1. Introduction

The Inseego MiFi X Pro M3000 is a powerful and secure mobile hotspot designed to provide reliable 5G and 4G LTE connectivity. Equipped with Wi-Fi 6 technology, it supports up to 32 Wi-Fi enabled devices, offering a virtually lag-free connected experience. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your device.

2. SETUP

2.1 Inserting the SIM Card and Battery

- 1. Ensure the device is powered off.
- 2. Carefully remove the back cover of the MiFi X Pro.
- 3. Insert your activated Nano SIM card into the designated SIM card slot. Ensure correct orientation as indicated on the device.
- 4. Insert the battery into its compartment.
- 5. Replace the back cover, ensuring it clicks securely into place.

2.2 Powering On and Initial Configuration

- 1. Press and hold the Power button (usually located on the side or top) until the screen illuminates.
- 2. Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup, which may include setting a device password and Wi-Fi network name (SSID) and password.
- 3. Alternatively, you can manage settings via the Inseego Mobile app or a web interface by connecting a device to the hotspot and navigating to the device's IP address (typically 192.168.1.1).

3. OPERATING

3.1 Connecting Devices

- 1. On your Wi-Fi enabled device (smartphone, tablet, laptop), search for available Wi-Fi networks.
- 2. Select the Wi-Fi network name (SSID) displayed on your MiFi X Pro screen.
- 3. Enter the Wi-Fi password displayed on your MiFi X Pro screen.
- 4. Your device should now be connected to the internet.

3.2 Managing Wi-Fi Networks and Connections

- The MiFi X Pro supports simultaneous dual-band Wi-Fi 6 with primary and guest networks.
- Access the device's menu (via the touchscreen or web interface) to view connected devices, monitor data usage, and configure network settings.
- Guest networks can be enabled or disabled and configured with separate passwords for enhanced security.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Battery Care and Charging

- Charge the MiFi X Pro using the provided USB Type-C cable and power adapter.
- The device features fast-charging capabilities.
- For 24/7 operation, utilize the proprietary battery preservation mode when connected to AC power.
- Avoid exposing the device to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight for prolonged periods to preserve battery life.

4.2 Device Reset

If you experience persistent issues, a factory reset may resolve them. Refer to the device's on-screen menu or web interface for instructions on performing a factory reset. This will erase all custom settings and return the device to its default state.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

• No Internet Connection:

- Ensure your SIM card is properly inserted and activated with a data plan.
- Check the signal strength indicator on the device screen. Move to an area with better network coverage if necessary.
- Restart the MiFi X Pro and the connected device.
- Verify that your data plan has not been exceeded.

· Slow Speeds:

- · Reduce the number of connected devices.
- Ensure you are within optimal Wi-Fi range (up to 35 feet).
- Check for network congestion in your area.

• Device Not Powering On:

- Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the device to a power source.
- If the battery is completely drained, it may take a few minutes of charging before the device can power on.
