raise, lower, scoop, and dump materials like sand or small toys.
- **Trailer Use:** The detachable trailer can be used to transport lightweight items. Ensure the trailer is securely attached to the tractor's hitch before loading.

Encourage children to practice steering and pedaling in an open, safe area to develop coordination and control.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the lifespan of your Falk Claas Axion 410 2040AM Pedal Excavator Loader.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the plastic surfaces with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the plastic.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the toy for any signs of wear, damage, or loose parts. Pay close attention to the wheels, axles, steering mechanism, and loader connections.
- **Tighten Fasteners:** If any screws, bolts, or fasteners appear loose, tighten them immediately using appropriate tools. Do not overtighten.
- **Storage:** Store the toy in a dry, sheltered area when not in use. Protect it from extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, and prolonged exposure to rain or moisture, which can degrade the plastic and colors over time.
- **Lubrication:** Moving parts generally do not require lubrication. If any part becomes stiff, ensure it is clean and free of debris.
