# Nike AIR Zoom Pegasus 41 Women's Laced Running Shoes User Manual

## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Nike Air Zoom Pegasus 41 is a women's laced running shoe designed for comfort and performance. It features an upgraded breathable engineered mesh upper for enhanced ventilation and a ReactX foam midsole. This midsole surrounds both forefoot and heel Air Zoom units, providing an energized and responsive ride suitable for various running activities.

## 2. SETUP: WEARING YOUR SHOES

Proper lacing ensures a secure and comfortable fit, crucial for optimal performance and injury prevention. Follow these steps to correctly wear your Nike Air Zoom Pegasus 41 shoes:

1. **Unlace:** Loosen the laces completely to allow your foot to slide in easily.
2. **Insert Foot:** Place your foot into the shoe, ensuring your heel is seated firmly against the back of the shoe.
3. **Adjust Tongue:** Center the shoe's tongue over the top of your foot.
4. **Lace Up:** Starting from the bottom eyelets, pull the laces evenly, working your way up. Ensure the laces are snug but not overly tight, allowing for natural foot movement.
5. **Tie Knot:** Secure the laces with a double knot to prevent them from coming undone during activity.

The breathable mesh upper is designed to conform to your foot, providing a supportive yet flexible fit. Adjust lacing tension as needed for personal comfort.

## 4. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

---

Proper care extends the lifespan and maintains the performance of your running shoes.

### Cleaning Instructions:

- **Remove Dirt:** Gently brush off loose dirt and mud from the upper and outsole using a soft brush or cloth.
- **Hand Wash:** Mix a small amount of mild soap with warm water. Use a cloth or soft brush to clean the surface of the shoes. Avoid harsh detergents or abrasive cleaners.
- **Rinse:** Wipe the shoes with a clean, damp cloth to remove soap residue. Do not submerge the shoes in water.
- **Air Dry:** Allow the shoes to air dry at room temperature. Avoid direct sunlight or heat sources, as these can damage materials. You can stuff them with paper towels to help absorb moisture and maintain shape.
- **Laces and Insoles:** Remove laces and insoles for separate washing if needed.

**Do not machine wash or machine dry your shoes.** This can damage the materials, cushioning, and

overall structure.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your Nike Air Zoom Pegasus 41 shoes, consider the following common solutions:

- **Discomfort or Rubbing:** Ensure your shoes are properly laced and that you are wearing appropriate running socks. Check if the shoe size is correct; an ill-fitting shoe can cause discomfort.
- **Squeaking Noise:** A new shoe might squeak due to friction between parts. This often resolves with wear. If persistent, ensure insoles are properly seated.
- **Excessive Wear:** Uneven wear patterns on the outsole can indicate gait issues or that the shoes are past their effective lifespan. Running shoes typically last 300-500 miles, depending on individual use and running style.
