PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The reie D200 is a portable smart projector featuring integrated Google TV, native 1080p resolution with 4K support, and automatic optimization functions. It offers versatile connectivity options including Wi-Fi and Bluetooth.

- **Wireless Connectivity:** Equipped with 5G/2.4G dual-band Wi-Fi and Bluetooth for stable connections.

SETUP

1. Initial Power On

1. Connect the power cord to the projector and a power outlet.
2. Press the power button on the projector or the remote control to turn on the device.

2. Connecting to Wi-Fi

1. Navigate to the 'Settings' menu on the projector's interface.

2. Select 'Network & Internet'.
3. Choose your desired 5G or 2.4G Wi-Fi network from the list.
4. Enter the Wi-Fi password and select 'Connect'.

3. Automatic Optimization

The D200 projector is designed for instant setup. Upon powering on or moving the projector, it will automatically perform the following adjustments:

- **Auto Focus:** Adjusts the image clarity automatically.
- **Auto Keystone Correction:** Corrects distorted images to a rectangular shape.
- **Auto Obstacle Avoidance:** Detects and adjusts the projection to avoid obstacles on the wall.
- **Auto Screen Alignment:** Optimizes the image to fit the projection surface.

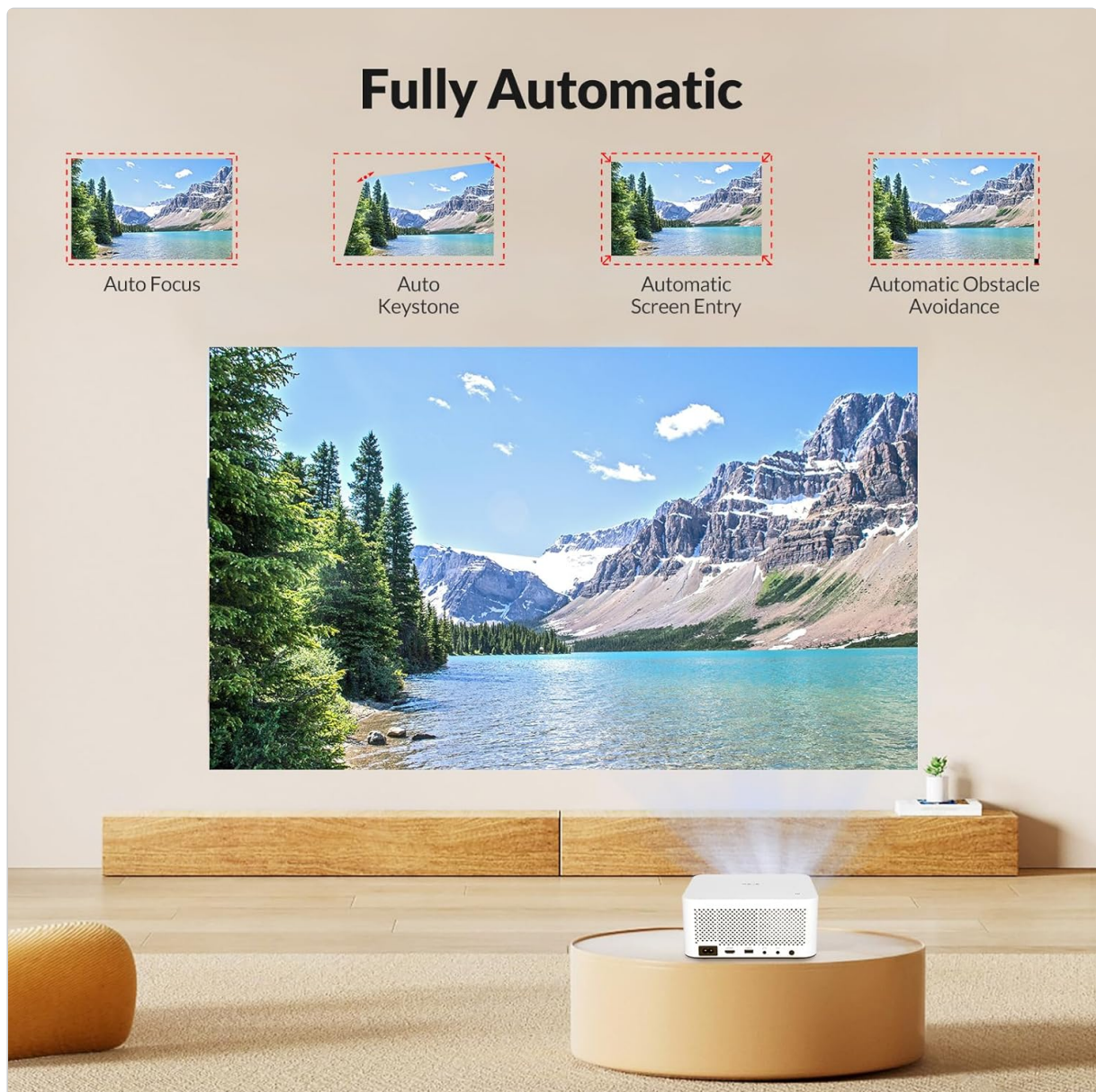


Image: Visual representation of the projector's fully automatic adjustment features.

4. Connecting External Devices

The projector offers multiple ports for connecting external devices:

- **HDMI Input:** Connect gaming consoles, laptops, TV sticks, or DVD players.
- **USB Input:** Connect USB memory devices or mini keyboards.

- **Audio Output:** Connect external speakers or headphones.
- **Bluetooth:** Pair with Bluetooth speakers or headphones for enhanced audio.



Image: Diagram illustrating various device compatibility with the projector.

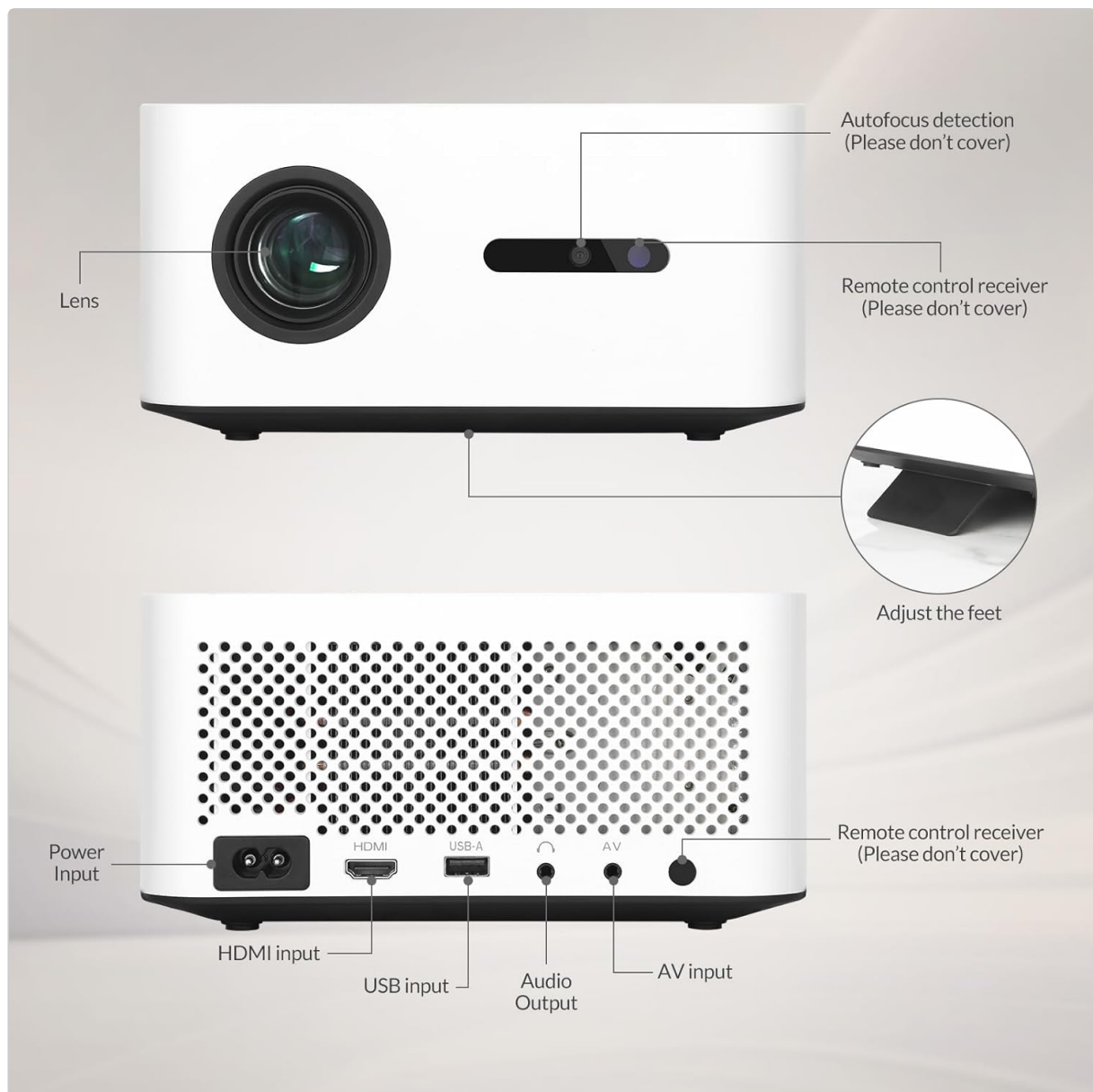


Image: Detailed view of the projector's input/output ports and controls.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remote Control Functions

The included remote control provides full navigation and control over the projector's functions:

- **Power Button**: Turns the projector on/off.
- **Google Assistant Button**: Activates voice commands for content search and control.
- **Navigation Pad (Up/Down/Left/Right/OK)**: For menu navigation and selection.
- **Home Button**: Returns to the main Google TV interface.
- **Back Button**: Returns to the previous screen.
- **Volume +/-**: Adjusts the audio volume.
- **Dedicated App Buttons**: Quick access to Netflix, YouTube, Prime Video, etc.

2. Google TV Interface

The Google TV interface provides seamless access to a vast library of applications and content. Use the remote control to navigate through apps, personalized recommendations, and settings.

3. Screen Mirroring

To wirelessly cast content from your smartphone or tablet:

- Ensure your device and the projector are connected to the same Wi-Fi network.
- For iOS devices, download the 'AirScreen' app on the projector.
- Select the appropriate mirroring option (iOS Wi-Fi Mirroring or Android Mirroring) from the projector's main menu.
- Follow the on-screen instructions to connect your device.

4. Adjusting Display

The projector automatically adjusts focus and keystone. For manual adjustments or specific settings:

- Navigate to 'Settings' > 'Picture' for manual keystone correction or image zoom.
- The projector supports screen sizes up to 100 inches.

5. Audio Settings

The projector features built-in speakers with Dolby Audio. For external audio:

- Connect Bluetooth speakers/headphones via 'Settings' > 'Bluetooth'.
- Use the 3.5mm audio output jack for wired external audio devices.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your projector.

1. Cleaning the Lens

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical lenses.
- Gently wipe the lens surface to remove dust or smudges. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.

2. Ventilation

- Ensure the projector's ventilation vents are clear and unobstructed to prevent overheating.
- Do not place the projector on soft surfaces that may block airflow.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your projector, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Solution
Blurry image / Out of focus	Ensure the projector is on a stable surface. The projector features auto-focus; if issues persist, check for obstructions in front of the lens or try restarting.
No Wi-Fi connection	Verify your Wi-Fi network is active and the password is correct. Ensure the projector is within range of your router. Try restarting both the projector and your router.
No sound or poor audio quality	Check volume settings on the projector and any connected external audio devices. Ensure Bluetooth devices are properly paired. If using wired audio, check cable connections.

Problem	Solution
Input lag with external devices	Ensure HDMI cables are securely connected. Try a different HDMI port or cable. Some devices may inherently have slight input lag.
Apps not loading or updating	Verify a stable internet connection. Check for available system updates in 'Settings' > 'System'. Clear app cache or reinstall problematic apps.


