1. INTRODUCTION

The iDOO Electric Composter is a countertop appliance designed to convert food waste into nutrient-rich fertilizer. This system processes organic materials, reducing their volume and preparing them for garden use. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation and maintenance of your composter.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions carefully before using the iDOO Electric Composter. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the appliance.

- Always use gloves when handling food waste.
- Keep the composter clean to prevent pest attraction.
- Unplug the composter from the power outlet before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- Do not compost sharp objects such as knives or broken glass.
- Do not compost hazardous materials, chemicals, or non-biodegradable items.
- Ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, level surface.
- Keep out of reach of children and pets.
- Follow standard electrical appliance safety precautions, including not immersing the unit in water.

3. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the main parts of your iDOO Electric Composter:

- **Main Unit:** The primary housing of the composter.
- **Composting Bucket:** A removable aluminum alloy bucket with Teflon coating for easy cleaning, where food waste is processed.
- **Lid:** Covers the composting bucket, featuring a secure lock and integrated filter compartment.

- **Activated Carbon Filter:** Located in the lid, this filter helps neutralize odors during operation. Two packs are included for simultaneous use.
- **Control Panel:** Features buttons and indicators for power, cycle start/pause, and child lock.

4. SETUP GUIDE

Follow these steps to set up your iDOO Electric Composter:

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and inspect the composter for any damage.
2. **Placement:** Place the composter on a stable, flat surface in a well-ventilated area. While the unit has odor control, using it in areas like a garage, greenhouse, laundry room, or balcony is recommended to ensure optimal air circulation.
3. **Install Filter:** Open the filter compartment in the lid and insert the activated carbon filters. Ensure they are properly seated.

4. **Insert Bucket:** Place the composting bucket into the main unit. Ensure it is securely positioned.
5. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Operating your iDOO Electric Composter is a straightforward process:

1. **Add Food Waste:** Open the lid and add your approved food scraps to the composting bucket. Do not fill above the indicated fill line on the metal bucket, and avoid packing the material down tightly to ensure proper processing.
2. **Close Lid:** Securely close the lid. The composter features a safety lock; if the lid is not properly closed and locked, the unit will not start.
3. **Start Cycle:** Press the power button, then select the desired composting cycle. The machine will automatically proceed through drying, grinding, and cooling phases. A typical cycle lasts 6-10 hours.
4. **Monitor Progress:** The control panel will indicate the current stage of the composting process. You can pause the program at any time to check the contents.
5. **Retrieve Compost:** Once the cycle is complete and the unit has cooled, open the lid and remove the composting bucket. The processed material will be a dry, nutrient-rich fertilizer.

What Can Go into the iDOO Composter?

The iDOO Electric Composter is designed to process a variety of organic waste:

- Fruit and vegetable scraps
- Fruit pits (soft pits only)
- Soft bones (e.g., fish bones)
- Soft shells (e.g., eggshells, nut shells)
- Starches (e.g., bread, pasta)
- Dairy products (in moderation)
- Coffee grounds & tea bags
- Houseplants and small amounts of yard waste
- Degradable paper (e.g., paper towels, coffee filters)

Turn Waste Into Compost

Tips: To avoid odors in your home, it is recommended to use the compost bin in ventilated places such as the garage, greenhouse, laundry room, balcony, etc.

Items to Avoid:

- Large, hard bones (e.g., beef, pork)
- Excessively fibrous items (e.g., asparagus bottoms, corn cobs, artichokes)
- Large quantities of very starchy items (can become gummy)
- Cooking oils, grease, and liquids
- Non-food items, plastics, metals, glass
- Chemicals or cleaning agents

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and efficiency of your composter:

- **Cleaning the Composting Bucket:** The aluminum alloy bucket is removable and features a Teflon coating for easy cleaning. It is also dishwasher safe. The unit may also have a self-washing button for convenience.
- **Replacing Activated Carbon Filters:** The activated carbon filters should be replaced periodically (refer to product guidelines or when odors become noticeable) to maintain effective odor control.
- **Cleaning the Main Unit:** Wipe the exterior of the composter with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the unit in water. Ensure the unit is unplugged before cleaning.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your iDOO Electric Composter, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Composter does not start	Lid not properly closed/locked; Power not connected; Child lock engaged.	Ensure the lid is securely closed and locked. Check power connection. Disengage child lock if active.
"E" code error displayed	Overfilling or tightly packing the composting bucket.	Unplug the unit to reset. Reduce the amount of waste in the bucket, ensuring it is below the fill line and loosely packed.
Unpleasant odors during operation	Activated carbon filter needs replacement; Unit placed in a poorly ventilated area.	Replace activated carbon filters. Ensure the composter is in a well-ventilated location.
Machine gets warm to the touch	Normal operation during drying phase.	This is normal. Ensure adequate clearance around the unit for heat dissipation.
Eggshells or other items not fully broken down	Some harder materials are crushed rather than fully composted.	This is expected for certain items. The output is still suitable for garden use.
