1. Introduction



3. Setup

3.1. Connecting the Tablet

Your Wacom Intuos Pro Small offers both wired and wireless connectivity options.


Wired Connection:

- 1. Connect the USB-C end of the provided cable to the tablet's USB-C port.
- 2. Connect the USB-A end of the cable to an available USB port on your computer. If your computer only has USB-C ports, use the included USB-A to USB-C adapter.

Bluetooth Connection:

The tablet supports Bluetooth 5.3 Low Energy for wireless operation.

- 1. Ensure your computer's Bluetooth is enabled.
- 2. On the tablet, slide the USB/Bluetooth selector switch to one of the Bluetooth positions (BT1 or BT2).
- 3. Press and hold the power button on the tablet until the Bluetooth indicator light begins to flash, indicating pairing mode.
- 4. On your computer, navigate to Bluetooth settings and select the Wacom Intuos Pro Small from the list of available devices to pair.

3.2. Driver Installation

- 1. Visit the official Wacom website (wacom.com/start/intuospro) to download the latest drivers for your operating system (Windows or macOS).
- 2. Follow the on-screen instructions to install the drivers. A restart of your computer may be required.
- 3. Once installed, the Wacom Desktop Center application will allow you to customize tablet and pen settings.

4. Operating the Tablet

4.1. Using the Pro Pen 3

The Wacom Pro Pen 3 offers 8192 levels of pressure sensitivity and tilt recognition for precise control.

- Holding the Pen: Hold the pen as you would a traditional drawing tool. The pen tip acts as your cursor.
- Pen Buttons: The Pro Pen 3 features three customizable buttons. By default, these buttons
 perform functions such as right-click, scroll, or modifier keys. Customize their functions in the
 Wacom Desktop Center.
- **Customization:** The Pro Pen 3 allows for physical customization with different grips and weight balances to suit your preference. Refer to the Quick Start Guide for instructions on changing pen components.

4.2. ExpressKeys and Dial

The tablet features 5 customizable ExpressKeys and a Dial for quick access to frequently used functions and shortcuts.

- ExpressKeys: Assign specific keyboard shortcuts, mouse clicks, or application-specific functions to each ExpressKey via the Wacom Desktop Center.
- **Dial:** The Dial can be configured for various functions such as zooming, scrolling, brush size adjustment, or layer navigation. Cycle through different Dial modes using the center button.



4.3. Battery Information

The tablet is equipped with a 1200mAh battery, providing up to 16 hours of use. Charging times are approximately 3.5 hours for a normal charge and 2 hours for rapid charging via a DC 5V input.

5. Maintenance

5.1. Cleaning the Tablet and Pen

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive materials, as these can damage the surface.
- Ensure the tablet and pen are completely dry before use.

5.2. Replacing Pen Nibs

The pen stand contains replacement nibs and a nib removal tool.

- 1. Gently pull the worn nib straight out of the pen using the nib removal tool.
- 2. Insert a new nib firmly into the pen until it clicks into place.

6. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your Wacom Intuos Pro Small, try the following steps:

• No Pen Response:

- Ensure the tablet is powered on and connected (USB or Bluetooth).
- Check if the pen nib is properly inserted.
- Verify that the Wacom drivers are installed and up to date.
- · Restart your computer.

• Bluetooth Connectivity Issues:

- Ensure the tablet's Bluetooth selector is in the correct position (BT1 or BT2).
- Remove the tablet from your computer's Bluetooth device list and re-pair it.
- Try connecting via USB to confirm the tablet is functional.

• ExpressKeys/Dial Not Working:

- Open the Wacom Desktop Center and check the customization settings.
- Ensure the drivers are correctly installed.


