IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: CHOKING HAZARD – Small parts. Not for children under 3 years.

- Adult supervision is required at all times.
- Always ensure children wear appropriate safety gear, including a helmet.
- Do not operate the vehicle near public roads, motor vehicles, steep inclines, steps, or swimming pools.
- Ensure all seat belts are securely fastened before the vehicle is in motion.
- This vehicle is designed for a maximum of two riders. Do not exceed this limit.
- The maximum weight capacity for this vehicle is 110 lbs (50 kg).
- Charge the battery fully before the first use and after each subsequent use.
- Keep hands, feet, and clothing away from all moving parts.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to assemble your ARBELI Ride-On Truck. For a visual guide, please refer to the installation video below.

1. Unpack all components and verify against the package contents list.
2. Install the rear axle and shock absorbers. Secure the metal frame and springs with the provided nuts and washers.
3. Attach the rear wheels to the axle, securing them with the appropriate hardware.
4. Install the front wheels, ensuring they are properly aligned and secured.
5. Connect the steering column wiring and firmly attach the steering wheel.
6. Connect the main battery terminals.
7. Install the seats and secure them using the provided screws.
8. Assemble and attach the roll bar with LED lights, connecting the necessary wiring.
9. Attach the front bumper to the vehicle's front.
10. Install 2 x 1.5 AAA batteries (not included) into the remote control.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Starting the Vehicle

1. Ensure the battery is fully charged and properly connected.
2. Press the power button on the dashboard to turn on the vehicle.
3. Select the desired speed (High or Low) using the speed switch on the dashboard.
4. Press the foot pedal to initiate movement.

Driving Modes

- **Manual Driving:** The child operates the steering wheel and foot pedal directly.

- **Remote Control Mode:** An adult can override manual control using the 2.4G remote control for enhanced safety. The remote allows for steering, speed adjustment (3 variable speeds), and an emergency brake feature.

- **Music Playback:** Utilize the built-in music player for pre-loaded tunes.
- **Bluetooth Connectivity:** Pair your mobile device via Bluetooth to play custom songs or stories.
- **LED Lights:** Activate the bright headlights and stylish searchlights for an enhanced driving experience.
- **Real Horn:** Press the horn button on the steering wheel for an authentic sound.

MAINTENANCE

Battery Charging

Locate the charging port, typically found under the seat. Connect the provided charger. For the first use, charge the battery for 8-12 hours. Subsequent charges should take approximately 8-10 hours. Avoid overcharging to prolong battery life.

Cleaning

Wipe the vehicle's surfaces with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Ensure no water comes into contact with electrical components to prevent damage.

Storage

Store the ride-on truck in a dry, cool environment away from direct sunlight. If storing for an extended period, disconnect the battery to prevent discharge.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vehicle does not move	Battery not connected or discharged; Power button off; Remote control not paired.	Check battery connections and charge; Turn on power button; Re-pair remote control.
Vehicle moves slowly	Low battery charge; Low speed setting selected; Overloaded vehicle.	Charge battery fully; Select high speed setting; Reduce load on vehicle.
Remote control not working	Remote control batteries are dead; Remote control not paired.	Replace remote control batteries; Re-pair the remote control with the vehicle.
Lights not working	Loose wire connection; Damaged LED.	Check all light connections; Contact customer support if LEDs are damaged.
