1. INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides comprehensive instructions for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Cecotec FREIDORA 100500 CECOFRY&GRILL DUOHEAT 65 air fryer. This appliance features a double resistance system for optimal browning and grilling, a 6.5-liter capacity, and 2200W power, designed for preparing healthy dishes.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using the appliance. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

- Always place the appliance on a stable, heat-resistant surface, away from walls and other heat sources.
- Do not immerse the cord, plug, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Do not use accessories not recommended by the appliance manufacturer, as this may cause injuries.
- Do not let the cord hang over the edge of a table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Do not use the appliance for other than intended use.
- Ensure the appliance is properly ventilated during operation.
- The appliance operates at 220 Volts (AC). Ensure your power supply matches this requirement.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the main components of your FREIDORA 100500 CECOFRY&GRILL DUOHEAT 65 air fryer.

- **Main Unit:** Houses the heating elements, fan, and control panel.
- **Cooking Basket/Drawer:** Removable non-stick basket for holding food.
- **Grill Rack:** For grilling and multi-level cooking.
- **Touch Control Panel:** Digital interface for setting cooking parameters.
- **Viewing Window:** Allows monitoring of food during cooking without opening the drawer.

4. SETUP AND FIRST USE

Before using your air fryer for the first time, follow these steps:

1. **Unpacking:** Remove all packaging materials and stickers.
2. **Cleaning:** Wash the cooking basket, grill rack, and any other removable parts with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive sponge. Wipe the inside and outside of the appliance with a damp cloth. Ensure all parts are completely dry before use.

3. **Placement:** Place the air fryer on a stable, level, heat-resistant surface. Ensure there is at least 4 inches (10 cm) of clear space around the back and sides of the appliance to allow for proper air circulation.
4. **Pre-heating (Optional but Recommended):** Plug the appliance into a grounded wall outlet. Run the air fryer empty for about 10-15 minutes at 350°F (175°C) to burn off any manufacturing residues. A slight odor may be present during this process; this is normal.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Cecotec air fryer is designed for roasting, grilling, and baking a variety of foods.

5.1 Basic Operation

1. **Prepare Food:** Place your ingredients in the cooking basket or on the grill rack. Do not overfill the basket to ensure even cooking.
2. **Insert Basket:** Slide the cooking basket back into the main unit until it clicks into place.
3. **Power On:** Plug the air fryer into a grounded electrical outlet. The control panel will illuminate.
4. **Set Temperature and Time:** Use the touch controls to select your desired temperature (up to 400°F / 200°C) and cooking time. The appliance features pre-set cooking programs for common dishes, accessible via the touch panel.
5. **Start Cooking:** Press the Start button to begin the cooking cycle. The internal fan and heating elements will activate.
6. **Shake/Flip (Optional):** For some foods, it is recommended to shake or flip the ingredients halfway through the cooking time to ensure even browning. The air fryer may have a reminder function for this.
7. **Monitor Progress:** Use the viewing window to check on your food without interrupting the cooking process.
8. **Remove Food:** Once cooking is complete, carefully pull out the basket using the handle. Use heat-resistant tongs to remove the cooked food.
9. **Power Off:** The appliance will automatically shut off after the timer expires. Unplug the air fryer when not in use.

5.2 Cooking Tips

- For crispier results, lightly brush or spray food with oil.
- Smaller food items usually require a slightly shorter cooking time than larger items.
- Do not prepare extremely greasy ingredients in the air fryer.
- Oven-ready snacks can also be prepared in the air fryer.
- The dual heating elements ensure even cooking and browning from both top and bottom.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your air fryer.

- **Before Cleaning:** Always unplug the appliance and allow it to cool down completely before cleaning.
- **Non-Stick Basket and Grill Rack:** These parts are not dishwasher safe. Clean them with hot water, dish soap, and

a non-abrasive sponge. For stubborn residue, soak them in hot water for about 10 minutes.

- **Interior:** Wipe the interior of the appliance with a damp cloth and mild dish soap. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads.
- **Exterior:** Clean the exterior with a damp cloth.
- **Heating Element:** Use a cleaning brush to remove any food residue from the heating element.
- **Storage:** Store the appliance in a cool, dry place once it is completely clean and dry.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your air fryer, refer to the following table for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Air fryer does not turn on.	Appliance is not plugged in. Power outlet is not working.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a grounded outlet. Test the outlet with another appliance.
Food is not cooked evenly.	Basket is overloaded. Food not shaken/flipped.	Reduce the amount of food in the basket. Cook in batches if necessary. Shake or flip food halfway through cooking.
Food is not crispy.	Not enough oil used. Moisture in food.	Lightly brush or spray food with a small amount of oil. Pat wet ingredients dry before air frying.
White smoke coming from appliance.	Greasy ingredients being cooked. Residue from previous use.	Avoid cooking excessively greasy foods. Clean the basket and heating element thoroughly after each use.
