1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions before assembly and use. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Weight Limit:** Do not exceed the maximum weight limit of 264 lb (120 kg) per chair.
- **Assembly:** Ensure proper assembly to prevent tipping and ensure stability. All screws and fasteners must be securely tightened.
- **Maintenance:** Regularly check all connections to ensure they remain tight.
- **Placement:** Use chairs on a level surface.

2. PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Durable Construction:** Crafted from premium solid wood for a sturdy frame and a smooth finish.
- **Removable Cushions:** Includes cushions that can be removed, offering comfort in various seasons and ease of cleaning.
- **Ergonomic Backrest:** Features a slightly curved backrest designed to conform to the natural curve of your back for optimal support.
- **Floor Protection:** Equipped with felt pads on the legs to prevent scratches and damage to your flooring.

3. INCLUDED COMPONENTS

4. SETUP & ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to assemble your dining chairs. It is recommended to assemble on a soft, clean surface to prevent damage.

Step-by-Step Instructions

1. **Prepare Backrest:** Insert wooden dowels (2) into the designated holes on part C (Backrest).
2. **Attach Side Rails:** Connect parts E (Left Side Rail) and F (Right Side Rail) to part C using the inserted wooden dowels.
3. **Connect to Front Leg Frame:** Align the assembled backrest (C) and side rails (E, F) with part A (Front Leg Frame). Secure them using long screws (1) and the Allen wrench (4).
4. **Attach Front Stretcher:** Connect part G (Front Stretcher) to the lower section of part A (Front Leg Frame) using long screws (1).
5. **Complete Frame:** Attach part B (Back Leg Frame) to the remaining open ends of the side rails (E, F) and the backrest (C) using long screws (1). Ensure all connections are tight.
6. **Install Seat Panel:** Place part D (Seat Panel) onto the assembled frame. Secure it from

underneath using L-brackets (I) and short screws (3).

7. **Attach Cushion:** Place the removable cushion (H) onto the seat panel. Tie the cushion straps securely to the chair frame to prevent it from sliding.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your VASAGLE dining chairs are designed for comfortable and stable seating in dining rooms, kitchens, or living areas.

- **Seating:** Sit centrally on the chair, ensuring your weight is evenly distributed.
- **Cushion Use:** The removable cushions provide enhanced comfort. They can be used year-

round, offering warmth in cooler seasons and easily removed for a cooler seating option in warmer weather.

- **Moving Chairs:** When moving the chairs, lift them rather than dragging to prevent damage to the chair legs and your flooring.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your dining chairs.

- **Cleaning the Frame:** Wipe the wooden frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Cushion Care:** The cushion covers are removable via a zipper for easy cleaning. Follow the care instructions on the cushion label for washing.
- **Felt Pads:** Periodically check the felt pads on the chair legs for wear and tear. Replace if necessary to continue protecting your floors.

- **Tighten Fasteners:** Every few months, check and retighten all screws and bolts to ensure the chair remains stable and secure.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Chair Wobbles:**

- Ensure all screws and bolts are fully tightened.
- Check that the chair is on a flat, even surface.

- Verify that all parts were assembled correctly according to the instructions. Disassemble and reassemble if necessary, ensuring parts are aligned before tightening.

- Difficulty Assembling:**

- Review the assembly video and step-by-step instructions carefully.
- Ensure you are using the correct hardware for each step.
- Do not overtighten screws until all parts are loosely fitted, then tighten them gradually.

- Cushion Slides:**

- Ensure the cushion straps are securely tied to the chair frame.
